Victoria by the Grace of God, of the United Kingdom of Great Britain, and Ireland, Queen, Defender of the Faith, &c.
To Our Trusty and well beloved *William Connor, Esquire, Gentleman, Greeting.*
We, reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty, Obedience and good Conduct, do, by these Presents, Constitute and Appoint you to be an Officer in the *Medical* Department of Our Army, from the *30th* of *March* 1872. You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your Duty as such in the Rank of *Assistant Surgeon* or in such higher Rank as We may from time to time hereafter be pleased to promote or appoint you to, of which a notification will be made in the London Gazette, by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging. And you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us, or any your superior Officer, according to the Rules and Discipline of War, in pursuance of the Trust hereby reposed in you.

Given at Our Court at Saint James's the Twentieth — day of August 1872 in the Thirty Sixth year of Our Reign.
