



REGULATIONS,

Relating to the Formation of a

LIBRARY AND MUSEUM,

AT THE KENT AND CANTERBURY HOSPITAL,

Adopted by the provisional Committee assembled for that object.

1849.

- 1.—For the purpose of promoting the establishment and collection of a Permanent Library and Museum, the Canterbury Society shall be associated with any other Medical Book Societies in East Kent, willing to co-operate for these objects under the following regulations.
- 2.—The Canterbury Society shall contribute, for the benefit of the Library and Museum, a sum of money equal to one-third of their annual subscriptions, or deposit in the Library a certain quantity of Books of equal amount, which shall be selected by the Library and Museum Committee from the list which shall be returned to them previous to the Sixth day of April in each year. All other Societies

shall contribute one-fourth of their annual subscriptions, or furnish books to that amount, which shall be selected from the list to be returned in the same manner.

- 3.—The Books shall be estimated for the purpose of the above resolution at the publishing prices, and the amount of the annual Subscription to each Society shall be considered as one Guinea.
- 4.—A representation of one-fifth of the Members of each of the United Societies shall form a Library and Museum Committee, which shall have the management of affairs relating to the Library and Museum.
- 5.—General Meetings of the Members of the United Societies may be convened by the Library Committee for the consideration of any subjects connected with the Library and Museum.
- 6.—Each Society shall guarantee to respect and enforce the laws and regulations relating to the Library and Museum.
- 7.—The Library and Museum shall, with the sanction of the Governors, be placed at the Kent and Canterbury Hospital under the trust of five Members of the United Societies appointed by the Library Committee; all matters relating to the use and distribution of the books being under the absolute control of the Library Committee. If at any time it should happen that there is no Society existing, making contributions of Books to the Library, or preparations to the Museum, for a period of ten years, the Trustees are hereby empowered to surrender the Books and Preparations forming the Library and Museum, to the Governors of the Hospital.

The Preceding Fundamental Laws were agreed to

By the Board of Management of the Hospital, August 17th, 1849, with the Proviso:—

"That the Physicians of the Hospital, for the time being, be ex-officio Members of the Library Committee."

LAWS AND REGULATIONS

Relating to the Use of the

LIBRARY AND MUSEUM,

AT THE

KENT AND CANTERBURY HOSPITAL.

- 1.—That the Library Committee (constituted in accordance with Rule 4 of the printed Regulations, and with the Resolution of the Board of Management as declared in their Minutes of August 17th, 1849,) shall hold Quarterly Meetings at the Hospital, for the transaction of the ordinary business, on the First Thursday after each Quarter day, at Seven o'Clock in the Evening; and at such other times as may be necessary, on receiving a written summons from the Librarian:—the presence of three Members being required to form a quorum.
- 2.—Every Member of the East Kent and Canterbury Medical Book Society, (or of any other Society which may hereafter become associated with it according to the Regulations for that purpose,) shall be considered a member of the Library and Museum at the Hospital; and as such, shall be entitled to use them, subject only to the Rules and Regulations which follow.

- 3.—Any person interested in the pursuit of Medicine, or its Collateral Sciences, and who is recommended to the Library Committee on the personal knowledge of two of its members, may be ballotted for in the usual way at any of the meetings of the committee. And if elected * shall, on the annual payment of £1 1s., be allowed to use the Library and Museum to the same extent as the regular members before described.
 - * One Black Ball out of 3 votes shall exclude.
- 4.—Any Gentleman may be made an Honorary Member of the Library and Museum, in virtue of donations to either of them, at the option of the Committee; and the Committee shall further be empowered, to allow the Medical Officers of Regiments quartered in the neighbourhood to become temporary members, without the payment of any subscription, on their being recommended by any two of the regular members, who will also be required to declare themselves responsible for any loss or damage done to the books by those who use them upon their recommendation.
- 5.—There shall be a Librarian, and Sub-Librarian, whose duties collectively shall be—to attend to all applications made for books, and to forward them as promptly as possible—to enter in a book kept for the purpose, the title of every book removed from the Library, the name and address of the person who borrows it, the date on which it was issued, and returned, together with the condition it is in. They shall also see that the books are arranged in proper order upon the shelves, and that they are carefully preserved. And finally, they shall make regular reports to the Committee upon the condition of the Library after an actual inspection of its contents, and shall be specially expected to notify immediately any book which may be missing from it.

- 6.—The Librarian shall be one of the Medical Staff of the Hospital, (he being also a member of the Library Committee,) and that he shall act as Treasurer of the Library, and make quarterly reports in that capacity to the Committee.
- 7.—The Sub-Librarian shall be either the House Surgeon, or the Dispenser of the Hospital.
- 8.—The Library shall be open for reference to, and for the delivery of books, on *Monday*, *Wednesday*, *Thursday and Saturday*, from 10 A. M. to 4 P. M., during which time members can make use of the Library as a reading room.
- 9.—Every Member on application in writing to the Librarian, may have sent to him from the Library, any books he wishes for, (not more than 2 vols. at a time,) on condition, that the member so borrowing, shall pay all expenses of carriage, and that, if he detain an Octavo volume more than a fortnight, or a Quarto, or Folio more than three weeks, he shall pay a fine of 2d. per day for each vol., exclusive of the day of sending and returning.
- Note.—Country Members may avail themselves of the first conveyance within a week after the period of keeping a Book shall have expired, without incurring a fine.
- 10.—No book above the value of Three Guineas shall be removed from the Library without a note to the Librarian from the member taking it, stating specially, that he will be answerable for any loss or damage such work may sustain while in his possession.
- 11.—Members shall be answerable for all Books which shall be lost or damaged whilst in their possession; and any

member who defaces a book by writing in it, or otherwise, shall be fined at the discretion of the committee to any amount, not exceeding the original value of the book.

- 12.—If a book be detained by any member three months beyond the time allowed for keeping it, and cannot be forthwith produced, it shall be considered as lost, and the member who is accountable for it, shall either furnish a fresh copy or pay the full value of one.
- 13.—The Donor's Name shall be inserted in all Books presented to the Library, and also after the notice of them in the printed Catalogue.
- 14.—All fines and penalties incurred shall be paid to the Librarian, and duly employed at the discretion of the Committee, for the benefit of the Library and Museum; and any member who refuses to pay the fine or penalty adjudged to him under the authority of these regulations, shall be no longer considered a member of the Library.
- 15.—The Committee shall be empowered to appropriate such portion of the funds to either the Library or the Museum exclusively, as they may deem necessary. The Librarian, or such person as the committee may deem advisable to appoint, shall fill the office of Curator of the Museum, and shall see that all preparations, &c., of the Museum are properly preserved. He shall keep a catalogue and case book, which shall contain as full particulars as necessary, of each specimen, and shall report on the condition of the Museum to the committee at their meetings.




