Incorporating the Trustees of *George Simpson*, Esquire's, Hospital.

WHEREAS George Simpson, late of the City of Dublin, Efquire, deceased, did, by his Last-will and Tef-A 2 tament

Preamble.

tament, bearing Date on cr about the eleventh Day of December, One thousand seven hundred and seventy-eight, (among other Things therein contained) give, devise, and bequeath unto his Wife, Catherine Simpson, the Use and Enjoyment of his Dwelling-House in Jervis Street, Dublin, Recital of during her Life; and from and after her Decease, he devised and bequeathed the fame in Manner therein and herein after-mentioned, and did thereby devise and bequeath unto his Friend James Forbes, Merchant, his Bishop's Leafe of the Lands of Carrowneglera, and other Lands in the County of Roscommon, as alfo his fmall Estate in the fame County,

County, in the Polleffion of Mr. Potts; alfo his Estate and Premises in Little Butter-Lane, Dublin, likewife his Effate and Lands of Pelletstown, in the County of Dublin; also his Houses and Premises in Frederick-Street, Dublin, with all his Term and Intereft therein, in Truft, in the first Place to pay off the Ground-Rent payable thereout, and then to permit his faid Wife to receive and take the clear Rents payable thereout during her natural Life; and from and after her Decease, then to the Uses and Purpofes therein and herein after particularly mentioned : And the faid George Simpson, after bequeathing feveral Sums of Money to charitable

charitable Uses, and other Purpofes, did, by his faid Will, give, devife, and bequeath all the Reft; refidue, and Remainder of his Real, Freehold, and perfonal Fortune, (including therein the before-mentioned Houfes, Lands, and Premifes so bequeathed to, and in Trust for his faid Wife, from and after her Decease,) unto his Friends James Forbes, Travers Hartley, Thomas Read, Redmond Morris, Morgan Crofton, Edward Strettell, Jame Ford, The Reverend Doctor Robert Law, Allexander Jaffray, William Barton, Nevill Forth, Martin Brownley, Mathew Coleman, and his said Wife Catherine Simpson, and the Survivors and Survivor of them,

them, and their respective Succefsors, in Truft, thereby and thereout to erect, fupport, and maintain an Hofpital for the Reception of fuch poor decayed, blind, and gouty Men, as they fhall think worthy of fuch a Charity, with Power in them, and the Survivors and Succefsors of them, to lay out at Interest, or in a Purchase, without Rifk to themfelves, and to demife, fet, fell, or otherwise dispose of, all or any Part of the faid Refidue, as they shall think most proper for the Ufes and Purpofes of the faid intended Charity, with a further Power in them, and their Survivors and Succeffors, to elect and appoint any other fit and proper Perfons

fons as Truftees with them, who are to have the fame Powers and Authorities as the faid other Truffees; and of his faid Will, appointed his faid Wife, and the faid James Forbes and Thomas Read, Executors; and the faid Catherine Simpson and James Forbes have obtained a Probate thereof, under the Seal of His Majesty's Court of Prerogative, and taken upon them the Burthen and Execution thereof.

Reciting And whereas the faid Thomas the Election Read is fince dead, and Mr. of Mr. George Read is fince dead, and Mr. Sutton, in the George Sutton, Merchant, hath Room of Mr. Read, debeen fince duly elected in his ceased. Room, and the faid other furviving Truftees have feverally accepted

accepted of the faid Truft, and are defirous to carry the humane Intention of the faid George Simpson into immediate Execution, but being apprehenfive that the Powers fo vested in them by the faid Will, are not fufficiently explicit to enable them to effectuate the Defign and Intention of the Testator, are defirous that a Corporation shall be crected by Act of Parliament, effectually to Anfwer the charitable Intentions of the faid George Simpson, and that the Real, Freehold, and Perfonal Fortunes devifed to the faid Truftees, and their Successors, shall be vested in them as a Body. Corporate, upon the fame Trufts,

Trufts, and to the like Intents and Purposes, and under the fame Rules and Directions, as in and by the faid Will of the faid *George Simpson* are expressed and intended.

The first enacting Clause appointing the Trustees a Corporate Body.

At the humble Petition, therefore, of the faid Catherine Simpson, James Forbes, Travers Hartley, Redmond Morris, Morgan Crofton, Edward Strettell, James Ford, The Reverend Doctor Robert Law, Alexander Jaffray, William Barton, Nevill Forth, Martin Brownley, Mathew Coleman, and George Sutton, and for the Purposes aforefaid : Be it enacted by the King's most Excellent Majesty, by and with the Advice and Confent

Confent of the Lords Spiritual and Temporal, and Commons in this prefent Parliament affembled, and by the Authority of the fame, That from and after the first Monday after the paffing of this Act, there be, and shall be a Corporation for ever, for the Execution of the faid Laftwill of the faid George Simpson, fo far forth as the fame relates to the faid Hospital fo intended to be erected as aforefaid, and to answer the feveral Intents and Purposes therein contained, and herein aftermentioned, which Corporati. on shall confift of the feveral Truftees herein beforementioned, that is to fay, Catherine Simpson,

Simpson, widow of the faid George Simpson, James Forhes, Travers Hartley, Redmond Morris, Morgan Crofton, Edward. Strettell, James Ford, The Reverend Doctor Robert Law. Provided always, That no No Mem-Member of the faid Corpora-ber of the Corporation tion fhall ever be elsted to, to hold any or permitted to hold any lu-Employment crative Employment under, under them. or receive any Salary or Wages from the faid Corporation.

