#### PREFACE.

THE main portion of this table was compiled for my own use while a student. I was led to do this by feeling the need of such a table; and being unable to discover that any such existed, either separately, or an text-books of anatomy, I have been induced to collect and publish the rough notes I then made, from the belief that this want is still widely fielt, and from the hope that they will be found by other students as unseful as they were to myself.

With regard to the arrangement and nomenclature of the muscles, I have thought it better to adopt some system already known and recognised, than to originate one of my own. I have, therefore, in these matters, followed the best and most widely-used text-book,—Dr. QUAIN'S ANATOMY, by Dr. Sharpey and Mr. Ellis.

As this table will fall into the hands of beginners as well as of dvanced students, I have thought it best, on the first mention of each erve (though not afterwards), to carry it up to its derivation from the erebro-spinal centre, thus — "Posterior Auricular of Facial of 7th erebral."

I have to record my acknowledgements to JOHN WOOD, Esq., .R.C.S., Demonstrator of Anatomy at King's College, London, for kind suggestions and aid in the progress of this work. I am, however, myself solely responsible for the statements herein contained. I have endeavoured to make these as accurate as possible; but, should any errors have crept in, I shall be very thankful for intimations of them (and, indeed, for suggestions of any improvements), that, in the event of a re-print, they may be corrected.
