NINTH

MORTUARY REPORT.

FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING 1ST FEBRUARY 1856.

THE Registration received more aid in the way of written reports than it had ever before got, these being one-seventh of the whole number; the increase being mostly towards the end of the year, and after the Government Circular (Appendix) was sent to Medical Practitioners and a letter was addressed to the Parsee Punchayet. The great assistance given by several of the Grant College Graduates in response to the Circular, is now duly acknowledged. If the effort of the Graduates thus evoked be vigorously sustained by them, and be joined in by the others in Medical practice, the value of these Tables will be greatly enhanced in future years.

2. The reported deaths during the year 1856 were 15,783, or 855 more than those of 1855, and 1,105 above the mean of the preceding eight years. Of these 288 were Still-born, which is 17 above the mean of former years, and 7 above last year's reported Still-born.

3. There were 2,151 deaths from Cholera, that being 412 more than in 1855, but below the average of former years. As had all along been observed, there was a preponderance of mortality from this cause in the districts lying along the sea-shore, and a very decided degree of freedom from it in the sections densely occupied by houses and without gardens. In former Reports, it was pointed out that Mahim appeared to be an exception to what was thought to be the rule, but on further investigation its immunity is found to be only apparent. In the absence of Population Tables, recourse was had to

a standard of comparison afforded by the mortality from all, excepting Epidemic causes; the effect of other causes being presumed to be nearly equally felt over all the Island. It is now, however, so manifest in the Returns that Fever deaths are reported in unequal ratios in different localities, that the mortality from Fever also is now excluded, and a standard is made consisting of the proportions of deaths in different localities from all causes, exclusive of Cholera, Small-pox, Measles, and Fever.

4. From the aggregate of the last nine years, it is found that Cholera is in excess in the following districts: *Dhobee-tulao, Girgaon, Mazagaon, Harbour, Chaoputee, Oomburkharee, Esplanade, Mahim, Wurlee, Seo, and Mahaluxmee*; with an intensity greatest in the first of these, and diminishing in the order given. It is below the standard in the following districts, the immunity from it being in diminishing series: *Fort, Mandwee, Khara-tulao, Bhooleshwur, Kamateepoora, Colaba*. When *Girgaon* and *Chaoputee* cease to be cocoanut plantations, there is reason to expect that their obnoxiousness to Cholera will be lessened, and that the expectation of life among their inhabitants will be increased. As the mortality from Cholera seems to depend so much on the moisture or dryness of the soil, it is a matter of grave importance that the efficiency of the drainage of the Island shall at least keep pace with the increased influx of water which will come from the Vehar works.

5. From *Small-pox*, the next of the usual Epidemic diseases, there was a lower mortality than had been registered in any of the preceding eight years; it amounted to only 200.

6. *Measles*, from which no death had been recorded in 1855, had 1 death attributed to it in August, 2 in October, 8 in November, 31 in December, and 122 in January; the year thus closing while the Epidemic was rapidly advancing. The mortality, as was to be expected, was chiefly among children. The deaths from all these three Epidemic causes were 2,515.

7. The registered deaths from other causes amounted to 12,980, being 1,086 in excess of the preceding year, but below the number in the year 1854. *Fever*, as usual, was the disease to which the larger portion of those deaths was ascribed. On examining the distribution of the Fever deaths during the past nine years, there is found reason to suppose that there are two causes to which its origin or its deadliness may be assigned; one is the vicinity of

Salsette with its extensive salt marshes, and the other is impure air, vitiated by a dense population, having imperfect means of disposing of the night-soil, and deficient scavenging.

