FOURTEENTH MORTUARY REPORT.

FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING 1ST FEBRUARY 1861.

THE Returns of the past year show a somewhat higher rate of mortality than usual. Exclusive of the Still-born, 15,863 deaths have occurred, viz. 8,949 males and 6,914 females. The excess of male over female deaths is unusually large, being in the ratio of 129·4 males to 100 females, while the average ratio is but 124. The fluctuations in the ratio are, however, very great, and seem difficult to be accounted for even on the supposition that the difference is chiefly owing to the changes in the floating population.

2. The deaths from *Cholera* were 1,251, about half the average number. Of these, 1,091 occurred in the two last months of the statistical year, December and January. The disease appears to have broken out first in an epidemic form among the families in the Native Infantry lines on the Esplanade, from whence it rapidly spread to the native town. Girgaon has contributed even more than its usual high proportion of victims to this terrible scourge. The low-lying districts of Kamatee-poorā and Dhobee Tulao come next in order.

3. *Small-pox*, almost absent last year, has been this year excessively fatal, having carried off 1,600 persons. The average number of deaths is about 660. It raged as usual through the first six months of the year, commencing in January with 32 deaths, and ceasing, or nearly so, by August. With the exception of one year, 1858, when there were 1,656 deaths, no such mortality from small-pox has occurred since the registration commenced. Whatever may be the cause, there appears to be a singular regularity in the recurrence of the epidemic outbreaks of *Small-pox*; the disease assuming increased activity pretty constantly every third year. The following years have been marked by a large mortality from *Small-pox*:—1850, 1852, 1855, 1858,

and 1861. The victims have, as usual, been chiefly children between one month and four years of age ; but, unlike what has been previously observed, it will be noticed (Table XXV.) that a sudden increase in the number of deaths occurs between the ages of 14 and 34, apparently indicating, in accordance with other statistics in these Tables, an unusual influx of adults from other parts, probably less protected by vaccination than even the inhabitants of Bombay.

4. The mortality from *Measles* was 76 only, against an average of 270, making a total of epidemic diseases of 2,927, which is rather less than the average; the excess of mortality is therefore due to diseases which are not of an epidemic character.

5. *Fever* was said to be the cause of 7,024 deaths, and Disease of the *Nervous System* of 701,—both numbers somewhat greater than usual. Disease of the *Respiratory System* was fatal to 1,033, the mean of the last 13 years being 1,328. The numbers recorded under this head have been diminishing during the last ten years. Diseases of the *Alimentary System* carried off 2,078, which is a large increase upon the mortality of the last three years, though not greatly in excess of the average. Under Cachexies and Debility 1,404 deaths were registered, which is still more than last year, and nearly twice the average. Of these, 1,182 or 84 per cent. were children less than 15 days old.

6. To diseases of the *Circulatory System* 35 deaths are attributed; to *Diseases* of the *Urinary System* 24; *Child-bearing* and the diseases incident thereto carried off 141 females; 12 deaths from *Leprosy* are recorded; 128 from *Dropsy*, and 12 from *Unknown Causes*.

7. The *Violent Deaths* were 209, the largest number that have yet occurred in a single year. Of these, 9 were carriage accidents, 76 died from drowning, and 21 from falls. 8 persons were suffocated by falling earth; 24 were crushed or suffocated by falling houses, and 4 were killed by the fall of masses of rock,—a total of 36; a great loss of life due to preventible causes, and for which a serious responsibility rests on the owners or managers of the property.

8. The *Still-born* were 337, of which were males 214, females 123; thus to every 100 females, 174 males were still-born—a large excess, yet less than that recorded last year. Of the 16,200 deaths, including the still-born, 10,559 bodies were buried, 4,736 burnt, and 905 exposed to carrion birds. The place of birth of 8,148 was Bombay, of 7,962 elsewhere, and of 90 it was unknown. 1,935 written reports were received, or 12 per cent. of the whole.

9. From the Meteorological Observations it appears that the year was in some respects exceptional. The barometric pressure varied little from the annual mean, but the mean temperature was only 79.1° against an average of 80.2° . The mean dew-point was also lower than usual, being 71.3° , though the degree of saturation of the atmosphere at the recorded temperature, or the percentage of humidity, was the same as usual, viz. 79 per cent. The wind blew from the sea a mean of $20\frac{1}{2}$ hours, or three quarters of an hour more than the average, and from the land $3\frac{1}{2}$ hours. The rain-fall at Colaba was 76 inches on 97 days, the average being 70 inches on 99 days. I have this year appended a column showing the rain-fall at Byculla, which is almost always considerably in excess of that at Colaba. 106 inches of rain fell on 94 days. The average rain-fall at Byculla is about 80 inches. The year was in fact an unusually wet one, which partly accounts for the mean annual temperature being lower.

