### **Publication/Creation**

18 Sep 1834

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Francis Galton to take 15 grs. blue pill every night at  
bed time -

Leamington Water every other morning - 2 large tumbler  
repeated every 20. minutes till it operates (with a little  
ginger if it produces flatulency -

State of evacuations to be examined -

Pea for breakfast - Yolk of Egg - dry toast or rusk with  
little Butter -

Light plain animal food - nothing rich - no pastry  
nor cream -

1 Glass of Cherry with Water at dinner

Pea in the afternoon -

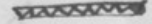
No Vegetables or fruit whilst taking Mercury -

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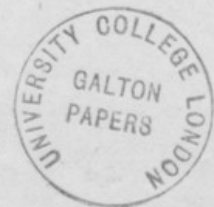
