There is now no such thing as fog, and when there is any want of density, strange to say it is in the under-exposed plates. This capability of exposure was forcibly exhibited a week since, when I was rusticating at a triends home, taking some views around. I had a wrong memo. on my dark slide of ' Coffee and albumen" when it really contained Kennett Gelatine Plates, the consequence was I exposed each plate 13 and 14 minutes respectively, instead of 2 minutes-discovered my error before developmentthought the plates ruined, but corrected them with bromide, and got two good negatives, little worse for over exposure.

"As compared with your former make they may be called *slow and sure* so far good, but I am still yearning for some of those extra sensitive, and having conquered the gelatine difficulty, I am in hopes you will make rapid pellicle as certain as slow.