8. The first of these causes appears to be most active in the northern end of the Island, or that part of it which is nearest to Salsette and most directly to the leeward of the marshes when the night land-wind blows. Thus while for the whole of Bombay the Fever deaths are to the other deaths, exclusive of the Epidemic, in the ratio of 544 per mille, they are in the F Division, which forms the northern end of the Island, in the ratio of 706 ; and in the A Division, which is the farthest south, and therefore most distant from Salsette, the ratio is but 481 per mille : in D and E, the more rural of the intermediate Divisions, the ratios are 524 and 514 respectively. Or if the separate districts of these Divisions be taken, it is found that in F, the district of *Seo*, which is nearest to the Salsette marshes, and most exposed to such morbid influences as may be wafted by the land-wind, the ratio is 763 ; in *Mahim*, the next in proximity, it is 691 ; and in *Wurlee*, the third in distance and order of exposure to the land-wind passing over Salsette, it is 651. In the *Parell* district of E, lying immediately to the south of the *Seo* and *Mahim* districts, the ratio is 564, while in the *Mahaluxmee* and *Walkeshwur* districts of D, it is 522 and 532 respectively. In A, the *Esplanade* has a ratio of Fever deaths of 517, the *Fort* 488, and *Colaba*, the extreme southern district, has the ratio of 424.

9. The reason for supposing that the evils attending dense population, with deficient cleanliness and ventilation, foster or aggravate Fever, is that in the most thickly peopled districts the ratio of Fever deaths is higher than in the surrounding districts less densely inhabited : thus *Mandwee* has the ratio 617, *Oomburkharee* 567, *Bhooleshwur* 551, *Market* 544, while the *Esplanade*, *Dhobee-tulao*, *Girgaon*, *Kamateepoora*, and *Mazagaon*, which nearly surround them, have ratios of Fever mortality varying from 498 to 528 per mille. The high mortality of 567 in *Tarwaree* is not yet accounted for ; the aggregate of deaths in that section is comparatively small, and it may be that when a larger amount of observations is accumulated, the ratio may be modified.

10. Such is the result of the observations of the past nine years. In estimating its value, it is to be borne in mind that the Causes of Death are

very far from being stated with perfect correctness, and that the absolute number of Fever deaths may be erroneously given; but it has, at the same time, to be considered, that it is probable that the same error pervades the reports of all the sections alike, and that the ratios are likely to approximate more nearly to the truth than do the sums. Again it is to be remembered that the observations from which the direction of the night-wind is deduced, were made at the extreme southern end of Colaba, a position possessing many advantages for the prosecution of the main objects of the Observatory, but from its distance of more than 11 miles from the part contiguous to Salsette, these observations may not afford a strictly true indication of what the winds, especially when light, are in a part so differently situated as to surrounding land and water. Observations on the azimuth of the wind ought to be taken at various parts of the Island, and, as a first step towards this, a wind-gauge might at once be placed at the Signal-station on Parell Hill, which seems a desirable position for the purpose.

11. There were unusually few deaths referred to disease of the Brain and Nervous System, the total being but 478, or 94 less than in the preceding year, or 92 less than the mean of former years. The deaths, however, from Apoplexy and Paralysis were increased: in those from Tetanus there was a diminution to the extent of 123.

12. In Class VI. there were 23 casualties, of which 7 were from Aneurism. The deaths from disease of the *Respiratory System* were 1,177, which is 76 per mille of the total mortality of the year, or 90 per mille if the usual Epidemic causes are excluded: both the aggregate number and the ratio are less than in 1856. There were 2,139 deaths registered under disease of the *Alimentary System*, which number is 214 in excess of that of last year, and about the same in excess of previous years. In Class IX. there were 10, the same small number as in 1856. In Class X. there were 147 reported deaths, nearly all of which occurred in Child-bed.

13. Of the 110 deaths in Class XI. there were 24 attributed to Guinea-worm, and if the 5 cases in which it is stated to have been the cause of Traumatic Tetanus be added, the total deaths in the year from this parasite of the integuments amounted to 29.

14. The deaths entered in Class XII. amounted to 1,113, a number much in excess of that of last year, and 491 greater than the average of

former years. The increase is under the head *Debility*, and can best be accounted for by supposing that those employed to receive the Death Reports carelessly omitted to ascertain what was the cause of the debility. The reported deaths from *Leprosy* were 32, the mean number having before been 45; and the number from *Dropsy* 162, which also was below the average.

