To Our Trusty and well beloved John Wotherspoon, M.B. Greeting:
We, reposing especial Trust and Confidence in your Loyalty, Ability and good Conduct, do, by these Presents, Constitute and Appoint you to be an Officer in Our Territorial Force, from the seventeenth day of June 1913. You are therefore carefully and diligently to discharge your Duty as such in the Rank of Lieutenant in Our Royal Army Medical Corps or in such higher Rank as We may from time to time hereafter be pleased to promote or appoint you to of which a notification will be made in the London Gazette, by doing and performing all and all manner of things thereunto belonging, as required by the established Regulations of Our Service, exercising authority according to the Rules and Discipline of War over Junior Officers of Our Royal Army Medical Corps and Subordinates employed in Our Army Medical Service, and over the Soldiers of Our Royal Army Medical Corps, and over all Officers and Soldiers attached thereto, and over all Patients in Military Hospitals and observing and following yourself under the same Rules and Discipline such orders and directions from time to time as you shall receive from Us or any your Superior Officer in pursuance of the Trust We hereby repose in you.

Given at Our Court at Saint James's the sixteenth day of July, 1913, in the Fourth Year of Our Reign.
