A COPY OF THE

L A W S

For the Regulation of the Medical Library
at the GENERAL INFIRMARY at HULL,
1st of January, 1784.

I. THAT the Books, Plates, and all
the Appurtenances of the Medical
Library, be the Property of the GENERAL
INFIRMARY at HULL; but that a majority
of the Subscribers reserve to themselves a
Power to sell, or exchange such Books, as
they think proper, for the improvement of
the Library.

II. That the use of the Library be confin'd
solely to the Gentlemen of the Faculty in
HULL, and to those residing within twenty
Miles thereof.

III. That every Subscriber from the above
date pay Two Guineas Entrance, and Half
a Guinea annually; or on advancing Six
Guineas at one time; or Books amounting
to that Value, approved off by the Com-
mittee; shall have an equal Right with a
perpetual Subscriber.

IV. That any Person wishing to become
a Subscriber after the second Monday in
July 1784, pay Two Guineas Entrance, and
Half a Guinea annually.

V. That every Subscriber, during his
Subscription, or Benefaction, qualified as
above, may have any Book out of the Library

by sending for it, or may read in the Library Room between the Hours of Ten and Twelve in the Morning, and from Two to Four in the Afternoon, Sundays excepted.

VI. That the second Mondays in January, April, July, and October, at Half past Twelve o'Clock in the Forenoon be the Days appointed for Quarterly Meetings to be held in the General Infirmary, to determine on the purchasing such Books as the majority shall agree upon, not exceeding the Sum in Hand.

VII. That a Committee of not fewer than three Subscribers, do meet the second Tuesday in every Month, in the General Infirmary, at Half past Twelve o'Clock, and have power to order any New Publication; and in case three Subscribers do not meet within Half an Hour of the time appointed, every absent Subscriber residing in HULL shall pay one Shilling.

VIII. That the Apprentices or Pupils of the Subscribers, be allowed to enjoy the advantages of the Library, on paying Two Guineas in advance, or Half a Guinea annually.

IX. That the General Meeting be held annually in the Infirmary, on the second Monday in April, at Half past Twelve o'Clock in the Forenoon.

X. That in every Book given to the Medical Library, the Donor's Name be inserted.

XI. That the Apothecary be appointed Librarian, who shall see that all the Books be properly arrang'd, and each Volume dis-

tinctly number'd, and he shall keep an Alphabetical Catalogue of all the Books, Manuscripts, Pamphlets, &c. expressing the Edition, place where Printed, date, size, price and number, as they stand in the Library.

XII. That the Librarian shall annually make a Catalogue of the Books, and Manuscripts in the Library, also take an account of all the Books belonging to the Library that are wanting, and the name of the Person to whom they were last delivered, and this Catalogue and Account shall be laid before the Subscribers at their general Meeting.

XIII. That the time allowed for Reading each Book be fix'd by the Committee, and the forfeit for keeping Books beyond the limited time be One Penny *per Day*, but in no case to exceed the price of the Book kept, and that the Fines received be given to the Librarian.

XIV. That Subscribers residing in the Country, shall be allowed two Volumes of a Set, to be kept only the Time fixed for Reading one of them, or till the first Market-Day after the Time limited for keeping it expires.

XV. That no Subscriber shall lend a Library Book to any Person out of his own House, or receive one belonging to the Library, from any other Person than the Librarian, under the Penalty of Two Shillings and Six-pence.

XVI. That none but Medical Books, or Books entirely connected with Medicine be purchased.

XVII. That no Subscriber under the penalty of One Shilling, take out any Book without the knowledge of the Librarian.

XVIII. That the annual Subscription be paid in advance, and all Fines at the first Quarterly Meeting after they are incur'd, and that no Subscriber have a Book from the Library, until he has paid his Subscription, and the Fines he may have incur'd.

XIX. That if any Book taken out of the Library be lost or defaced, the Person who took it out shall pay the Value of it ; but if the Book belong to a Set, he shall take the remaining Volumes and pay for the whole, or otherwise make the Set compleat.

XX. That no Subscriber residing in HULL shall take out more than one Book and one Pamphlet at a time.

XXI. That any Subscriber making Application to the Librarian for a Book not then in the Library, shall be at Liberty to enter his Name, and the title of the Book, in a Book kept for that purpose ; and that no Subscriber take back any Book, return'd by him, if any other Subscriber has applied for it before the Time of its return.

XXII. That a recommendatory Book be kept by the Librarian for any Subscriber to insert the Titles of such Books as he may wish to have purchased.

XXIII. That if any difficulty arise, not expressly determined by these Laws, it shall be determined by the Committee, and their transactions and determinations shall be recorded in a Book kept for that purpose.

XXIV. That no Person be considered a Member of this Library, who does not consent to be governed by these laws.

XXV. That as this Library is to be the property of the Infirmary, a Donation from any Person, who wishes to promote so useful and laudable an Institution, will be thankfully received.
