10. 22 Sepr. 1826. From the Army Medical Department Office signed by S. Reed Secretary addressed to Wm. Lindsay Esqr., Surgeon 18th. Foot at Haslar Barracks:

The Board acknowledges receipt of Expenditure return of the 24th. ultimo and observes that "the charge of 6/8d. for boat hire and Stati -onery for Dr. Watson is deducted therefrom as an inadmissible expence for a Regimental Hospital. The Doctor should pay for his own boat hire and stationery and transmit to this Office a quarterly account of his Disbursements in the Public Service. 11. 22 Oct. 1826. A draft letter from Haslar Barracks in Lindsay's Hand writing addressed to S. Reed Esqr. , Secretary Army Medical Board:

Haslar Barracks, 22nd. October 1826.

In reply to your letter of the 20th. inst. which I did not receive till this morning.

I have the Honour to offer for the Director General's information the following explanatory observations respecting the five cases of fever alluded to in your communication.

In the first case all the five cases belonged to the 35th. Regiment and came from ? Hurst Monckton where that Corps is stationed

quartered. 2nd. Soon after admission, on the following day, one of the five cases, tho' manifestly at first a case of continued fever, began to exhibit local affection of the joints together with other

diagnostic symptoms of acute rheumatism. Consequently the patient was discharged from under the head of fever and placed under that of the latter disease. He still continues

under treatment.

3rd. All the cases appear to have been produced by the common causes which prevail and operate at this season of the year when the vicissitudes of the weather are sudden and severe.

4th. They were all rather slight and unimportant in so much that it did not occur to me at the time of making out the return to merit any remarks respecting them...

Ath. They have all been discharged cured to their duty with the exception of the case of acute rheumatism as already mentioned.

6th. The first case was under treatment 2, the second 4, and

each of the other two 9 days.

7th. One case of the four yielded to aperients, diaphoretics and diluents, the other three, in consequence of greater excitement, and acceleration of pulse, and some slight ??? to the head, lost each thirty two ounces of blood from the arm; which together with purgatives, sudorifics, diluents and ??? readily subdued the fever.

I beg leave further to add for the Director General's information that fever cannot be said to have been a prevailing disease at this station during the summer and autumn months of this year as, on examination of the returns L find that only 41 cases have been admitted since the 24th. of last June comprehending a space of four months.

18. Report of the Committee of the Army Medical Officers' Benevolent Society, laid before the Seventh Annual General Meeting held at Willis's Rooms, King's Street, St. James's on the 22nd of May, 1828.

"The Committee of the 'Army Medical Officers' Benevolent Fund desire to report that they have devoted their Best Attention to the interest of the Fund during the past year, and have been seconded by a corresponding feeling on the part of their Brother Officers, highly honourable to their spirit and Liberality.".....

A Statement of the Society's Accounts is given with a full list of Subscribers, Surgeon Lindsay's name being included as a new subscriber.

Contributors to the Fund who have been conspicuous by their acts of liberality are listed.

The sum of £150 awarded at the last General Meeting in various proportions as then stated, among the most helpless of the Orphans of Army Medical Officers, has been duly paid and Gratefully received.

The Committee recommend that the sum for distribution on the present occasion be limited to Two Hundred Pounds.

The Report records that the Society was instituted in May, L820. Subscriptions by: 67 ladies.

Some 522 Officers. (The Worshipful Society

£777.2.11 invested
£160 given to 23 Orphans, £10 of this
being a special Grant.

Donations during the year amounted to some £530, annual contributions to £333; dividends were &151.





### REPORT

OF THE COMMITTEE OF

#### THE ARMY MEDICAL OFFICERS' BENEVOLENT SOCIETY,

LAID BEFORE THE SEVENTH ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING,

HELD

At WILLIA's ROOMS, King Street, St. James's, on the 22nd of Mar, 1828.

