*Victoria* By the Grace of God of the United Kingdom  
of Great Britain and Ireland Queen Defender of the Faith &c To Our Trusty and well beloved  
William Leattell Surgeon Greeting We do by these Presents Constitute & appoint  
you to be Surgeon to Our Forces  
from the 12<sup>th</sup> of July 1863 You are therefore carefully and diligently  
to discharge the Duty of Surgeon by doing and performing all and  
all manner of Things thereunto belonging And you are to observe and follow  
such Orders and Directions from Time to Time as you shall receive from Us  
or any your superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War.

In Witness whereof the said General Commanding in Chief and one of Her  
Majesty's Principal Secretaries of State, in pursuance of the Order of  
Her Majesty in Council bearing date the Seventh day of June 1862, and  
by Command of Her Majesty under Her Royal Sign Manual of even  
date herewith, hereunto subscribe their names this Second day of  
July One thousand eight hundred and sixty three

ExtractBitternauBattalion Orders 15 December 1872

3 Surgeon Battell having left  
 the Battalion on appointment to the  
 10th Hussars, the Commanding Officer has  
 a most agreeable duty to discharge in  
 acknowledging the Assistance and advice  
 he has at all times received from him  
 during his service as Surgeon of this  
 Battalion, and in assuring him that he  
 carries with him to his New Regiment  
 the good wishes of all ranks of the 2/20th.
