Ido hereby Constitute and Appoint you the said George Brack None Soozens — to be a Harvart Officer in Her Majesty's Regular Terces from the sweeky knist day of mas 1900, and to continue in the said Office during the pleasure of the Right Hereuvalle the Secretary of State for War. You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your Duty as such by doing and performing all manner of things thereunto belonging as required by the Established Regulations of the Service, and you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions as you shall receive from your Commanding or any other; your superior Officer, according to the Rules and Discipline of War.
