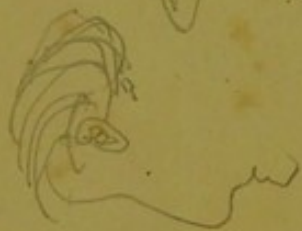

# SEVENTH

## MORTUARY REPORT.

---

FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING 1<sup>ST</sup> FEBRUARY 1854.

---

ON looking into the Death Returns of the past year, it is seen that the mortality has greatly exceeded the mean of the preceding six years of the registration. The total reported funerals were 18,010, or, deducting Still-born, there were 17,742 deaths from various causes, which is 3,931 above the average. The male deaths were 9,963, and the female 7,779; or in the ratio of 128 males to 100 females; the mean proportion which they bare to one another during the preceding six years being 122·87 to 100. The great fluctuations from year to year, in the ratio of male to female deaths, has led to frequent inquiries whether they could result from errors in the entries at the funeral-places; but there has not been found any reason to doubt the accuracy of the Registers on this point.

2. In this country, it is impossible to obtain from the greater part of the people any exact statement of their ages; nor was anything more than an approximation to the truth expected in individual cases. It is, however, to be supposed, that when the aggregate number of recorded ages becomes large, the errors of understatement and of overstatement will compensate the one for the other, and that thus an average not far from the truth will be obtained. The aggregate number that these Returns now afford us is, perhaps, yet too small to allow of positive conclusions being drawn; but from the 100,607 deaths at various ages that have been recorded, it is found that the mean age at death has been  $24\frac{1}{4}$  years.

3. It is also found, that of the deaths that have occurred during the last

four years, 43·00 per cent. were below the age of 14; that 44·27 were between the ages of 14 and 54; and only 12·73 per cent. above 55 years.

4. These, and such like abstract facts, are of no present practical value, but they, as well as other information that is being accumulated in these Mortuary Tables, will become of true importance for sanitary and other civic purposes, when trustworthy Population Returns shall show the ages of the living, and their distribution in the island. It was the sanguine hope that a correct enumeration of the inhabitants would ere long be made, that led me to propose the construction of these Tables; and the expectation that these details of the dead, at present so dry and barren, would soon be elucidated, and rendered useful by corresponding Population Returns, has been an encouragement to assiduous care in their preparation.

5. The time for another Census is near, and I would with due respect state, that from the utter failure of the two former attempts at an enumeration of the people, and from much consideration of the subject, I am of opinion that it is impracticable to take a correct Census in Bombay by other means than those that are used in Britain; and there does not appear to be any valid reason why a legal enactment should not be had recourse to here, to obtain from the people that information which it is for the people's good to collect, which is necessary to allow of sanitary measures being undertaken with confidence, and which the Government of every civilized country has, or ought to possess. There is not among the Natives of this place, as those who have local experience well know, any religious objection to afford all the usual information connected with Vital or Mortuary Statistics, such as those at a distance are too apt to imagine may exist.

6. During the year under review, the deaths from epidemic causes were more numerous than in the preceding year, solely from a higher Cholera mortality, so many as 3,353 having been destroyed by that disease. There were but 313 fatal cases of Small-pox reported, which is fewer than in any of the preceding years of the registration. The number of deaths from Measles was 130, which is almost identical with that in 1853. The parts of the island chiefly infested by Cholera are seen to have been the same as in former years; but a correct knowledge of the comparative liability in different localities to the ravages of the disease can only be obtained when the population of the several localities is ascertained.

7. The deaths from diseases that may be considered of endemic origin—



as we may suppose part of the fevers, of the bowel complaints, and of the convulsions and tetanus, to be—were unusually great. It is not easy to trace the effects clearly to their causes; but one cannot but be impressed with the idea that the loss of life is much increased by foul drains in the town, cesspools and dung-heaps, and the neglect of the drainage of the Flats from the monsoon water, since the main drain, which used to carry it off, has been banked up on each side. The burial-grounds in the neighbourhood of the town must also be a copious source of disease.

8. The disposal of the dead ought to have more attention than has yet been given to it, for, as it is now practised, there is much in it that is very objectionable; and in considering this matter, it has to be borne in mind that the clandestine domiciliary interment of infants, which was first noticed in the Report for 1850, still remains unchecked, affording facilities for the undetected commission of infanticide, and contributing to the pollution of the air of dwelling-houses, through the decomposition of the bodies interred in or near them.

