Dear Miss Thoyte, Colonel Orr who is in charge of our records at Winchester has sent me copies of a most interesting series of letters etc., from Staff Surgeon Sillery and I understand we owe them to your good offices. They are quite unique and throw a wonderful light on the administration of the Medical Services in the early nineteenth century and will be of great value to future historians and research workers. I shall be taking them up to London next week to preserve among our archives. I am returning the portrait as you request and would be interested to know whether Dr Sillery was an ancestor of yours. Very many thanks for sending us the Sillery papers which I found exceedingly interesting.

Medical administration must have been very odd in the early 1800's when M.Os would write direct to the D.G. urging their own promotions and asking for a year's leave on full pay !

Sillery had quite a distinguished academic record. The following is his biography as contained in "Johnston's Roll".
