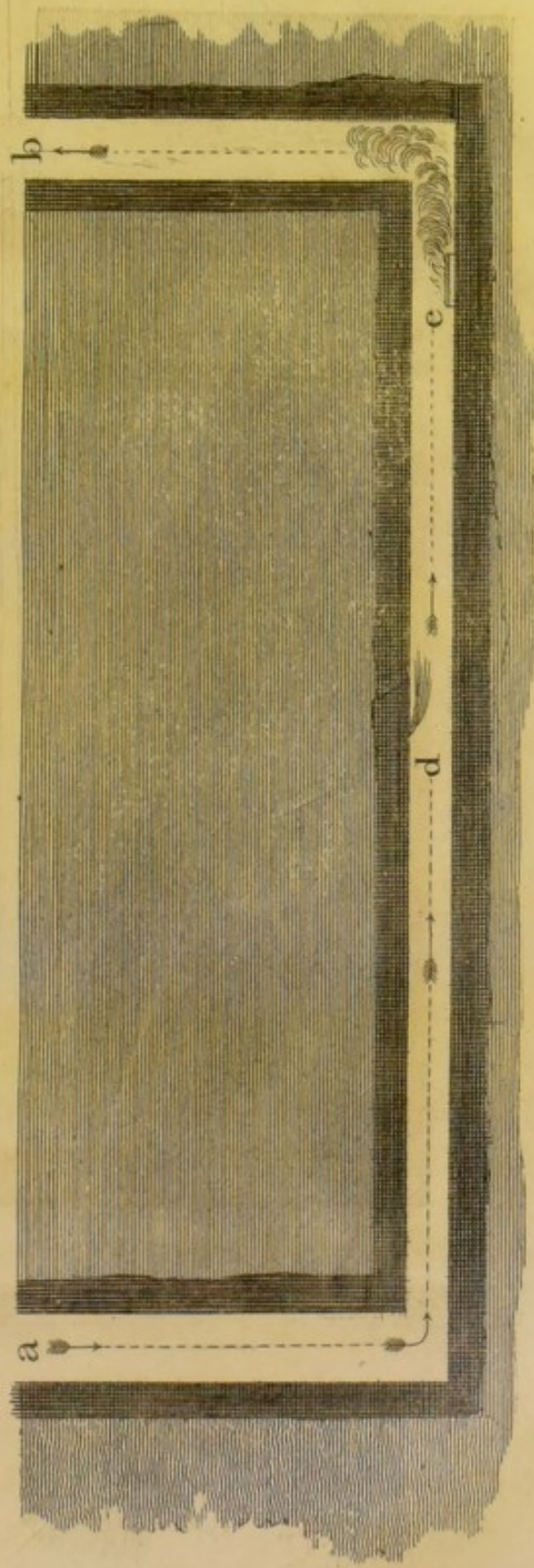
Page 9. line 1, the comma is put after g, instead of c.
