





1. Boer brothers, William & Stephan (William with hand on knee) who helped L'Col. C. G. D. Mosse at "Lufkin's Tower" with garden and horses.
2. Boer prisoner camp 'Deadwood Camp'. The other was 'Broad bottom Camp'. Each held about ~~3000~~³⁰⁰⁰ prisoners, most of whom were ~~on~~ on parole of Col. C. G. D. Mosse in medical charge of both camps.
3. General Cronje with his wife, secretary and another in front of their cottage. "Kent Cottage"
4. General Schiel and General Cronje.
5. Packing case in which a Boer prisoner had himself packed and posted to South Africa. The tin box contained food. He was discovered in the hold of the ship near Ascension Isle and returned to St Helena under escort.
