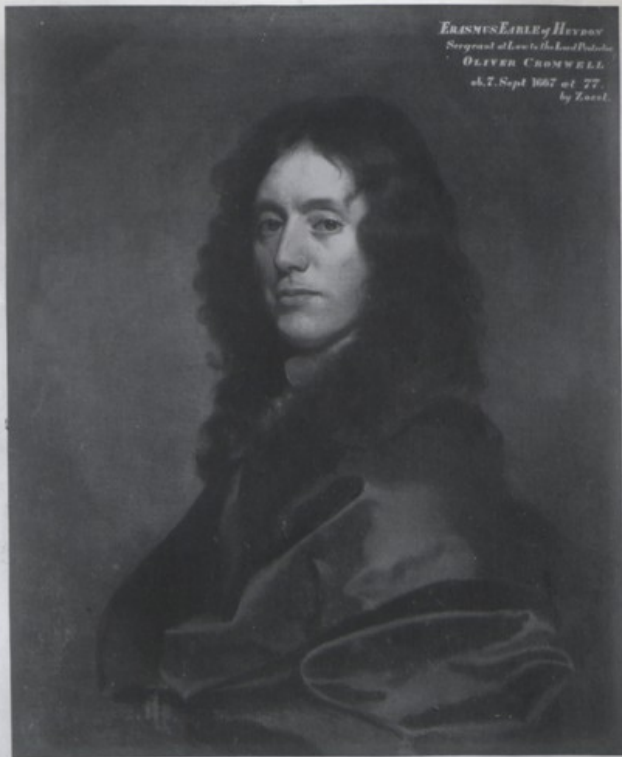

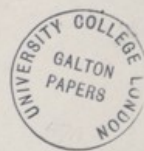

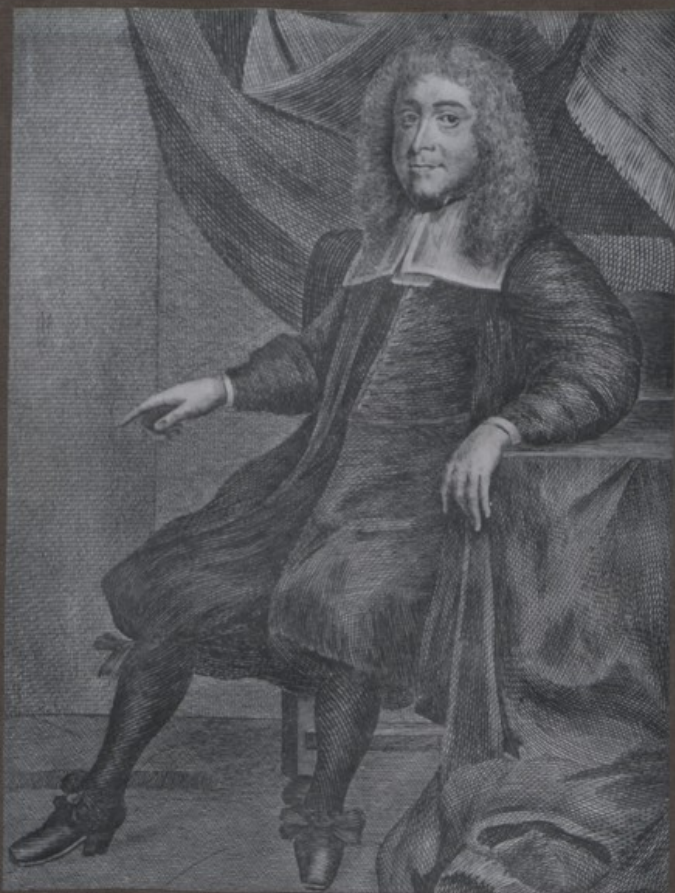

Platonic epistle to a married Lady.

