To our Trusty and well beloved Edward Louis Lundy Esquire Greeting:

We, reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty Ability and good Conduct, do by these Presents Constitute and Appoint you to be Brigade Surgeon in Our Land Forces from the Twenty seventh day of November 1879. You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge the Duty of Brigade Surgeon or of such higher Rank as We may hereafter appoint you to, by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging. And you are to observe and follow such Orders and Directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us, or any your superior Officer, according to the Rules and Discipline of War, in pursuance of the Trust hereby reposed in you.
