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

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



2. M. **Armlets**, six, made of conus shells. Vary from D. 55 to D. 115.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
3. M. **Forks**, three, made of limb bones of cassowary. LL. 143, 143, and 175.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
4. M. **Comb**, decorated with red, white and blue beads, in wood. Worn by chief. L. 440, B. 55. Tavium.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
5. M. **Necklaces**, two, in cords of plaited vegetable fibre and teeth of sperm whale. Teeth, L. 193, B. 88, and L. 217, B. 68.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
6. M. **Necklaces**, five, made of teeth of sperm whale; cords wanting. Teeth, vary from L. 149, B. 57, to L. 180, B. 54.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
7. M. **Necklace** made of tooth of sperm whale, cord wanting. Presented to Sir William Macgregor in 1883 when, as acting Governor of Fiji, he opened the Veilbeose Council of Great Chiefs at Kandavu Island. It was the largest tooth the chiefs could find in the Colony. L. 223, B. 71.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
8. M. **Necklaces**, three, made of teeth of sperm whale. L. 260, B. 130; L. 270, B. 125, and L. 355, B. 100.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
9. M. **Breast-plate** made of sections of teeth of sperm whale, with plaited cord in vegetable fibre for suspension. L. 219, B. 260.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
10. M. **Breast-plate** made of trochus shell, and sections of teeth of sperm whale, with cord of strips of coloured cotton for suspension. L. 200, B. 218.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
11. M. **Forks**, two, four-pronged, in wood. Used by cannibals for human flesh only. L. 223, B. 21, and L. 233, B. 33.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.
12. M. **Rat-safe** in ivory. Had been used by eight generations of a family in Namosi. L. 148, B. 63, T. 45.—*Macgregor Collection*. 1899.

13. M. **Die** in lead. Used for printing arms of King Cakobau, Fiji, on proclamations, Royal Gazettes, etc. Inscribed, "REREVAKA NA KAL OU KA DOKA NA TUI"—(Fear God and honour the king). L. 39, B. 38, T. 23.—*Macgregor Collection.* 1899.
14. M. **Great Seal** of Kingdom of Bua, Fiji, in brass. Inscribed, "TOVATA I VITI"—(Federation of Fiji). L. 35, D. 40.—*Macgregor Collection.* 1899.
15. M. **Powder horn.** Belonged to King Cakobau. L. 308, D. 76.—*Macgregor Collection.* 1899.

18. M. **Rat-safe**, in form of human head, in wood painted black, and with white of eyes in mother of pearl. L. 128, B. 102, T. 48.—*Macgregor Collection.* 1899.





For example: L. 145, B. 80, T. 30, indicates length 145 millimetres, breadth 80 millimetres, thickness 30 millimetres.
