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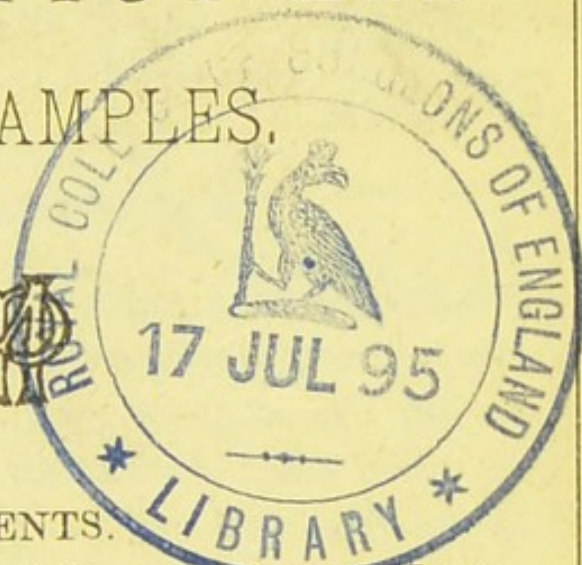

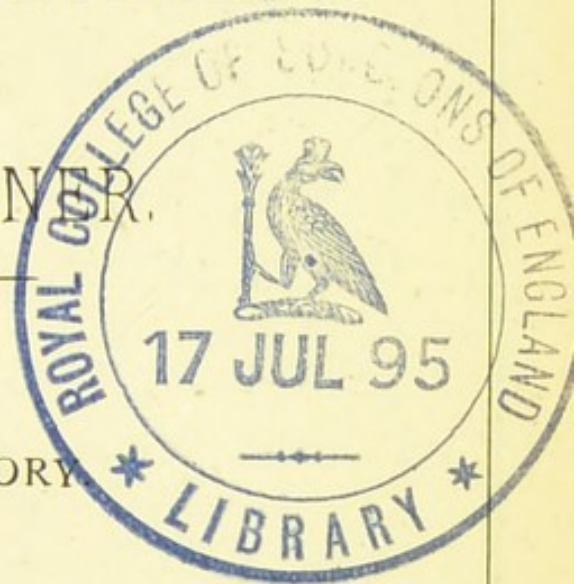

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## THE SOCIETY OF MEDICAL PHONOGRAPHERS.

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*The Society continues to make gratifying progress. The number of members, 60 at the start in December last, is now 150. These are distributed as follows:—In London and the London district are 42 members; in England and Wales 65; in Scotland 24; in Ireland 7; in Europe (Switzerland) 1; in America (United States) 4; in Africa (South Africa 3, Egypt 1) 4; in Asia (India) 3. Edinburgh comes second to London with 10 members, Glasgow stands third with 6, Bristol follows with 5, then Dublin and Oxford with 4 each. Cambridge and Manchester have 3 members each. Aberdeen, Birkenhead, Birmingham, Bournemouth and Liverpool have each 2 members.*

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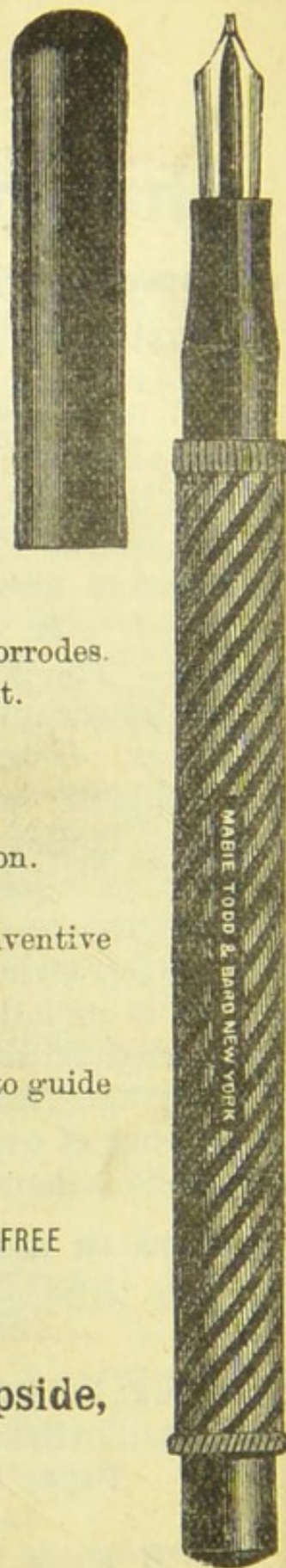
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