10. If we omit the first year of registration, 1848, as the Returns may be supposed to be then somewhat incomplete, and compare the next six years, from 1849 to 1854, with the following six, 1855 to 1860, we shall find that the mean annual mortality in the first period is 14,605, and in the second 15,019, an increase of only 3 per cent. But the proportion of deaths which occur in the different localities is not exactly the same. In the following districts a decided increase has taken place:—*Girgaon, Kamatee-poor, Mazagon, Colaba, Dhobee-tulao, Walkeshwar, Mahaluxmee*. In the following a decrease:—Fort, Market, Khara-tulao, Parell, Seo, Mahim, Water Division. This accords on the whole with what may be supposed to be the general movement of the population: Kamatee-poor and Mazagon have been getting more and more thickly populated, and also the hill districts of Walkeshwar and Mahaluxmee. The signs of increased population in Girgaon are not so marked, and the greater mortality is probably due in great part to the increasing insalubrity of the district. On the other hand, the diminished mortality in the Fort is perhaps attributable to the removal elsewhere of the residence of many whose offices are within the walls, the increasing value of house-room compelling them to seek other dwellings. Efforts have been made during the last two years to improve the drainage of Kamateepoor, but there has been hitherto little effect in diminishing the mortality; in fact the deaths during the past year are by far more numerous than in any previous year. The whole district lies so low, being below high water mark of spring tides, that the most complete system of local drainage is insufficient, without a properly constructed low-level sewer, into

which the local drains may discharge themselves. It is to be feared that unless steps are soon taken to supply this want, this district, tenanted by a rapidly increasing population of not the cleanliest habits, may become a very focus of epidemic disease. The large tannery in this neighbourhood, and the fœtid open ditches which are gorged with the refuse matter apparently flowing therefrom, contribute not a little to the offensive emanations which render it so unpleasant a task to pass through the district.

11. The information which these Tables are capable of conveying is confined to a few particulars. They record the yearly fluctuations in the mortality, whether from epidemic or non-epidemic causes, distinguishing the caste or race, the sex, the age, the month of the year, the occupation, and the place of residence. But these are little more than naked facts; it is extremely hazardous to attempt to draw from them any but the very simplest deductions. In fact, all the important conclusions to be derived from statistics of population cannot be touched, such as—the duration of life in the several castes or races, sexes, occupations, and localities, and its variation from time to time with the altered circumstances of the place. The practical conclusions deduced from a knowledge of these latter facts would be of the highest utility in suggesting means for ameliorating the health of the crowded population of this town, and diminishing the mortality.

12. The element wanting to this end, is a systematic enumeration of the population—a Census. It will be remembered that an attempt to take a census of the inhabitants of Bombay was made in the year 1849. The reported population was then 566,119, but from imperfections in the method employed, and from the internal evidence furnished by the detailed results, it is believed that very little confidence can be placed in the enumeration then made. A repetition of the census on a better plan has been frequently urged by the originator of these Tables, Dr. Leith. The following passages may be adduced from previous Mortuary Reports:—

“Six years of the Registration of the Deaths in Bombay are now completed, and the information gathered has been duly arranged, as was proposed, in anticipation of a census, which it was hoped would render the facts being accumulated truly valuable. At present these Mortuary Tables can be turned to only very limited use, and they are somewhat like what a Surveyor's system of triangles would be without a measured base line. It is greatly to be desired that measures may be adopted to render the approaching Census of the island correct, for it is better to be without a Return of the population

than to have one so inaccurate as that of 1849. Without a legal enactment such as is had recourse to in Britain, to render the giving the requisite information compulsory on the inhabitants, it seems almost impossible that a correct enumeration of the people can be made; for without such compulsion, with a population so large as to yield 14,000 dead a year, so diversified in race, and so little likely to give active aid in the work, although disposed to be passive, as this community is known to be, a very large establishment of enumerators would be required; and setting aside the very heavy expense of their maintenance, it would be difficult to find a sufficient number of men available and otherwise qualified for the work."—*From the Report for 1853.*

"The time for another Census is near, and I would with due respect state, that from the utter failure of the two former attempts at an enumeration of the people, I am of opinion that it is impracticable to take a correct Census in Bombay by other means than those that are used in Britain; and there does not appear to be any valid reason why a legal enactment should not be had recourse to here, to obtain from the people that information which it is for the people's good to collect, which is necessary to allow of sanitary measures being undertaken with confidence, and which the Government of every civilized country has or ought to possess. There is not among the Natives of this place, as those who have local experience well know, any religious objection to afford all the usual information connected with Vital or Mortuary statistics, such as those at a distance are too apt to imagine may exist."—*From the Report for 1854.*

13. I cannot but adopt without reserve these statements and suggestions, and I would respectfully urge, as a preliminary measure, the passing of an Act of the Legislative Council, rendering it compulsory on every householder to give the requisite information, and authorizing the infliction of a penalty for the wilfully giving a false return.