15. From violent deaths 143 were reported to have perished, of whom 48 were drowned; 14 in the sea and 34 in fresh waters. In the 27 instances in Class XVI. the causes of death were not specified.

16. The distribution of the deaths among the various races and sections of the Community was nearly in the following millesimal proportions:—Brahmuns, 23 per mille; Lingaets and Bhatias, 18; Hindoos of other caste, 510; Out-caste Hindoos 60; or adding together all of Brahmunicipal religion, the amount was 611 in a thousand. The Boodhists, chiefly Jains, were 38 in a thousand. The Moosulmans, including the Negro-Africans, as they are mostly of that religion, 245. The Parsees were 47 per mille; the Jews, 4; Native-Christians, 34; Indo-Europeans, 4; Europeans, 14; or adding all classes of Christians together, these were 52 in a thousand.

17. As many come to Bombay unaccompanied by their families, the above numbers do not show the true proportions that the deaths among those who may be in the vigour of years bear to each other. Taking therefore from the Tables the numbers of males above 14 and under 55 years of age, it is found that of the Boodhists there were 42 in a thousand; of the Hindoos of all kinds, 609; Moosulmans, 240; Parsees, 23; Native-Christians, 46; Indo-Europeans, 4; Europeans, 30; or of all Christians together, 80.

18. The proportion of male to female deaths is subject to very considerable yearly variation, although the male always greatly exceed the female, and during the nine years in which the deaths have been noted, the proportion has ranged from 115 to 132 of the males to every 100 of the females: in 1856 it was 126 $\frac{3}{4}$. In eight of these years the ratio of disparity between males and females in the returns has risen or fallen with the increase or diminution in the aggregate of deaths, and on referring to the different periods of life in the Tables, this correspondence has been observed only at ages above 20 and under 55, or the ages at which male temporary sojourners on the Island are likely to be most numerous. These observations tend to the conclusion that the higher mortality of some years, and the lower of others,

is partly to be attributed to there being more adult male lives at risk in the former than in the latter. The year 1849 was the only year in which this accordance of the ratio with the aggregate of deaths was not observed.

19. Of the dead, 7,143 were said to have been born in Bombay, 8,559 elsewhere, and of 81 the birth-place was unknown. The families of only 2,877 were said to belong to Bombay, and in 73 instances no information on this point was obtained. There were buried 9,953; there were 5,082 burnt, and 748 were exposed in the Parsee cemeteries.

20. From the Meteorological Observations it is found that the mean temperature of the year was $80^{\circ}3$, which is merely $\frac{1}{5}$ of a degree above the average of the preceding eight years; the mean daily range of thermometer was $10^{\circ}6$, or 1 degree less than the average of former years; and the mean humidity of the air was $\cdot 78$, or 1 per cent. more than in 1855. The rain gauged at the Observatory was 65.93 inches, while the average of the preceding eight years was 61.24 inches. It is likely that less rain falls at the Observatory than at any other part of the Island; it has been found that considerably more falls in the Fort, and still more at Byculla, than at Colaba.

APPENDIX.

GENERAL DEPARTMENT.

With a view to ensure correct Registration of Deaths in the Island of Bombay and Colaba, the Right Honorable the Governor in Council requests that all Medical Practitioners, European and Native, will furnish a Death Report, according to the annexed Form, in every fatal case occurring under their respective care or observation, to the Friends of the deceased, to be delivered by them, or by the Funeral Party, or by the Undertaker, at the time of the Funeral, to the Policeman at the place of burial.

It is unnecessary to point out to those who have received a liberal medical education, the usefulness of correct Mortuary Returns for sanitary purposes, as well as for other objects of medical and statistical science, for of this they must already be aware; but as hitherto that detailed information as to the causes of death, which it is reasonable to expect from Members of the Medical Profession in Bombay, has not been satisfactorily supplied, the Right Honorable the Governor in Council considers it necessary to remind the Medical Practitioners of this community that the correctness and value of the Mortuary Registration depend much, in this particular point, on their zealous co-operation.

