Collection (then in Australia) was offered to W. on owner's behalf by Umlin before 7/7/1932; catalogue loaned to Wellcome 12/7/1932. Correspondence from then till 12/6/1933, when a meeting was arranged. Matter still apparently under discussion 31/10/1933 when Mrs. E. gave Malcolm the address of Miss Cowan, who was acting as Black's agent.

It is possible that on Malcolm's departure in 1935 nothing more had been fixed and that the catalogue was never returned to Black.
