## GUIDES TO HISTOLOGICAL TECHNIQUES

The preparation of a satisfactory paraffin block is of prime importance as no amount of subsequent care will produce good results from a bad block.

No hard and fast rules can be laid down for processing of tissue but the following notes will provide a guide for the treatment of surgical and biopsy material.

The basic steps in the preparation of a stained section with paraffin wax are:-

- (1) Fixation.
- (2) Dehydration.
- (3) Clearing (dealcoholisation).
- (4) Impregnation with molten wax.
