With a view to uniformity, the early dates have been reduced to the New Style, established in the British Islands in the year 1752: To restore the original Dates, therefore, eleven days must be subtracted from the printed Dates, down to that year inclusive; thus Saturday, December 7, 1737, N. S.—11 Days,—Saturday, November 26, 1737, O. S. &c.
