25. August 1808.

Sir

I am directed by Dr. Shapter to request that you would send ashore for the use of the wounded French in the Village of Vinciera what quantity it may be convenient to you to spare of the following articles; - Viz^t

- Sticking Plaster
- Rollers.
- Tow

a few pins and a little Glauber salts.

As our own stock of dressings is completely exhausted of the wounded in a most deplorable condition I hope you will have the goodness to seize the very earliest opportunity of fulfilling this request.