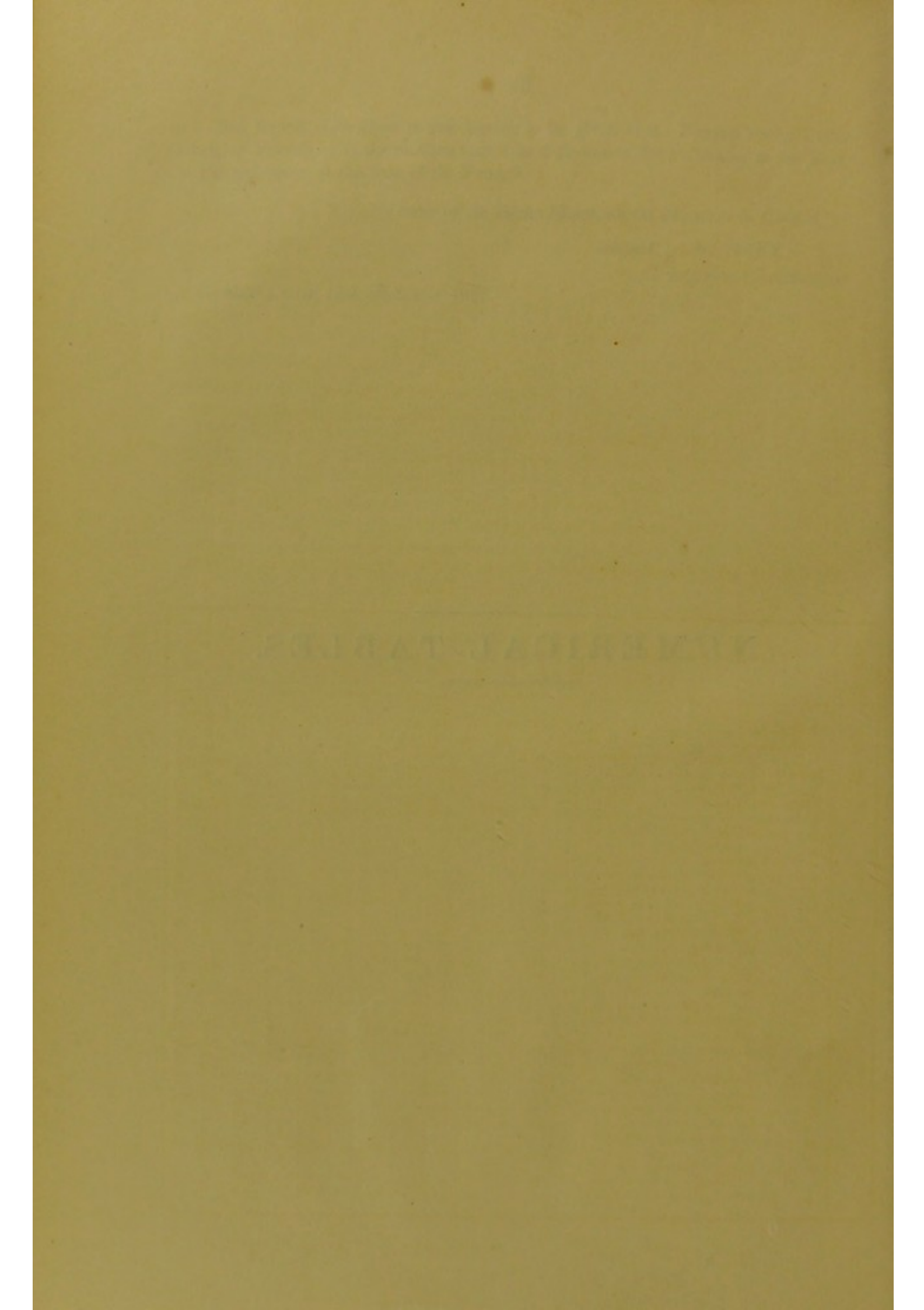