14. It can scarcely admit of a doubt, that during the last twelve years the population has received a great accession; the streets are more crowded, the signs of commercial activity are everywhere more conspicuous, many spaces then vacant are now built over; yet it is not a little remarkable in how trifling a degree the mortality has increased. The probability certainly is that in proportion to the population the health of the town is better now than it was twelve years ago. If this change is to be at all attributed to the partial improvements which have been effected in the drainage, to the establishment of

dispensaries, and to a few other hygienic measures,—the most sanguine hopes may be entertained of the effects of carrying out a complete system of drainage for the whole town, such as that recently proposed; and the speedy adoption of so eminently desirable a step cannot be too strongly urged. This completed, and the population of each district enumerated and classified, the comparative healthiness of the several districts will be at once seen, and an unfavourable return will be the immediate signal for further sanitary improvements.

15. From the advantages which this town already possesses, its favorable insular situation, its pure and invigorating sea breeze, its copious and excellent water supply, and the abundance of open space for air and recreation which it now affords, and it is to be hoped may long continue to afford,—when the streets are widened, and the water supply rendered more accessible to all, and when a thorough house drainage and an effective sewerage system shall have been established,—there is no reason why Bombay should not rank among the very healthiest of tropical cities.

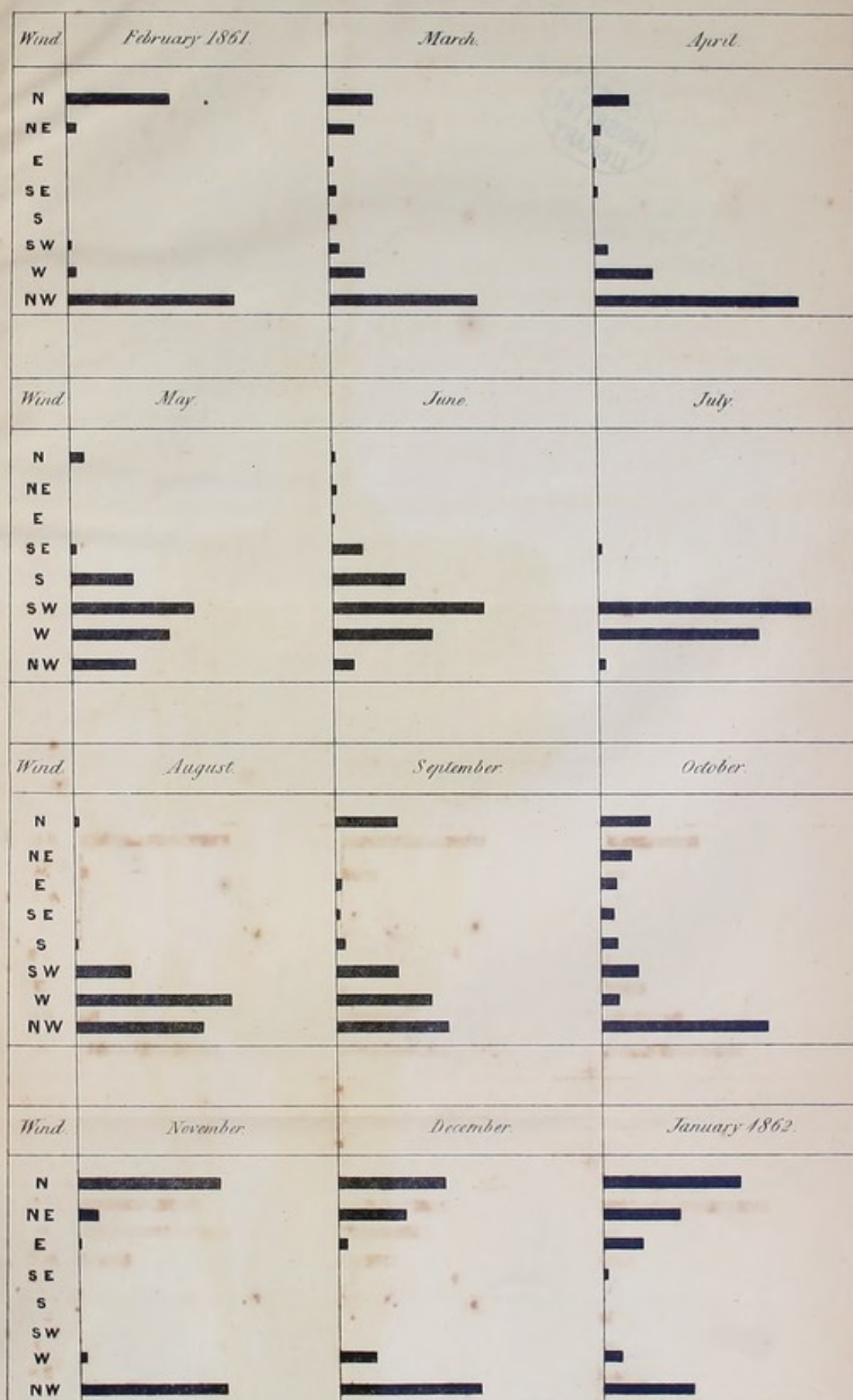

Scale 200 hours to an Inch.

