The publications of these laboratories, so far as at present issued, number 150. It has seemed to me desirable that complete sets of them should be permanently preserved, either for the use of Mr. Wellcome or for any other purpose for which in the future they might be required. A considerable number of the earlier publications are now no longer available in pamphlet form, but I have fortunately preserved two complete sets. These have now been bound together, as well as the somewhat varying size of the pamphlets permits, into three volumes of 50 each. As there is always danger of destruction by fire, it has seemed to me that it would be a wise precaution to have one set kept in the library at Wigmore St, while the other set could be retained here. If you could therefore find a place for these three volumes, where they would be carefully preserved, I shall be glad to send them over to you by a messenger.
