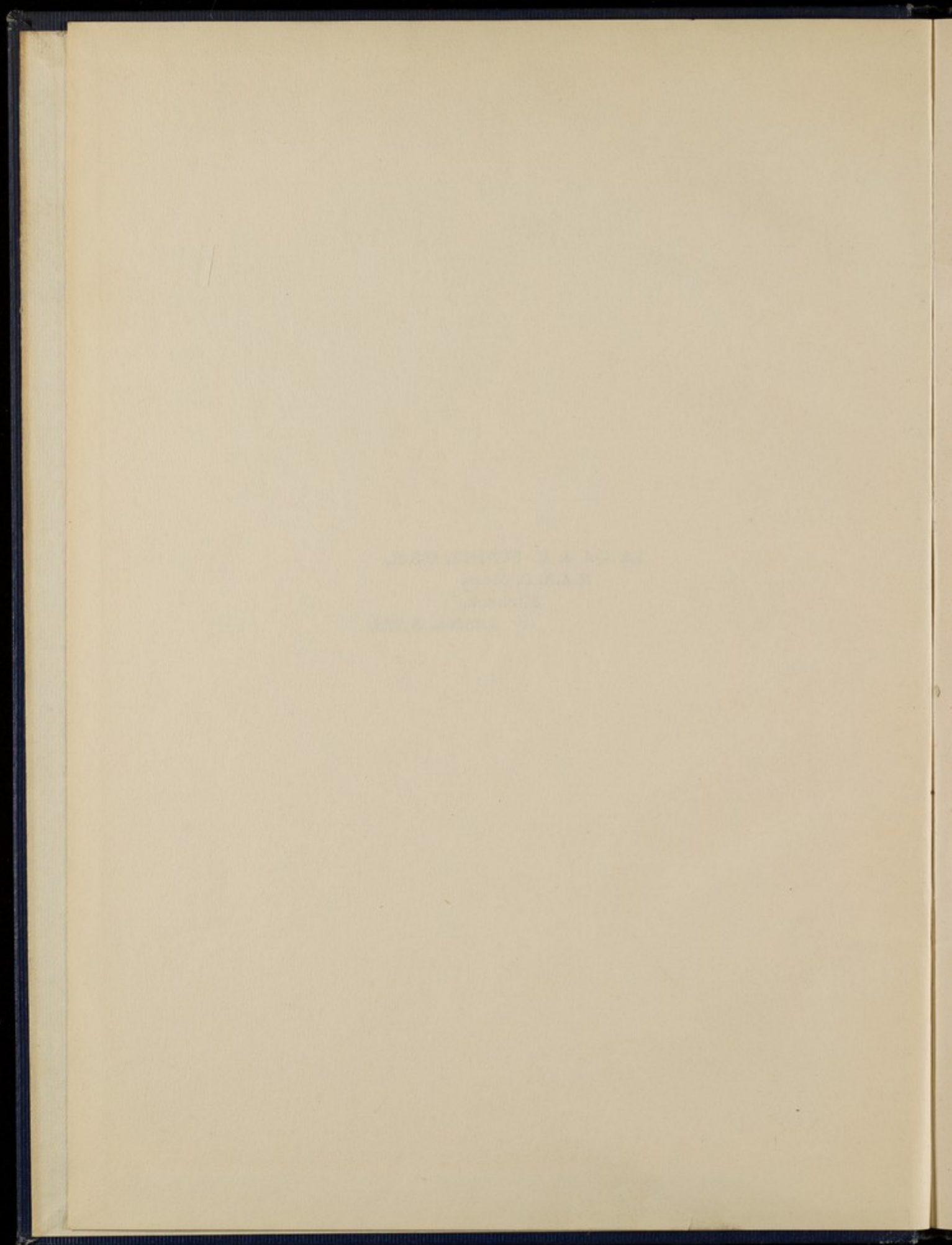

The nos. in square brackets after a Regiment give the modern numbers of the Regiment.

From considerations of space the present Territorial designations are not used.

