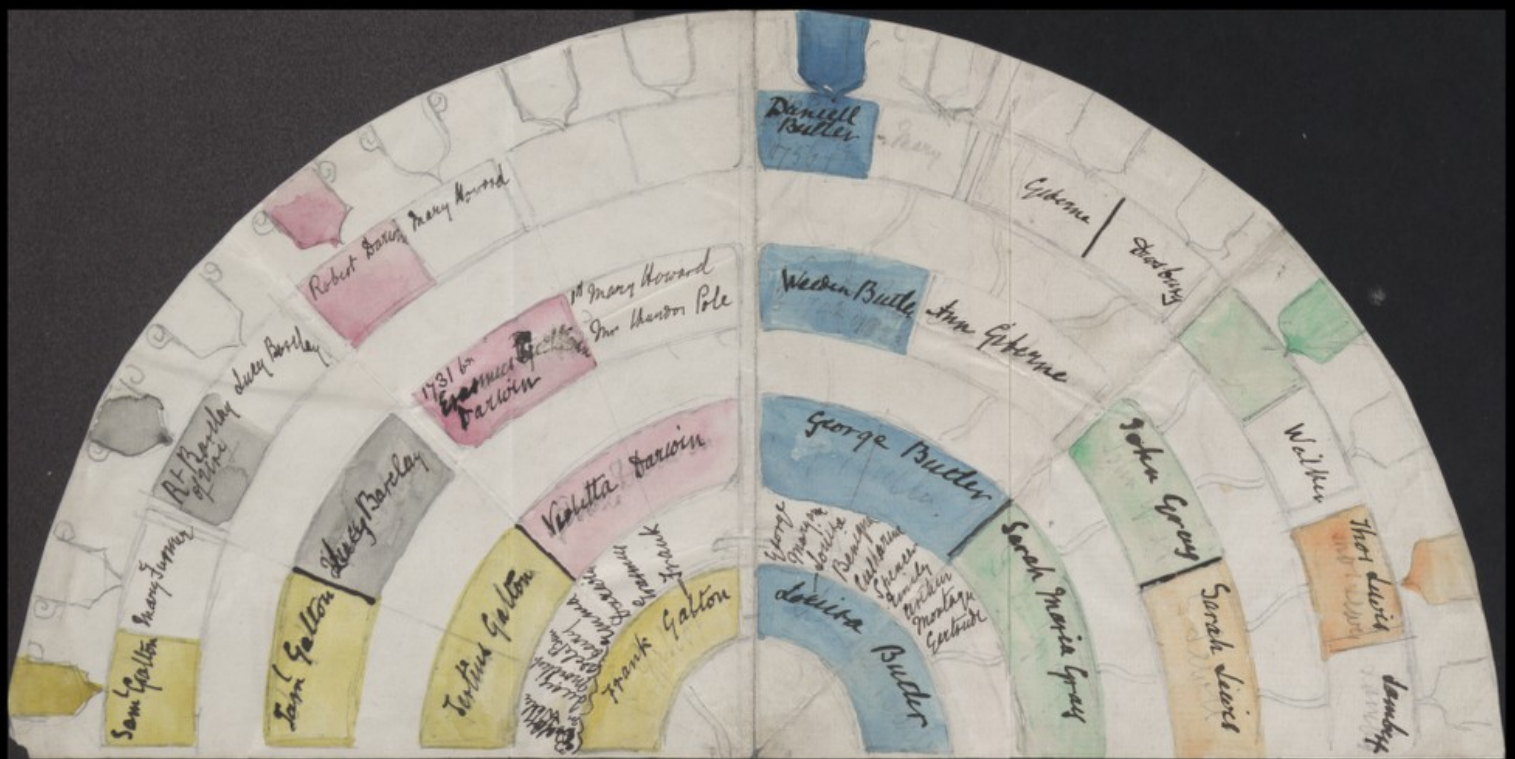
When I was a little child I can

a companion & friend





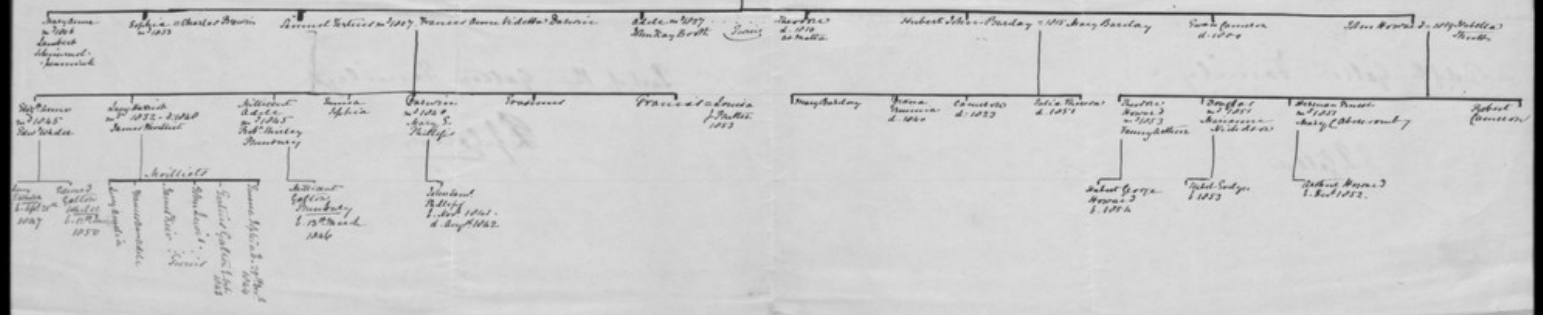

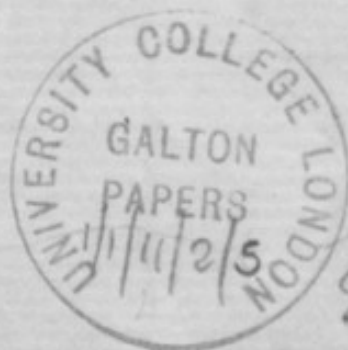

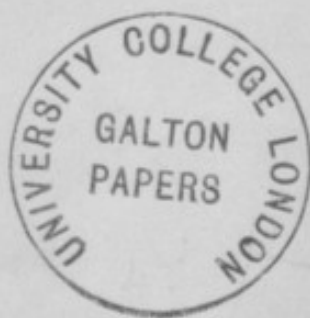

Daniel Butler ^{Oct 3} b. 1697 - d. 1756 at 59 - } lived at
his Wife Mary - b. 1701 - d. 1756 - at 55 - } Margate.

Weeden ^{Sep 22} 6th Son of Daniel & Mary Butler
b. at Margate 1742 - came to London 1757 -
married Miss Anne Giberne who was born 1739
& died 1803 of Asthma at 64 - she
was one of a large family.

Rev. Weeden Butler lived at Cheyne Walk,
Chelsea & had a boys School - He died
1823 - 81th year of his age.

They had 4. Sons & 1. daughter

Weeden Butler had 2 Sisters who married
& became Mrs. Tumbrell - she died 1815 -
& Jane, Mrs. Southwell - she was left a

Widow in 1787. with 10. children - One
of her Sons, Daniel, was a fine fellow
He lost an arm in Lt. Howe's 1st victory
June 1st 1794 - & died 3-years after of
wounds then received.

I suppose Mrs. Thomas Dawes Mother
was another Sister of Weeden Butler -
Miss Southwell who died 1800. was like
Miss Dawes & Mrs. Freshfield.

Daniel a 1st name in the Dawes family -
& Richard - where did Weeden come from? the same?

Thomas Lewis of Palmer's Green was the youngest son of a Yeoman of Pembrokeshire, & came to London with but little fortune - He married Miss Lambert who had 2 brothers William & Charles who had rooms at the Temple, & left no descendants -

Mr. Lewis had a sister who lived with them in London, & died in the house in Frederick's Place, Strand - over the Warehouse -

Mr. Lewis had 11. Children & died 1817 - aged 82 - leaving a handsome property -

He was a Bank Director - 7. Sons & 4. Daughters - all but Walter the youngest in the Tontine -

Aunt Susan died 1860 aged 82 -

Uncle Henry died 1880 - in his 95th year -

Aunt Hough died 1883 - in her 94th year -

His 2 eldest Sons William (a very fine young man) & Charles died before their Father & unmarried - He felt their death very much. Charles died in Ireland, where he had gone on business - Irish Linen being part of his Father's business -

He bought Wembley about 1805 & added to it greatly - finished 1814 -

I think - She died July 12 / 54 - aged 80.
