apothecary pots the same kind as those
I sold you 20 large ones nicely decorated
with basket of flowers on top & two birds
on the base. Cherubhead and flower, 30 to 35
small ones of two different sizes, some
are a little shipped on top. They have all
they original brass lids on them, so they
cover the broken parts. The large ones are
high $7\frac{1}{2}$ " the second size $5\frac{1}{4}$ " and the smallest
 $4\frac{3}{4}$ ". They looks nice all together. The price
for the lot is £ 11-0-0.

I have a small old book (historia Plantarum Lugduni. Apud Gabrielem Coterium (1561) with colored plants in good condition but not very clean long $4\frac{1}{2}$ " by $3\frac{1}{4}$ " large, tik 2" price 8 Sh. he is in Latin. Also I have one (Den Nederlantschen Herbarius: Amsterdam by Nicolaas Ben Schoon 1714. all with black prints and in good condition, the couverture in velvet price 3 Sh.

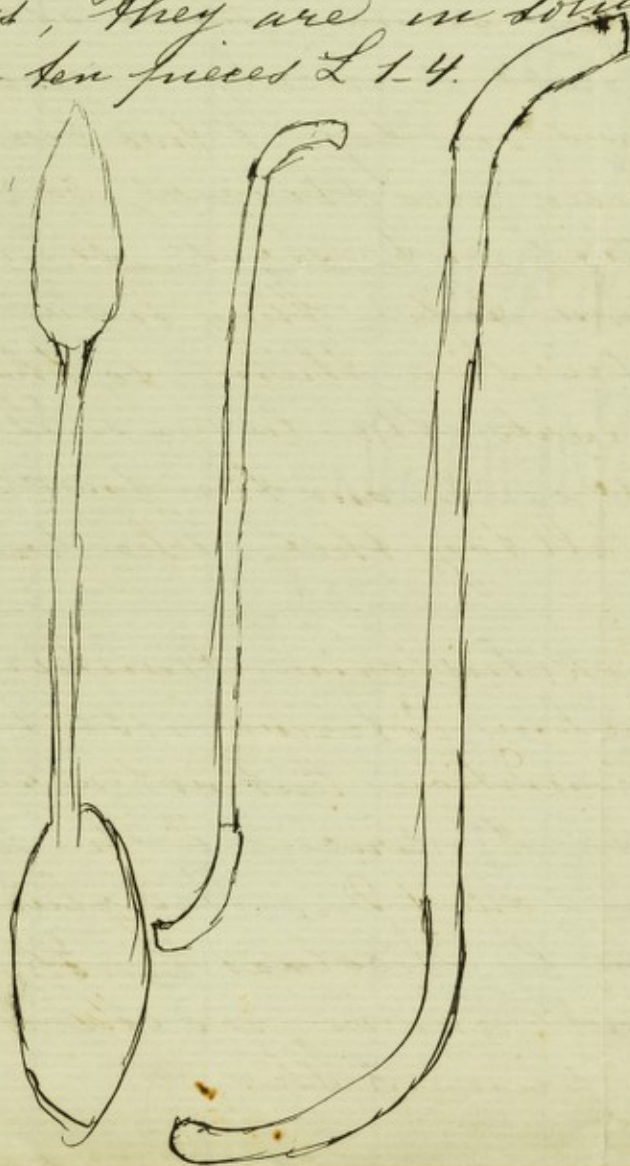
