So one day, we were getting into it and we had a couple of condoms. I happened to nut first that time and after about 30 minutes and 5 different positions, the condom popped! So I reached over and I pulled out the other one and I'm like, "This is the last one so don't go crazy!" Thirty minutes later that condom popped too! But the session was so juicy, I just let him finish and then chose not to do him after.

Afterwards, we both got tested and thankfully everything turned out okay. But I was nervous about getting HIV or an STD.
