

PREFACE.

THE last issue of the King's College Hospital Pharmacopæia having long been exhausted, a new edition has been called for. This has been adapted to the British Pharmacopæia. Its objects are to facilitate the work both of the prescriber and of the dispenser, and to present the student with a series of formulæ which have been found useful in the various departments. To render it more permanently serviceable the doses of the pharmacopæia have been added, brief directions are given for the treatment of common cases of poisoning, and diet sheets employed in the wards are appended. The direction for the dietary of infants, as carried out in the Children's Ward, will probably prove of value to those commencing practice.

POISONS AND THEIR TREATMENT.

EMETICS.

When an Emetic is ordered, one of the following may be employed, unless a special Emetic is mentioned.

- (a) Mustard and Water.—A table-spoonful of mustard stirred up in two-thirds of a tumbler of lukewarm water.
- (b) Sulphate of Zinc.—Thirty grains dissolved in half a tumbler of luke-warm water.
- (c) Warm Water.—Given copiously, alone or after one of the above.

DEMULCENT DRINKS.

When demulcent drinks are ordered, one or more of the following may be given.

- (a) Linseed Tea.
- (b) Barley Water.
- (c) Milk.
- (d) Compound Almond Mixture.

(Common Poisons arranged alphabetically.)

DIETARY FOR INFANTS.

EMPLOYED IN THE PANTIA RALLI WARD,

One month old: 1 part milk, 1 part hot water, 1 part lime water; vary quantity of lime water according to state of child's bowels. Feed every two hours, giving from zij to ziij.

Two months: 2 parts milk to 1 of hot water and 1 of lime water or $1\frac{1}{2}$ of hot water and $\frac{1}{2}$ of lime water. Feed every 3 hours, giving from 3iij to 3vj.

Three months: 2 parts of milk to 1 of hot water, with 1 teaspoonful of lime water; increase quantity to zvij every 3 or 4 hours. These bottles should be sweetened and given at a temperature of 96° or 98°. Barley water or oatmeal water with the fibre of the meal left in

may be used alternately with or instead of the lime water.

After six months the milk should be given as little diluted as possible, but still with some lime water.

After eight months the frequency of the bottles should be decreased and some more solid food given with spoon, such as rusks softened in boiling water and mixed with warm milk, porridge, arrowroot.

After tenth month feed entirely with spoon and give beef tea; chicken broth once a day.

If the child is sick some food may be mixed with the milk as early as the fifth month, and even beef tea may be given if cow's milk seems to disagree; arrowroot or gruel can be easily given in the feeding bottle.

After sixteen or eighteen months very finely minced meat or chicken mixed

with bread crumbs and gravy, with custard pudding, bread and milk, porridge, &c., may form the diet, not feeding the child oftener than every three or four hours and never between its meals.
