MORTUARY REPORT.

FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING 1ST FEBRUARY 1853.

DURING the statistical year 1853 the total number of deaths reported from the funeral places was 14,164, the still-born being 242, or but 1·7 per cent. of the whole, which is nearly the ratio that has been maintained during the six years that the new registration has been in operation,—a ratio, however, that is very low compared with what has been deduced, from Returns here accessible, of European continental countries, giving an aggregate of 10,882,157 deaths, of which 4·8 per cent. were still-born. The relative smallness of the number of still-born reported in Bombay is probably in great part owing to the practice of the domiciliary interment of infants, which has been mentioned in the Reports for the preceding three years.

2. Of the 13,922 who died after birth, 7,542 were males, and 6,380 were females, the ratio being 118·2 to 100. The disproportion of the sexes shown in the Mortuary Registers at this place, has been the subject of remark since my first Report for the year 1848, and it appeared to be in a great measure accounted for by the immigration of adult males, for service and labour. The remarkable circumstance, however, of a steady large preponderance of male over female births, in all castes and tribes, which has been noted during the past four years of birth registration, has favoured the opinion, that in India the relative proportion of the sexes may be normally different from what it is in Europe. There is not yet a Census of the island of Bombay, that is in the least trustworthy, to which reference can be made for the elucidation of this or any point of vital or mortuary statistics, and it is matter of doubt if there be any Indian population

Returns that can be altogether relied on. Almost all such, however, that have yet been seen, show a large excess of males in all castes and tribes, and in both agricultural and civic populations.

3. In the course of the year it was discovered that the numerous caste of Bhatias had been erroneously included in the Boodhist group, with whom they have no religious connection, and they were transferred after the month of May, to form a group with the asarcophagous Lingaets. This error has made the number of Boodhists appear unduly large in the tables for 1851 and 1852 ; but it has not affected the correctness of the division of the people into sarcophagous and asarcophagous. There are few Boodhists in Bombay, and, as was corroborated in this year's registers, the allied or derived Jains are in many cases Jains only by descent and family connection, while they worship Vishnoo or Sheeva. These proselytes to Brahmunism are still allowed to intermarry with those of their *Nat* or tribe who have continued unchanged in religion. A list of the Jain tribes, and of the castes of Hindoos that occurred in the registers during the year, is appended.

4. Compared with the mortality of 1852, there was an increase of 411 deaths. There were fewer deaths from *Small-pox*, but more from *Cholera* and *Measles*, while in the total of the epidemic classes there was a diminution of 129. Among the diseases not known to be epidemic there was an increase of 354 from *Fever*, of 132 from diseases of the *Respiratory System*, of 125 from those of the *Alimentary System*, 73 from *Cachexy and Debility*, and 48 from *Accident and Violence*. Under diseases of the *Nervous System* there was a decrease of 80, and under *Dropsy* of 100 deaths.

5. With reference to the mean of the preceding five years, the total mortality of 1853 was 133 in excess ; that from epidemic causes was less by 1,197, but from all other causes it was greater by 1,338, the excess being seen in all the chief classes of disease, excepting diseases of the *Nervous System* and *Dropsy*, in both of which there was a diminution of deaths. The deaths from *Small-pox* during 1853 were happily below the average of the preceding five years.

6. Making use, as before, of the somewhat uncertain standard of the deaths from ordinary causes, in the want of population Returns, the localities of the chief mortality from *Cholera* were the same as were pointed out in the Report for 1849, these being the lowest and dampest districts of the island,

rather than such as, although densely peopled, are on higher ground and without gardens. The Northern Division of the island, as usual, suffered comparatively little.

7. Girgaon is always severely visited by Cholera when the disease is prevalent, and it would doubtless be conducive to the salubrity of that part of the island if the dense plantation of cocoanut palms were removed. To clear away at once the whole of the cocoanut trees would, however, involve an expense that would not, it is thought, be readily encountered. The existence of a belt of palms, forming, as it were, a wall 70 or 80 feet high, must hinder the healthful ventilation, by the sea breeze, of the portion of the island immediately to its leeward ; but were this belt composed of only full grown palms it would be less injurious than it is now to Girgaon itself, as their shady frondage would be well elevated, and would allow the breeze to ventilate the ground beneath, with little hinderance from their slender stems. It is the undergrowth of young palm trees, filling up the interstices of the stems of those that are full grown, that acts most perniciously, and it is desirable that for the future the planting of cocoanut trees there should be prohibited ; and as these trees are rarely productive under eight years, it might be ordered that all those under four years' growth should be rooted out, some compensation being given to the owner ; and at the same time it might be notified that after four years from date given, no licenses would be granted to tap fresh trees. By these means the salubrity of Girgaon would be gradually improved, at little expense to the public, and without loss to the present cultivators.

8. The evil to ventilation caused by the custom in Girgaon, as well as in all parts of the island, of surrounding compounds and gardens with high walls, instead of open railings, should, if possible, be remedied.

9. The violent deaths were 30 above the mean of the preceding five years, and exceeded by 48 those of 1852. The drowned amounted to 51, of whom so many as 42 lost their lives in the insufficiently fenced pools, tanks, and uncovered wells. By the falling of houses, sheds, and walls, the large number of 17 were killed.

10. The written Reports of death received were one-ninth of the whole. Of the 14,164 whose deaths were registered, 7,722 were reported to have been born in Bombay, 6,397 elsewhere ; and regarding 45 no information on the point was obtained. Bombay was the country to which the families of

3,280 were stated to belong, and of 42 the country could not be ascertained. 9,680 bodies were buried, 3,672 were burnt, and 812 were exposed to be devoured by birds.

11. According to the Meteorological Abstracts supplied by the Superintendent of the Bombay Observatory, the mean Barometric pressure was 29·814 inches, the mean range was 0·116 inch, and the extreme range 0·606 inch. The mean temperature in the shade was 80·8 Fahr., or 0·7 higher than in 1852, the mean range of temperature 11·9, and the extreme range 32·4, both being less than what they were in the preceding year. The Dew Point mean temperature corresponded with the temperature of the air in its excess over that of 1852. The per-centage of Humidity in the air was 91. Rain to the amount of 69·26 inches fell, and there were 99 days on which it rained.

12. Six years of the registration of the Deaths in Bombay are now completed, and the information gathered has been duly arranged, as was proposed, in anticipation of a Census, which it was hoped would render the facts being accumulated truly valuable. At present these Mortuary Tables can be turned to only very limited use, and they are somewhat like what a Surveyor's system of triangles would be without a measured base line. It is greatly to be desired that measures may be adopted to render the approaching Census of the island correct, for it is better to be without a Return of the population than to have one so inaccurate as that of 1849. Without a legal enactment, such as is had recourse to in Britain, to render the giving the requisite information compulsory on the inhabitants, it seems almost impossible that a correct enumeration of the people can be made; for without such compulsion, with a population so large as to yield 14,000 dead a year, so diversified in race, and so little likely to give active aid in the work, although disposed to be passive, as this community is known to be, a very large establishment of enumerators would be required; and setting aside the very heavy expense of their maintenance, it would be most difficult to find a sufficient number of men available and otherwise qualified for the work.