When no number is given after the Regiment the particular corps has not been identified with one of the existing Regiments, or is one that has been disbanded at a date not precisely known. As a rule the latter is the case.

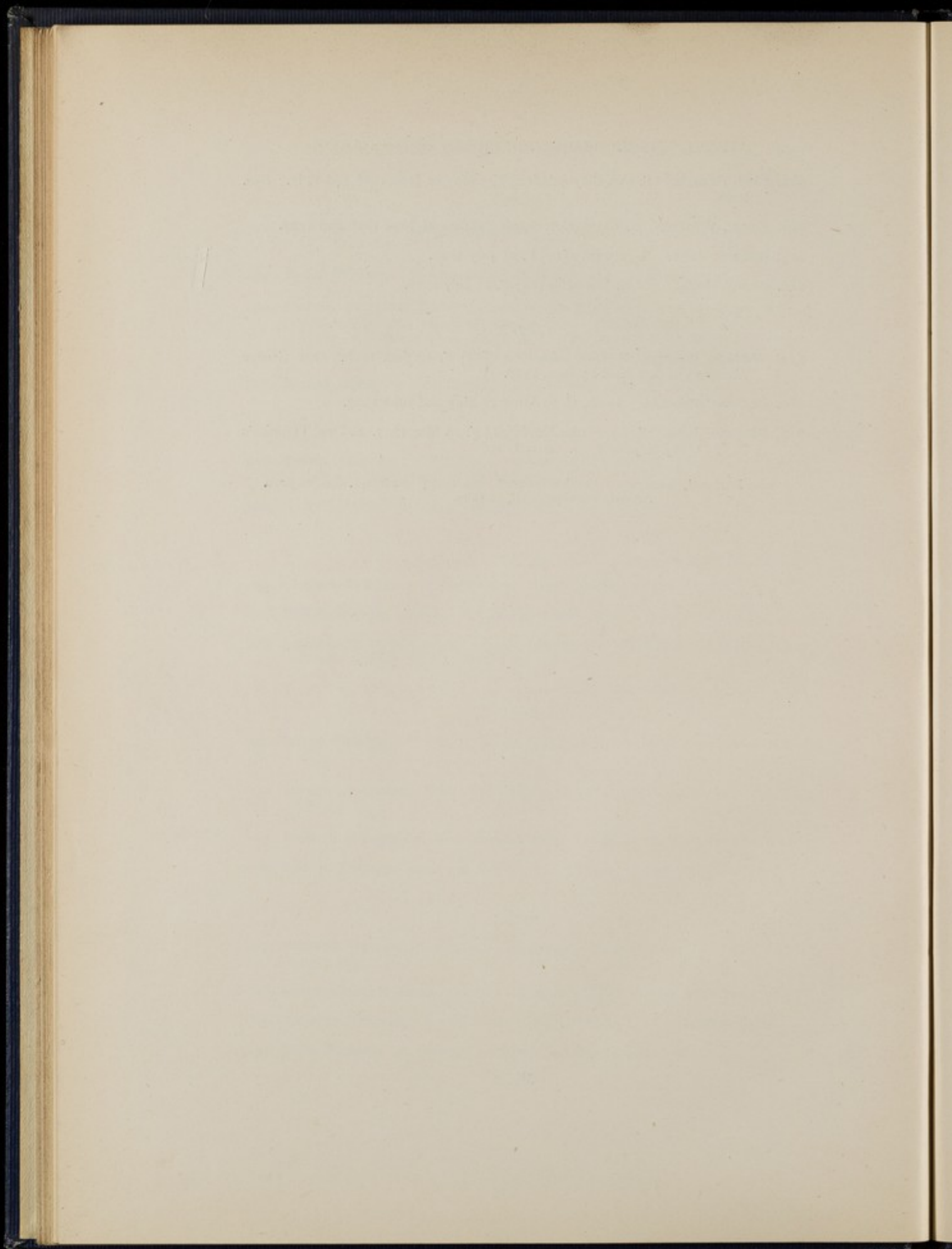