W. W. FRASER, Esq. Inspector of Hospitals, in the Chair.

THE Committee of "The Army Medical Officers' Benevolent Fund" desire to report, that they have devoted their best attention to the interests of the Fund during the past year, and have been seconded by a corresponding feeling on the part of their Brother Officers, highly honourable to their spirit and liberality.

In entering upon their duties, they could not but feel some hesitation. It was scarcely reasonable to hope, that the stream of Benevolence, which had flowed uninterruptedly for seven years, and brought the Fund into its present prosperous condition, should continue; but it is now the pleasing duty of that Committee to state, that such expectations have been agreeably disappointed—that the springs of Charity are still as productive as ever, and that the Receipts of the past year have scarcely been exceeded by those of any year since the establishment of the Fund.

It will be seen, by reference to the annexed Statement of the Society's Accounts, that the Receipts since the last General Meeting have amounted to £.1,000; that is to say, Donations and Subscriptions, £.834; Interest on Stock, £.166.

£.900 Three per Cent. Cossols have been purchased during the year, making the Society's Stock, at this time, to cossist of £.4,400 Three per Cents., and £.1,000 Four per Cents., producing £.172 per Annum.

The Committee consider that their duties would be imperfectly performed, were they to omit recording the names of those Contributors to the Fund, who, during the past year, have been conspicuous by their acts of liberality. The accompanying List of Subscribers is so contrived, as to show at one view the whole Receipts of the year. In casting their eyes over it, the attention of Members will probably be drawn to the following Names:—

Lady M'Grigor, by the additional Sum of Five Pounds, has made up her Subscription to Fifteen Pounds. Mrs. Borland has contributed Ten Guiness. Mrs. Henderson, Mrs. T. Gunning, and Mrs. Bohan, Ten Pounds each. Mrs. Harrington and Mrs. Starkie are Contributors of Five Pounds each.

The Society is doubtless sware that Sir Lucas Pepys, Bart., the Worshipful Company of Apothecaries, and Calvert Clarke, Esq., are Dohors to the Fund, of Ten Guineas annually. Dr. Shapter has made a second Donation of £.21. John Lawrie, Esq., Army rigoria, and Dr. Mouat, of the 14th Foot, are Contributors to the same esmount. Dr. Brown, Inspector of Hospitals at Madras, has transmitted to the Treasurer the Sum of £.27 15s., being a Collection, in aid of the Funds, from the Medical Officers on that Station. Dr. M'Mullen, Deputy Inspector of Hospitals, has presented £.20, and the following Officers are Contributors of Ten Guineas each: Dr. Woolriche (2nd Donation); Dr. Broadfoot; Dr. Sweeny; Dickens Buckle, Esq.; Dr. Baird; Dr. Ingham, 29th; Surgeon Millar, 47th Foot; Surgeon Barlow, 71st; Assistant Surgeon Cotton, 14th Regiment; Surgeon Brown, 45th Regiment; Dr. Browne, H. EXTRACT from the PROCEEDINGS of the ANNUAL GENERAL MEETING of the Medical Officers of the Army, held at the Thatched House Tavern, St. James's Street, 16th May, 1829.

In regard to the Musuem at Chatham, it was stated, that, by the unwearied exertions of Dr. Clarke, and the scientific labours of Mr. Gulliver, it has increased in size, and in the value of the preparations: during the year it has received the most valuable additions. A collection of the most beautiful preparations in Natural Structure has been formed by Mr. Gulliver, which, with some presented by Dr. Knox of Edinburgh, are the admiration of several able Anatomists who have visited Chatham; these preparations are, further, of the highest utility, particularly to the junior Officer.

