Collection (then in Australia) was offered to W. on owner's behalf by Urlin before 7/7/1932; catalogue loaned to Wellcome 12/7/1932. Correspondence from then till 12/6/1933, when a meeting was arranged. Matter still apparently under discussion 31/10/1933 when Mrs. E. gave Malcolm the address of Miss Cowan, who was acting as Black's agent.

It is possible that on Malcolm's departure in 1935 nothing more had been fixed and that the catalogue was never returned to Black.

NOTE: Carvings in chalk of the human form or bust, male and female, sometimes twinned are more or less of a grotesque nature and usually elaborately colored in design. In New Ireland it is believed that the Spirit of a deceased person must have some habita-tion on Earth; carved chalk figures are therefore obtained from a bush tribe who live in the Rossel Mountains, S. W. Coast of New Ireland, and are placed by a Chief (whose particular business it is to receive them in a "Toberan" or Spirit House, that is built inside another house, and is decorated with variegated plants. It is death to a woman toapproach or to look upon these figures. These Carvings are evidently prepared in honor of the dead and are therefore an element of ancestor worship.