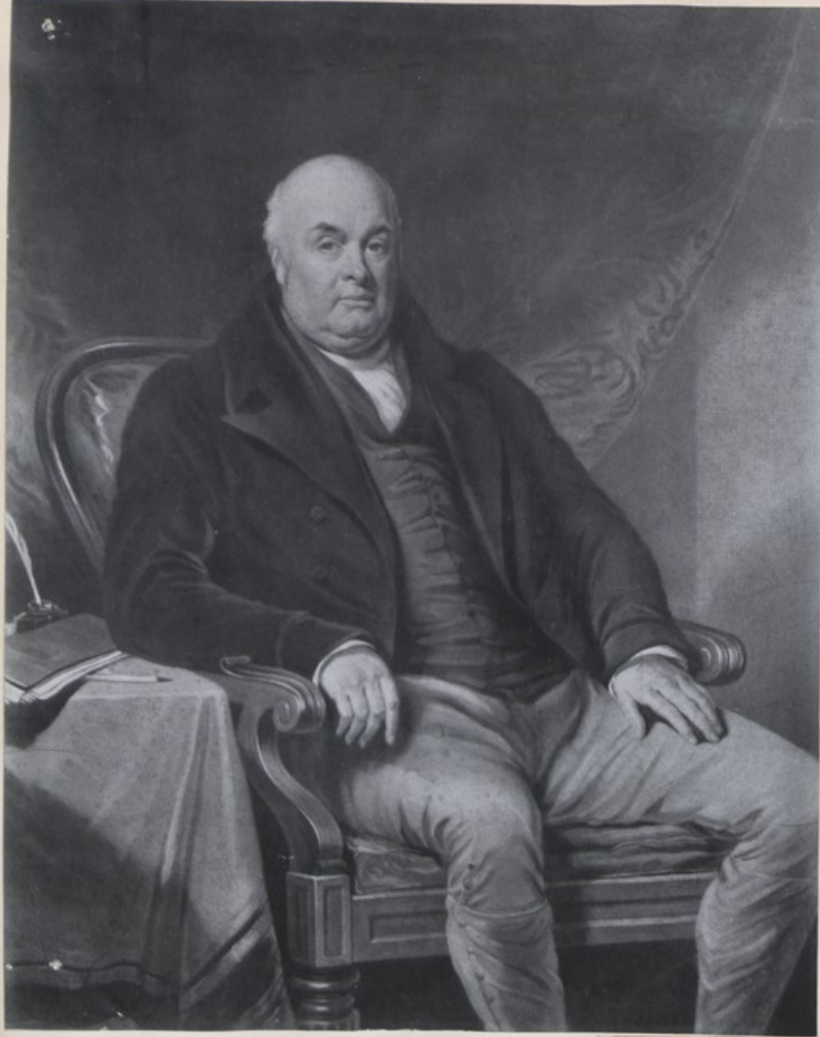
Oh, read these lines Elyza! — may they move

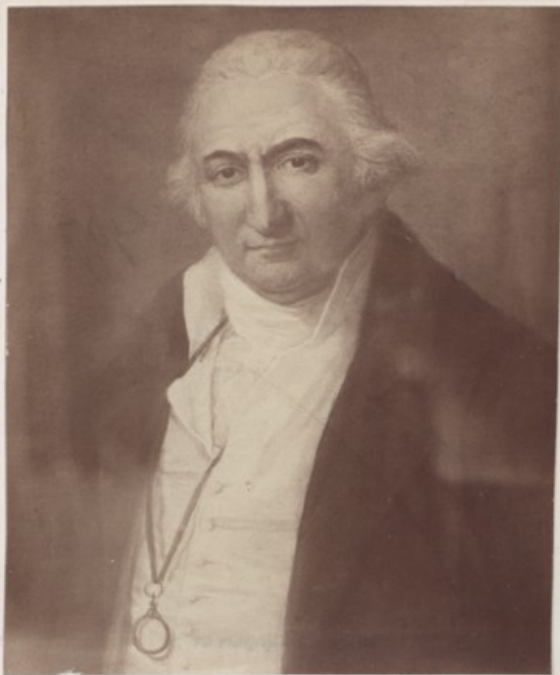