And be it enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That the Receiver,

Receiver and other Officers to give Security.

ceiver, and all and every other then the Officers fo to be appointed in purfuance of this Act, fhall, before they fhall be permitted to enter upon Office, give fuch good and fufficient Security for the just and faithful Discharge of their respective Offices as the Truftees fhall think proper, and fhall at all Times be accountable to the faid Truftees, or their Committee, when required; and that every such Receiver shall be obliged, from Time to Time, to lodge the Monies. to be received by him by virtue of his Office, within fortyeight Hours after he shall have received the fame, in fuch Bank as the faid Truftees, or any five of them, shall direct,

to be accountable for the fame to the faid Truftees on any Quarterly Day; and that all All Officers to account and every the Officers fo to be yearly, that is, on the first appointed, shall be obliged, on Monday in the first Monday in February in Feb. in every Year, or every Year, or oftener, if re- oftener, if quired, to give in a particular required. Account in Writing, figned by him and them, of all Receipts, Payments, and Difburfements of the faid Corporation, and the fame shall be then examined, audited, and fubfcribed by the faid Truftees, or any five of them; and shall then also give in a true and exact State of the Funds of the faid Corporation, in order that they may be examined and entered in a Book to be kept for that Purpose,

Purpose, such Book, and all other the Books and Papers of the faid Corporation, to be at all Times open and free for the perufal of the feveral Members thereof.

After the Decease of Mrs. Simpral Estates devised to her, and all other the Estates of Mr. Simpson, from and Monday after passing this Act, to vest in the Trustees, and their Successors.

And be it further enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That son, the seve-from and after the decease of the faid Catherine Simpson, all the Real, Freehold, and Perfonal Eftate of the faid George Simpson fo devifed to, and in after the first Truft for her as aforefaid, and all other the Real, Freehold, and Perfonal Eftate of the faid George Simpson, from the first Monday after the paffing of this Act, fubject to the Payment of his Debts, Funeral Expences, Annuities,

Annuities, and Legacies, if any fuch remain unpaid, shall be, and the fame are hereby vested in the Truftees of the faid Hof. pital, and their Succeffors, during the feveral and refpective Estates, Terms, and Interefts therein, upon the several ` Trufts, and to the fame Ufes, and for the fame Purpofes, as in and by the faid Last-will and Testament of the faid George Simpson are directed, appointed, and intended concerning the fame, and to and for no other Use, Intent, or Purpose whatsoever.

And be it further enacted by No other the Authority aforefaid, That Churity to be bleaded with no other Charity whatfoever this. C fhall

fhall hereafter by the faid Truftees be blended or incorporated with the faid intended Charity, but that the fame fhall at all Times for ever hereafter remain fole and diffinct from every other Charity.

Trustees to have Power to purchase not exceeding 1000l. a Year:

And be it enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That the faid Truftees of the faid Hofpital, and their Succeffors, shall and may purchafe, have, take, and enjoy to them and their Succeffors, any Manors, Lands, Tenements, Annuities, or Hereditaments, in Poffeffion, Reverfion, or Contingency, not exceeding in Value the yearly Sum of One thousand Pounds Sterling in the whole, of any Perfon

Perfon or Perfons having a Right, and not being otherwife difabled to alien or grant the fame, who are hereby enabled to transfer and grant the fame without Licence in Mortmain; and that it shall and may be lawful, to and for the faid Trustees of the faid Hospital, or the majority of them prefent, at any Corporate Affembly, not being less than nine, from time to time, by Indenture, under their Common Seal, to demife and to set for or leafe any Lands, Tenements, any Term, in Cities or or Hereditaments, vested in Towns, not them in purfuance of this Act, exceeding or any Part or Parcel thereof, for any Term or Number of Years, in Cities or Towns Corporate, for Building, not exceeding the Term of ninety-C 2 nine

99 Years, or nine Years, and in any other in any other Place for 3 Lives, or 31 Years.

Place, not exceeding the Term of three Lives, or for any Number of Years not exceeding thirty one Years, fo as upon every fuch Demife or Leafe, there be referved and made payable, Half-yearly, to. the faid Truftees of the faid Hofpital, and their Succeffors, during the Continuance of fuch Leafe and Leafes respectively, as much Rent as can, at the making of fuch Leafe and Leafes refpectively, be really and bona fide gotten for the fame from a Solvent Tenant, and fo as no Fine or other Confideration be taken for the fame; and that every fuch Demife or Leafe be made in Poffession and not in Reversion.

And be it enacted by the Au. All Leases thority aforefaid, That all made in any other Man-Leafes made of fuch Lands, ner to be null and void. Tenements, or Hereditaments in any other Manner fhall be null and void to all Intents and Purpofes.

And be it enacted by the Authority aforefaid, That this Act to be deemed a Public Act. fhall be be deemed, taken, and allowed, in all Courts of Juffice in this Kingdom, as a Public Act, without fpecially pleading the fame.
