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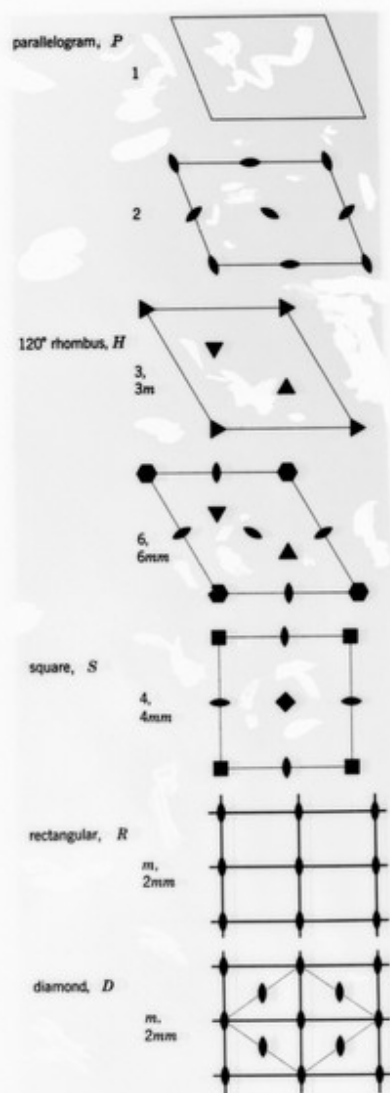


FIG. 24. The distribution of rotation axes and mirrors in the five plane lattice types.

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