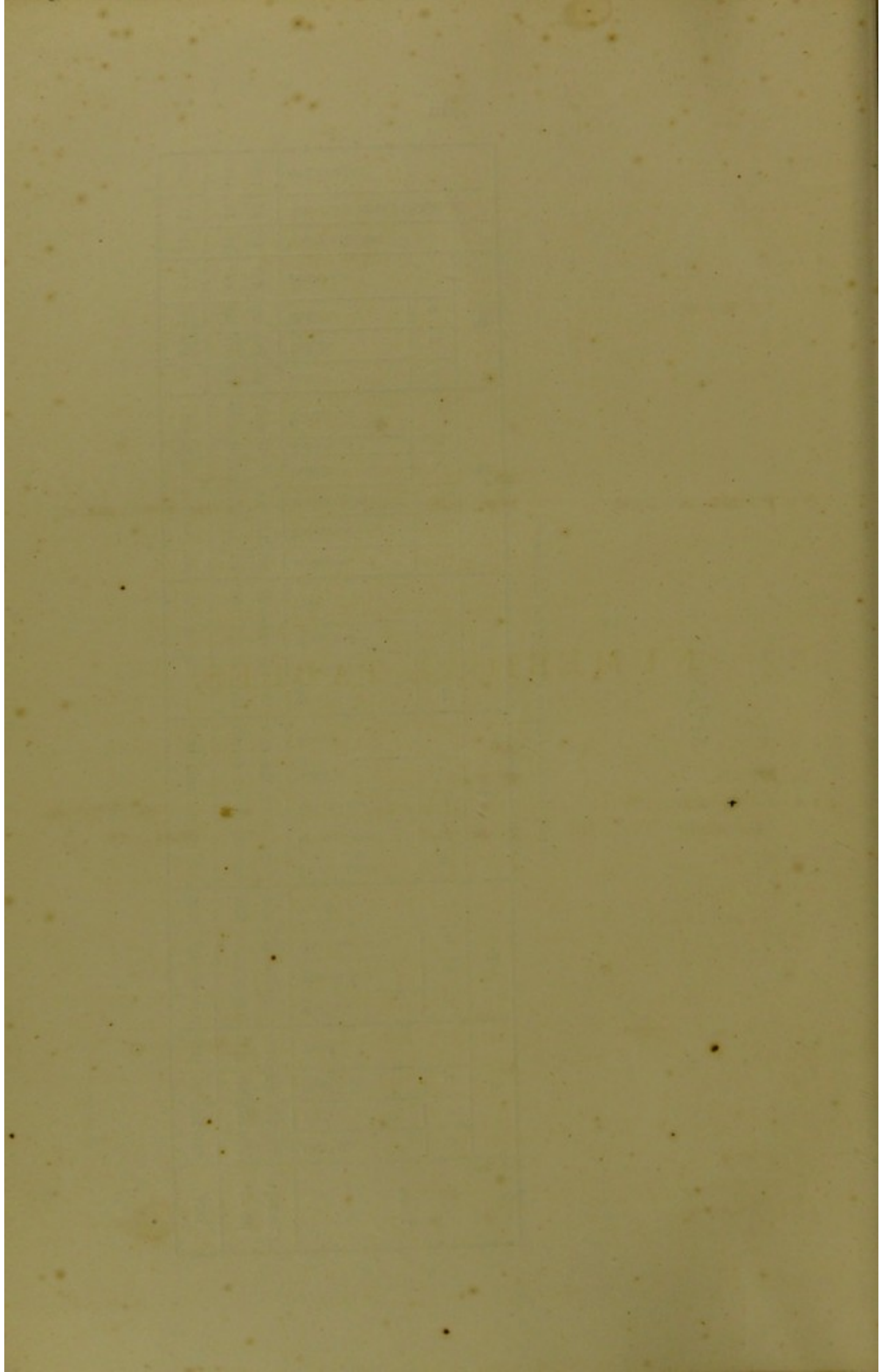

