

The Right Honourable the Secretary of State for War
To Harry Augustus Ward

By virtue of the Authority to me, by the King's Most Excellent Majesty in this behalf given, I do hereby Constitute and Appoint you the said Harry Augustus Ward to be a Warrant Officer in His Majesty's Regular Forces from the sixth day of April 1908, and to continue in the said Office during the pleasure of the Right Honourable the Secretary of State for War. You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your Duty as such by doing and performing all manner of things therunto belonging as required by the Established Regulations of the Service, and you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions as you shall receive from your Commanding, or any other, your superior Officer, according to the Rules and Discipline of War.

To Our Trusty and well beloved Harry Augustus Ward Greeting:
 We do by these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be Quartermaster in Our Land Forces from the Eleventh day of July 1914. You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the Duty of Quartermaster by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging.
 And you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us or any your superior Officer according to the Rules and Discipline of War.

Given at Our Court at Saint James's, the Third day of July 1914 in the Fifth Year of Our Reign.
