My dear Sir

I received your note yesterday afternoon accompanied by a letter by five Shilling Dollars, but could not reply to it, till the present moment, having been very much occupied.

Though I cannot but feel highly flattered by the very handsome & polite manner in which you are pleased to make mention of my family & self, yet I trust you will not be offended, if I continue to insist on the terms I named to you this morning, to which end I have sent by the bearer forty Dollars, which do me the favor to accept of. You will confer a further obligation on me by continuing your kind attention to my family as heretofore, but I wish it clearly to be understood, that I cannot think of accepting the attendance you are good enough to offer, on any other condition, than those usual with all Medical Gentlemen in private practice, namely, a pecuniary remuneration, adequate to the

trouble & inconvenience occasioned them by their
Patients.

Should this proposal meet your approbation
be pleased to signify the same, that we may be mutually
understood; Permit me however in every case, to express
how sensible I feel, for your past favors to my family
& self, & to assure you that I should esteem myself very
happy to have it in my power to render you any service
if I can, at any time, pray command me, as I shall feel
a sincere pleasure in so doing. I cannot at this moment
recalled to whom the Looking Glass was sold, but as the
no doubt I shall find out he after. By the by
I send the Book, together with the surplus that remains
after deducting the Looking Glass