In Natural History, of the Classes Mammalia, Birds, Fishes, Insects, and Testacea, the collection is of very considerable value, and most important additions are announced as on their way, by the Medical Officers serving in the peninsula of India. In the mineral kingdom we are rich;—we possess about 1800 specimens; 400 of which have been added to the Museum during the year, from North America, Bermuda, the Mediterranean, and from India. The principal contributors to the Museum, in Anatomy and in Natural History, have been Drs. Monro, Knox, Ballinghall, and Reid, of Edinburgh; Mr. Bainton, of St. Bartholomew's Hospital; Drs. Burke and Forbes; Staff Surgeons Collier, Williams, Hill, Stewart, Pilkington, and Doyle; Surgeons M'Arthur, Colclough, Roe, and White; Assistant Surgeons Gulliver, Gibson, Morgan, Brown, Huthwaite, Crawford, and Davey.

Under the care of Dr. Clarke and a Committee of the Officers doing duty at Chatham, the Library continues to receive valuable additions:—143 volumes have been added to it during the year, making now a total of 1530 volumes. Of the 143 volumes added during the year, 109 are donations, and 34 have been purchased out of the very slender funds, and by the liberal contributions of money by some gentlemen. The principal donors have been Mr. Bruce, of the Royal Military College; Staff Surgeon Burton (to whom your Museum and Library owe so much), Dr. Lindsay, Mr. Gulliver, Dr. Kinnis, Mr. Allan, Staff Surgeons Marshall and J. V. Thompson, Drs. Abercrombie and Macintosh, of Edinburgh: Doctors Ballinghall and Cope, and Staff Surgeon J. V. Thompson, have presented works published by them.

Donations in money have been liberally given, by Dr. Shapter, £5.; Dr. Symes, Assistant Surgeon H. P. 88th Regiment, £5.; Staff Surgeon Stewart, £2. 28.; Assistant

Surgeon Cavet, £1. 1s. So slender are the funds of the Library, that, until these donations in money were received, we could neither print the Catalogue, nor bind some valuable works of reference. It is earnestly hoped that donations in money and in books will continue to flow in, and that every Medical Officer who has not contributed will do so; and, further, that our brethren in civil life will present copies of their works.

In the Record Room, in Berkeley Street, are contained most valuable documents :-

1st. A Complete History of the State of Health of the British Army in every quarter of the world, from 1816 to 1828, in 111 folio volumes, as given in the Annual Reports and Returns. This history of diseases is perfect and most valuable, as connected with the collection of morbid preparations at Chatham. In the Record Room will likewise be found, the History of Disease in the Army for a series of years before 1816, although not in so connected a form.

2nd. Histories of particular Diseases, chiefly those prevalent or endemic in distant stations and the colonies, being replies to queries.

3rd. Four folio Volumes of Topographical Statements, illustrated by Plans, Drawings, and Sketches of all the Cantonments and Stations of Troops at home and abroad.

4th. A valuable Collection of Papers on the Syphilitic question.

5th. In five folio Volumes, Monthly Statements of the Diseases prevailing in the Army from 1815 to 1829, and

6th. A large and valuable Collection of the Histories of particular Cases of Disease, with the post mortem appearances.

Officers are invited to visit the contents of the Record Room, which are open to any gentleman of the profession who may apply; no one can consult these documents without advantage; the arrangement and care of them form a monument of the industry and talents of Dr. Gordon, who has nearly completed a tabular statement of the disease, mortality, and number of soldiers rendered ineffective from disease, from 1816 to 1826—a document not less valuable than curious.

In conclusion, it was stated, that the local Museum and Library formed on each Foreign Station, are all of them in a flourishing state, more particularly that at Ceylon, which was first formed by Dr. Farrell, brought to high perfection by Mr. Collier, and now under the able superintendence of Dr. Forbes; that at Quebec, under Dr. M'Dougle; that in Nova Scotia, under Dr. Skey; in Jamaica, under Mr. Draper; and under Dr. Arthur, at the Cape of Good Hope.

Several Medical Officers have gained great distinction by their pursuits in different branches of Natural History and Comparative Anatomy:—Mr. Collier, at Ceylon; Dr. Knox, of Edinburgh; Mr. Burton, of Chatham; and Staff Surgeon, J. V. Thompson, Editor of the "Zoological Journal.
