THIS NOMINAL ROLL WAS WRITTEN BY SIR JAMES ROBERT GRANT WHO WAS THE DUKE OF WELLINGTON'S PRINCIPAL MEDICAL OFFICER AT QUATRE BRAS AND WATERLOO AND AFTERWARDS IN THE ARMY OF OCCUPATION.

IT WAS ENCLOSED IN A LEATHER POCKET BOOK BELONGING TO DEPUTY PURVEYOR GEORGE ROBINSON WHICH ALSO CONTAINED HIS WATERLOO MEDAL IN ITS ORIGINAL POUCH AND OTHER LETTERS AND DOCUMENTS.

THE ORIGINAL ROLL HAS BEEN RETURNED TO THE POCKET BOOK IN WHICH IT HAD LAIN FOR OVER A HUNDRED YEARS AND IS EXHIBITED IN THE HISTORICAL SECTION OF THE MUSEUM.