9. The state of several of the burial-grounds, both Moosulman and Hindoo, is such as to require immediate amendment, as the foul gases that taint the air in their neighbourhood are detrimental to health. The burial-ground on the north side of Grant Road may be mentioned as one of these. There is a burial-ground, however, which is so horrible and shameful, that it seems only to require to be brought to the notice of Government to have it suppressed—it is that for Hindoos at Sonapoor. The exact size of the ground is not, I think, clearly defined: the Policemen on the spot said there was an order that no grave should be dug below high-water mark; but the tides vary in height, and there was nothing to indicate the limit towards the sea. I had the breadth of the ground measured from the outside of the outmost grave, where it was still wet from the retiring tide, to the wall of the Moosulman cemetery, and also its length north and south, as pointed out by the men on duty: the area was found to be 10,581 superficial feet. Knowing that during the last seven months 2,711 bodies had been interred there, it may be concluded that in the course of a year the number will be nearly 4,649; and reckoning the due proportion of these as children, it is calculated that were the year's number of bodies laid at the same time, shoulder close to shoulder, without intervening space, they would not only completely cover the whole area, but they would have to be laid in two tiers,



the second equally closely packed as the first, and there would still be more, to form part of a third tier of corpses.

10. The rapidity with which the bodies decompose is marvellous; and yet the short time that is actually required for the process is liable to be cut still shorter at Sonapoor, for the men in charge of the place said that *eight days* was the time under which it was prohibited to re-open a grave for a new burial. He pointed out a grave just then dug, from which the remains of one who had been buried a month before were being taken up, to make room for another occupant. Were decomposition in this sandy soil not so rapid, it would of course be impossible that so many dead could be deposited there; yet, as in putrefaction the soft solids of the body are changed into poisonous gases, the greater rapidity of the process does but the more intensely pollute the air, by giving a larger quantity of those gases in a given time. The moral effect of such a scene on those who resort to this place to deposit their dead must be bad, and on those also who become habituated to its horrors, which are sometimes even aggravated in the monsoon, by the surf washing the newly interred from their graves.

11. Along the shore of Backbay there are several other graveyards, and also a depository for dead cattle, the stench from which also is most disgusting, and overpoweringly offensive; and all these are to the windward of the Native Town, which has its sea-breeze, that would otherwise be health-giving, thus poisoned. It is likely that the unwholesome emanations are *one* of the causes why Girgaon has what is thought to be a proportionately high mortality when Cholera is epidemic.

12. There were 8,458 deaths attributed to fever, which was 2,876 more than the mean of the preceding six years; and it is probable that Bombay shared in the febrific influence that made the neighbouring island of Salsette so pestilential during the latter part of last year.

13. The increase in the mortality under Class V. amounted to 20.

14. Class VII., or that of *Diseases of the Respiratory System*, was the only one in which there was any considerable decrease in the number of deaths; they were 1,466, that being 388 fewer than in the previous year, and 53 less than the mean of the foregoing six years.

15. The deaths under Class VIII. were 2,203, or 331 above the average. Under *Cachexy* and *Debility* also there was an increase.

16. Many of the casualties under Class XV. were caused by the hurri-



cane that blew on the night between November 1st and 2nd, and chiefly through the wreck of vessels in the harbour, 47 of the bodies of those drowned having been washed on shore. Four were killed on the same night by the fall of trees that were blown down, and 5 by falling houses; or, in all, 56 of the deaths were noted as caused by the storm. Death thus produced strikes with awe, and brings sudden desolation and grief to the bereaved; but it is not so revolting and horror-striking as the death of the infant that occurred in the following month, through having been partly devoured by a dog during the short absence of its mother from the shed or hut in which it lay. It is surely proper that the island should be freed from the many unowned, noisy, and, as is here seen, dangerous dogs that infest it.

17. Among the avoidable deaths were many of the 47 from drowning in unfenced pools, tanks, and wells; and to be blameless as regards the lives lost in this way, the expense of sufficient fences should not be spared. It is to be hoped that in the promised new water-supply, the drawwells and reservoirs will be of a less dangerous construction than the present are.

18. The Still-born were 268, or but 1·48 of the whole 18,010 that were brought to the funeral-places.

19. There were 12,516 buried, 4,611 burnt, and 883 exposed to the vultures. Bombay was stated to have been the birth-place of 8,550, while 9,349 were said to have been born elsewhere, and of 111 the place of birth was unknown. Bombay was given as the country to which 3,963 belonged, and of the rest 13,963 were of other countries, and of 104 information on this point was not obtained. The written Reports of Death were somewhat more numerous than in former years, amounting to one-eighth of the whole.

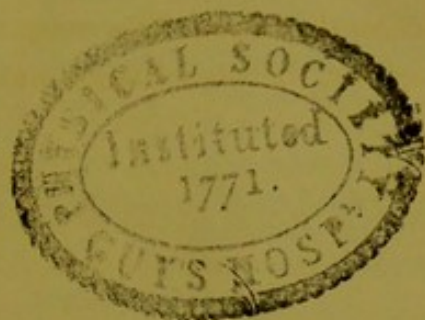
20. In reviewing the Meteorological Summary of the year, the facts that seem most influential were the cyclone of 1st and 2nd November, when the maximum force of the wind registered was 35 lbs. on the square foot, and the unusually great quantity of rain so late in the season as October and November: the total fall in the year was 82·13 inches. The variations in the hygrometric results received from the Observatory are not easily accounted for. Since 1848, the mean per-centage of humidity in the air has fallen progressively from ·94 to ·86, having seemingly been uninfluenced by the quantity of rain, the number of days on which rain fell, or the number of hours during which the land-wind or sea-breeze blew; and