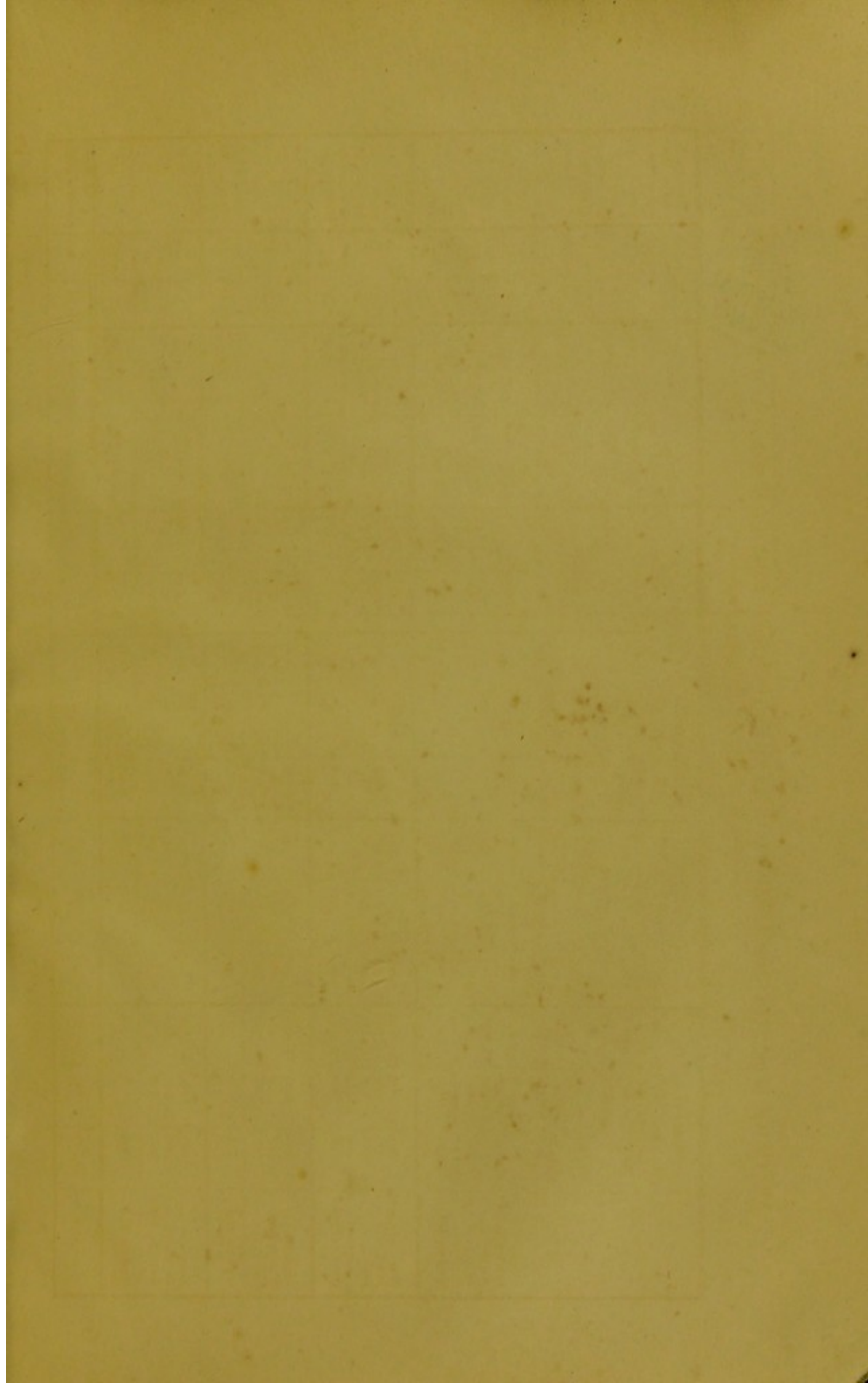
