1856-1887



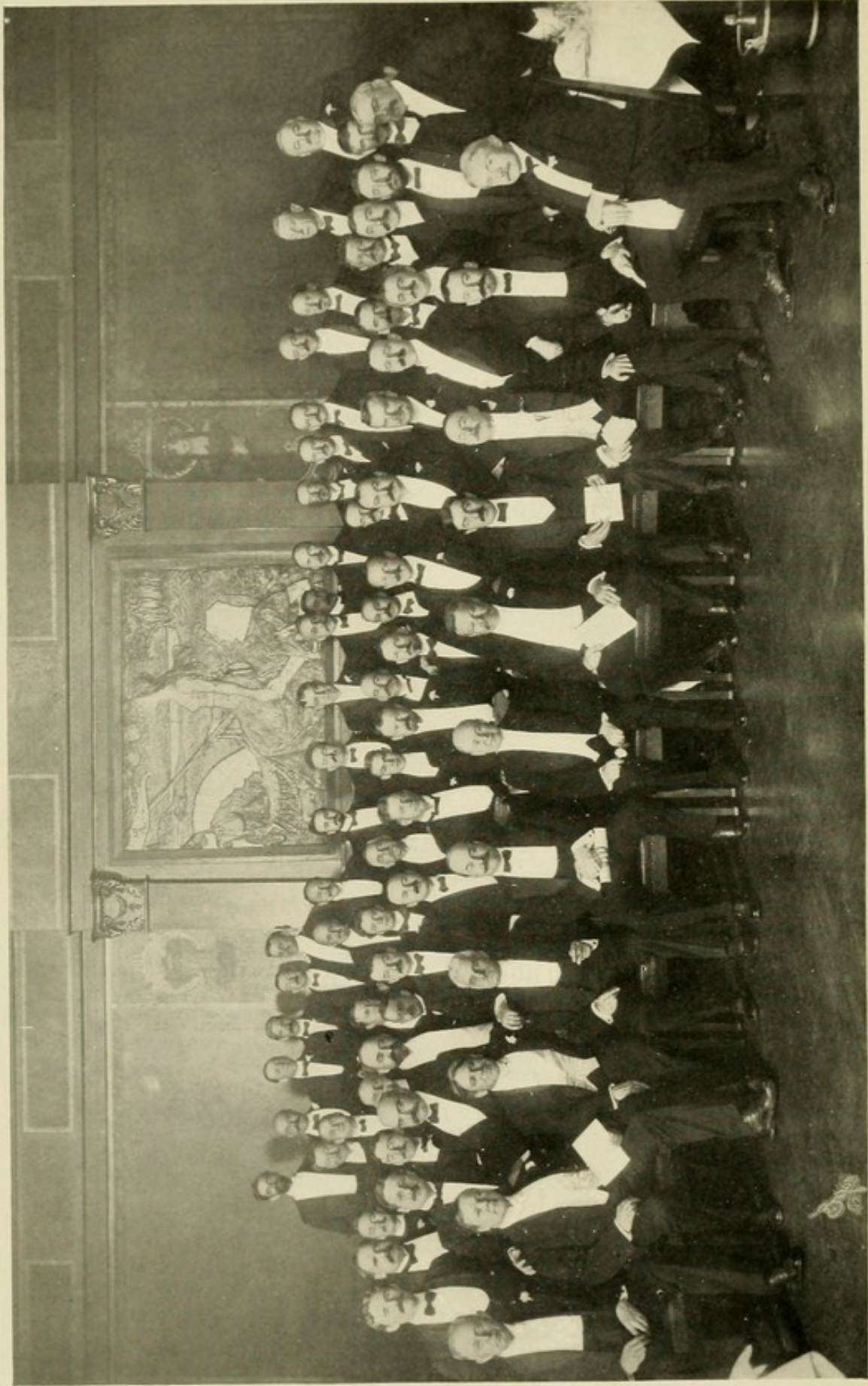

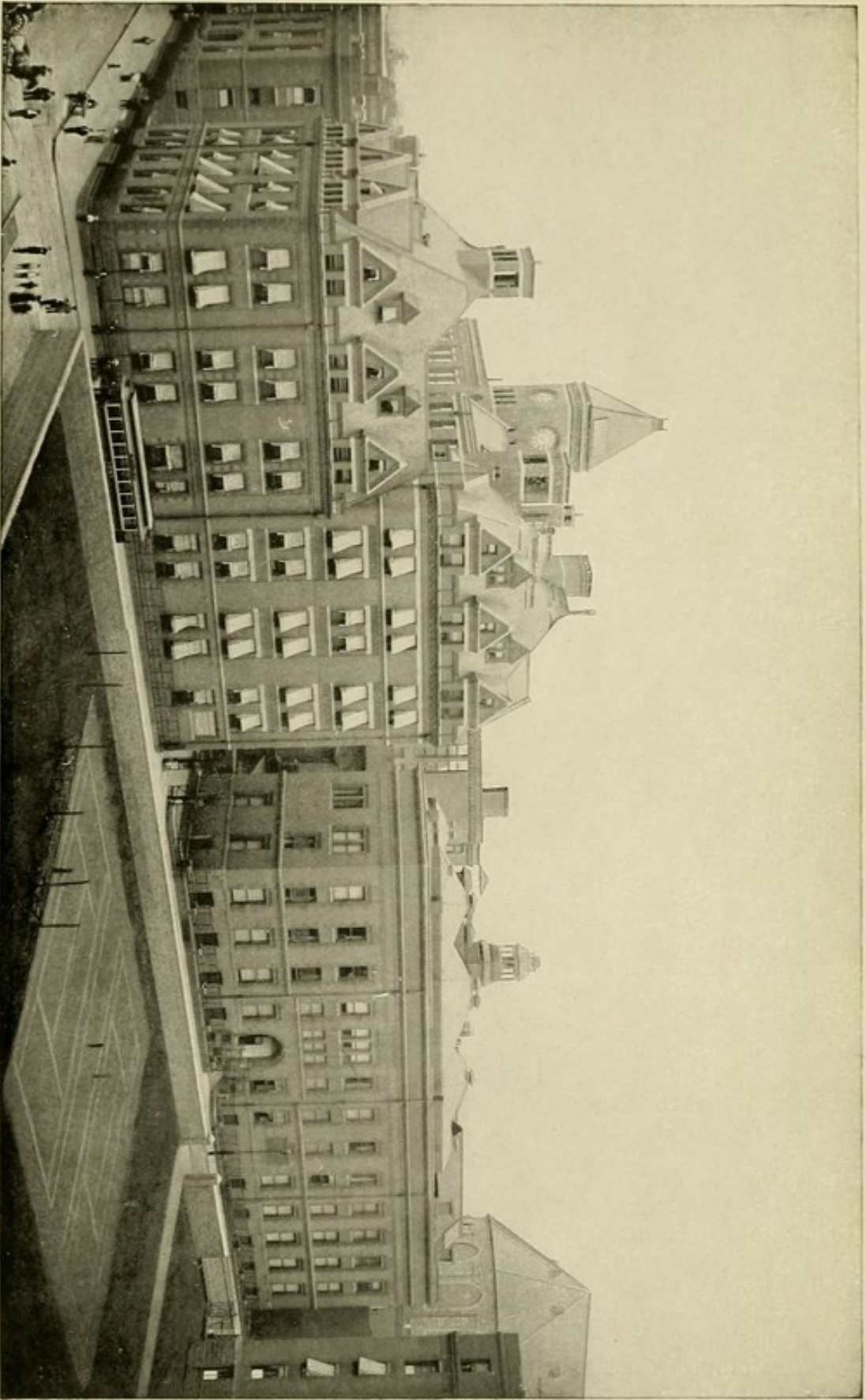
On the old farmhouse veranda, there sat Silas and Miranda,
