MORTUARY REPORT,

FOR THE YEAR BEGINNING 1ST FEBRUARY 1851.

DURING the past year, the new groupings of the Castes and Ages that were proposed in a former Report have been used. The series of Tables has been made somewhat different from that of former years, for the purpose of showing better the deaths from Epidemic, apart from those from other causes, and of noting more clearly the numerical relations of abode and season to the mortality, that the record may be ready for use when the amount, distribution, and fluctuations of the population become known.

2. The information contained in the Daily Registers, from which the Tables are made, was got in great part orally, there being still not more than a ninth of the deaths reported in writing. The total number registered as having died during the year was 14724; of these 7403 were said to have been born in Bombay, and 7935 elsewhere; while of 26 the birth-place was unknown. Of the same persons 2993 were reported to be of families belonging to Bombay, and 11706 of families belonging to other places, while of 25 the country was unknown. There were 10209 buried, 3743 burnt, and 772 exposed to vultures. Of the above deaths there were 235 still-born.

3. The new arrangement of the Castes, whereby the deaths of Brahmuns are given apart, allows it to be seen that their due proportion of still-born was not taken to the ordinary funeral-places. The other Hindoos, who follow the custom of the Brahmuns in the disposal of their infant dead, are chiefly the Purbhoos and Sonars; but as in these Tables they are included with many others in the group *Hindoos of other Castes*, the reported number of their still-born does not appear. Were a Cemetery for infants opened, to meet the Shastral objection to their being deposited in common burial-

grounds, the present reprehensible practice of clandestine domiciliary interment might reasonably and very advantageously be done away with.

4. Exclusive of still-born, there were 14489 deaths reported during the year, which is 2486 fewer than last year. In the Epidemic classes the deaths were 4020 from Cholera, 517 from Small-pox, and 98 from Measles, there being in the aggregate of these a diminution of 1415, although from Measles the number of deaths was greater.

5. The deaths from causes other than Epidemic were but 9854, which is less than in any of the three preceding years. The decrease from last year was chiefly in Nervous and Respiratory diseases, and in the class *Cachexy and Debility*.

6. In the whole mortality from diseases of Class V there was a decrease since the previous year of 80 ; but in Tetanus, taken separately, there were 113 fewer deaths than in the year 1850 ; that is, without taking into account those included in Class X, among which there was a little increase.

7. Among the imperfections of the grouping of diseases that is at present in use, there is the difficulty of arranging quite satisfactorily the casualties from this disease. By arbitrarily bringing together Traumatic and Idiopathic Tetanus, deaths which have followed external violence, sufficient in itself to endanger life, are put in Class V, instead of in Class XV. Thus cases occur that seem misplaced ; yet, on the other side, it would be equally objectionable to refer to Class XV, deaths where the external lesion to which the Tetanus is to be ascribed has been so slight, that only owing to a pre-existing highly morbid state of the nervous system in the person who has suffered it can such a grave result have followed. The severity of the injury causing this disease varies in degree, and becomes less and less, until in some it is so slight as to render the diagnosis between the Idiopathic and the Traumatic difficult, or perhaps impossible. The instances of doubtful diagnosis being not unfrequent, and also most of the registered deaths from this disease being reported without any mention being made of its origin, it is thought that the present arrangement is on the whole the best. In accordance with this transference of casualties from Class XV to Class V, cases of Guinea-worm, in which death has been caused by Tetanus, from the irritation produced by this parasite of the integuments, instead of being placed in Class XI, have been entered among deaths from *Disease of the Nervous System*. While, however, deaths are removed from Classes XV and XI, to Class V, it is considered advisable to allow those from Tetanus

in child-bed to remain in Class X. The allocation of deaths from Hydrophobia too, may sometimes be attended with doubt. In other classes, also, difficulties may be found to arise from the present grouping : as, for instance, where cases of both Spontaneous and Traumatic Pyæmia occur, the question arises whether the latter is to be associated with the former in Class VI, or to be placed in Class XV, if from outward injury ; or, if the result of a surgical operation, whether it is to be absorbed into the class to which the disease belongs, for the cure of which the operation was performed ? Similar objections, or others of as great weight, appear to be inseparable from nosological classifications : in none other that has been met with have they been found to be absent.

8. The decrease of mortality in Class VII was 209, and in Class XIII it was 96.

9. In diseases of the Alimentary Organs, there was an increase of mortality of 368 ; and under the head of Dropsies also, there was a small increase.

10. Of the deaths in Class XV, those from drowning continue to form a large proportion, and from our insular position many casualties of this kind are to be looked for. The existence of numerous open tanks and draw-wells, and also of quarry holes and other excavations, that are converted into deep pools by the heavy periodical rain, add greatly to the risks and facilities of destruction of life. During the years 1851 and 1852, of the 114 deaths by drowning, 37 were in the sea, and 77 in the Fort-ditch, pools, tanks, and wells. It is impossible to take precautions that would effectually prevent all such casualties, yet many might be hindered. If all such excavations as are dangerous were timeously filled in or railed round, being sought out, and not left unfilled or unfenced until brought to notice through inquiries on the drowned by the Coroner ; and if, instead of perpetuating the custom of making open draw-wells, no wells were allowed to be constructed without being covered, and provided with pumps to raise the water, many accidental deaths would be prevented ; and probably suicides would be fewer, owing to the facilities of self-destruction being lessened.

11. As the reported deaths from Syphilis are so few, they are not now put in a separate class, but are included in the Cachexies. The numbers entered under Leprosy are also few, but as it is a disease of more peculiar interest, it is thought desirable that it should retain its present prominence ; because, while it has the place of a Class, many points are recorded about it which would not be so, were it to be merged in a group with other diseases.

12. From the Meteorological Observations received, it is found that the mean Pressure of the Air during the year was 29.794 inches, and the extreme range of Pressure 0.696 inch ; that the mean Temperature was 79°5, the mean daily range of Temperature 11°7, and the extreme range of the year 39°9. The mean Dew Point was 71°6, and the per-centage of humidity of the Air 92. Rain fell on 91 days, and to the depth of 96 inches.
