The Cawnpore division order issued on the 14th May last, authorizing the entertainment of a Native Writer for the new hospital at Cawnpore, as a temporary arrangement, is, with the sanction of Government, confirmed.

By Brigadier J. Longfield, C. B., commanding at Delhi, dated the 25th February 1854 appointing Conductor W. Carroll to officiate as permanent Conductor in the magazine.

By Lieutenant M. J. White, 2d in command 11th Punjaub infantry, dated the 18th ulfine, assuming command of the corps, and making the undermentioned appointments, with effect from the 11th idem, consequent on the grant of general leave to Captain W. J. F. Suffeet, Commandant of the corps:
