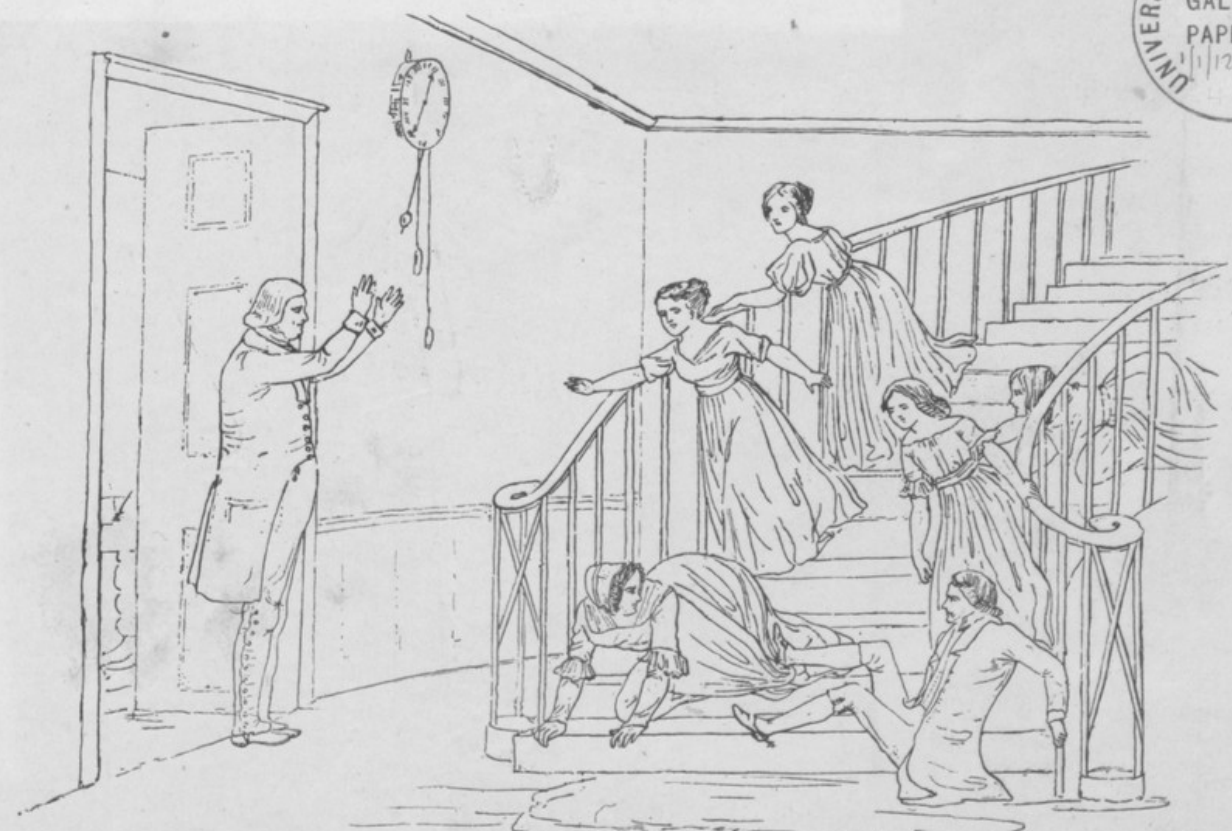

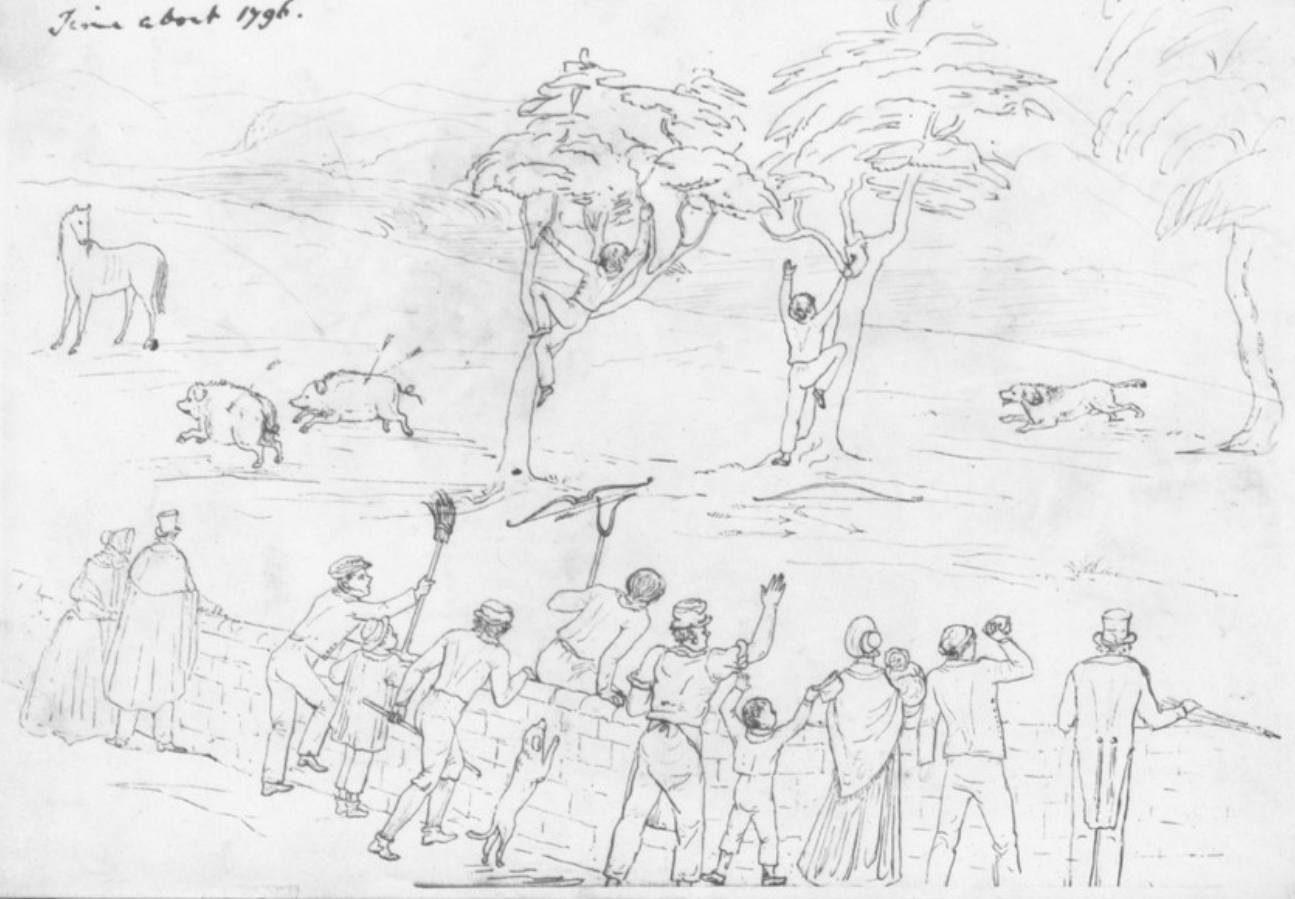

F. D. hosts the Boys in St. Peter's Church yard 1796.



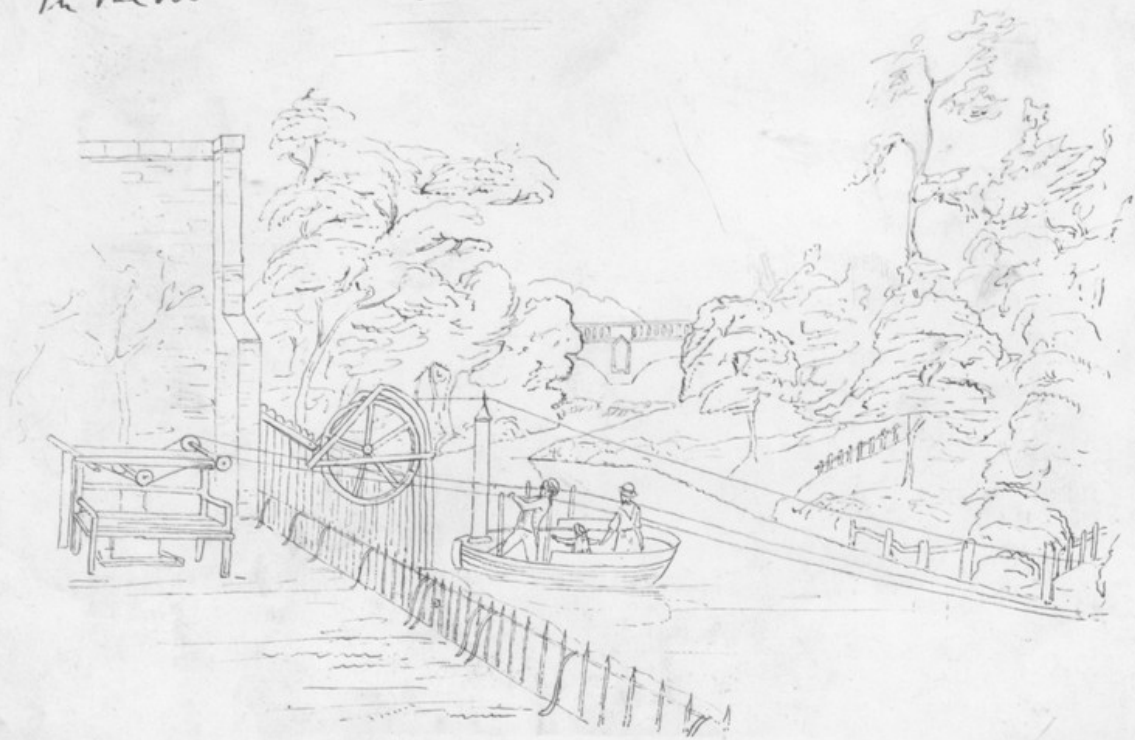




Caught on the Spikes at the bottom of the garden in the Full street -
