by the Grace of God of the United Kingdom of Great Britain and Ireland Queen Defender of the Faith &c  
To Our Trusty and well beloved William Donovan Gentleman Greeting  
We reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty Ability and good Conduct do by these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be an Officer in the Medical Department of Our Army from the 30<sup>th</sup> of March 1872 You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your Duty as such in the Rank of Assistant Surgeon or in such higher Rank as We may from time to time hereafter be pleased to promote or appoint you to of which a notification will be made in the London Gazette by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging And you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us or any your superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War in pursuance of the Trust hereby reposed in you.

Given at Our Court at St James the Seventeenth day of August 1872 in the Thirty Sixth year of Our Reign.