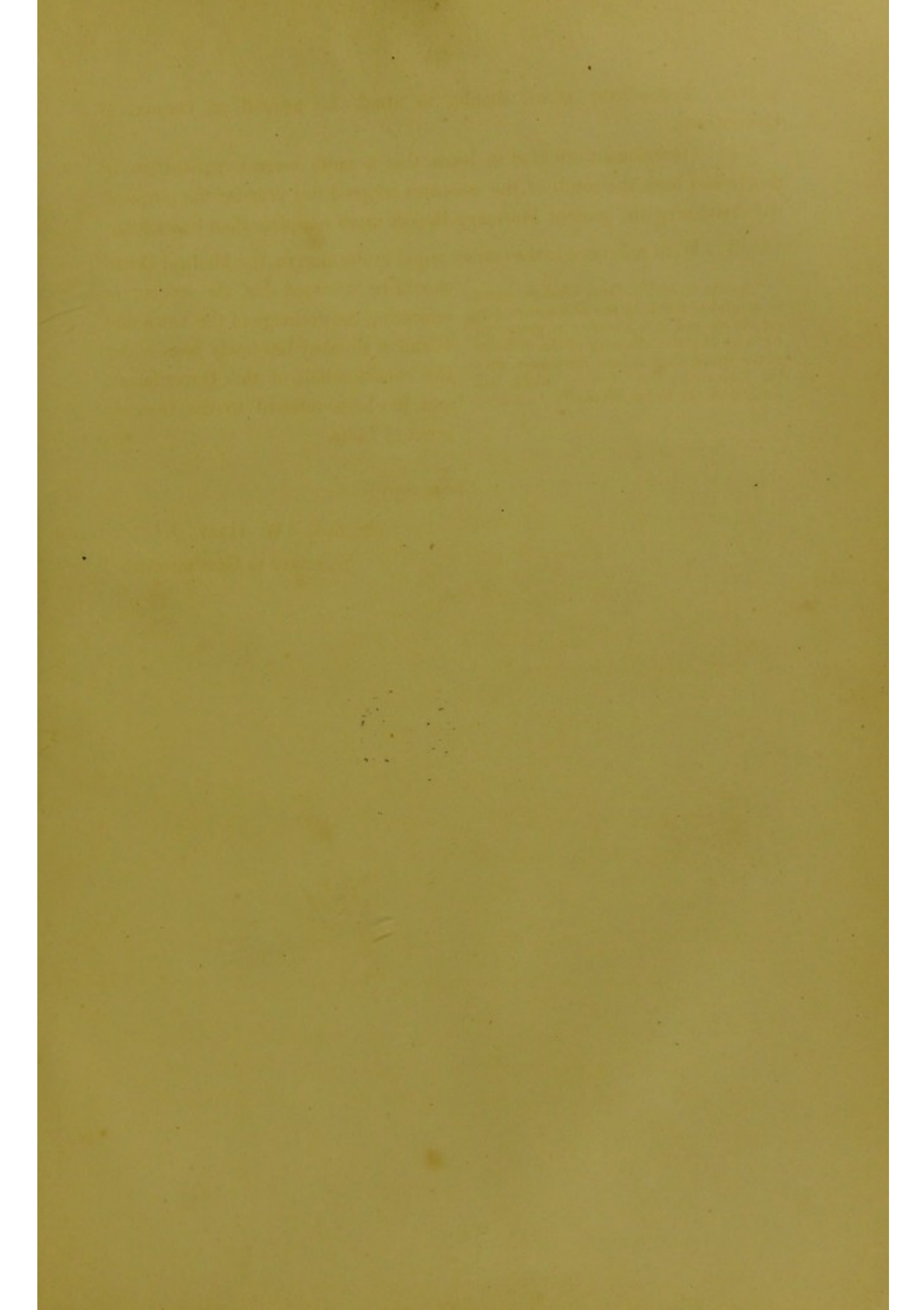
