

THE 'TELESMOKE'

Instructions for use

- 1. Stand 100 yards (approx.) from the chimney (the best view-ing distance is between 50-200 yards)
- 2. Adjust the eyepiece so that the filters are clearly defined.
- 3. Sight on to the smoke at the head of the chimney stack.

The smoke must be kept in the clear part of the filter unit so that a proper comparison can be made.



It will be noted that the image is upside down, but this will not impair in any way the ease with which an observation can be made.

To keep the instrument compact and portable it has been produced as an inverted image telescope.