while the mean humidity is shown to have fallen from  $\cdot 91$  in 1853 to  $\cdot 86$  in 1854, the mean dew-point has risen from  $71\cdot 5$  in 1853 to  $72\cdot 4$  in 1854, the mean temperature of the air having decreased one-fifth of a degree. The mean temperature of the air in the shade was  $80\cdot 6$ , the mean daily range  $11\cdot 34$ , and the range of the year  $38\cdot 4$ . The mean atmospheric pressure was  $29\cdot 205$  inches, the mean daily range  $\cdot 115$ ; and, owing perhaps to the storm in November, the annual range was so great as  $\cdot 928$  inch.

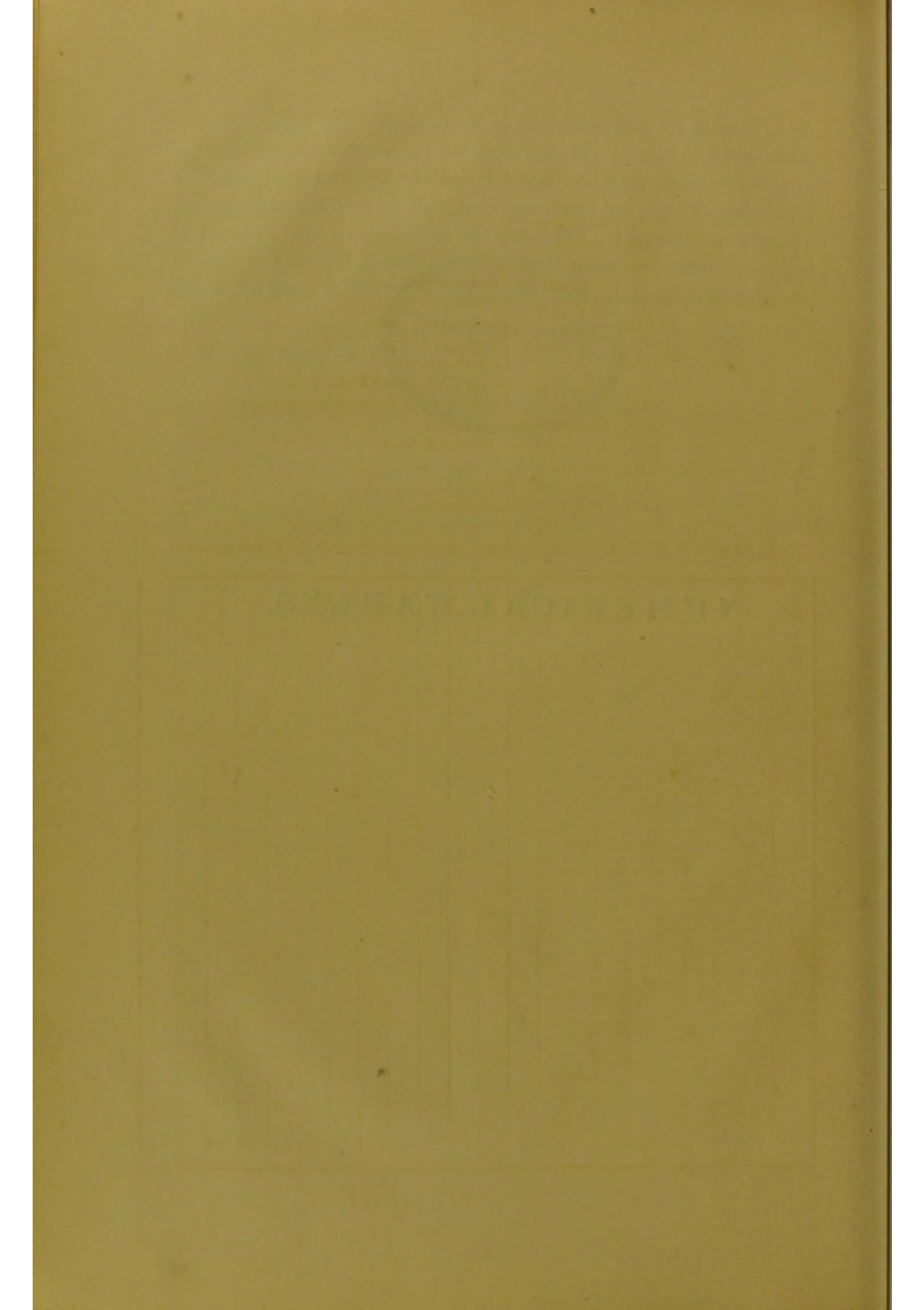
