External Appearance.

The body was that of a man in the prime of life and above the average stature. The general nutrition was good with considerable subcutaneous fat and the muscular development excellent.

The abdomen was retracted.

The skin had a slight yellow tinge which was also noticeable in the mucous membranes and was of the nature of jaundice.

The body was in a state of well marked cadaveric rigidity and post-mortem lividity was present on the dorsal surface.

Pupils unequal; the right more dilated and outline irregular.

Internal Examination.

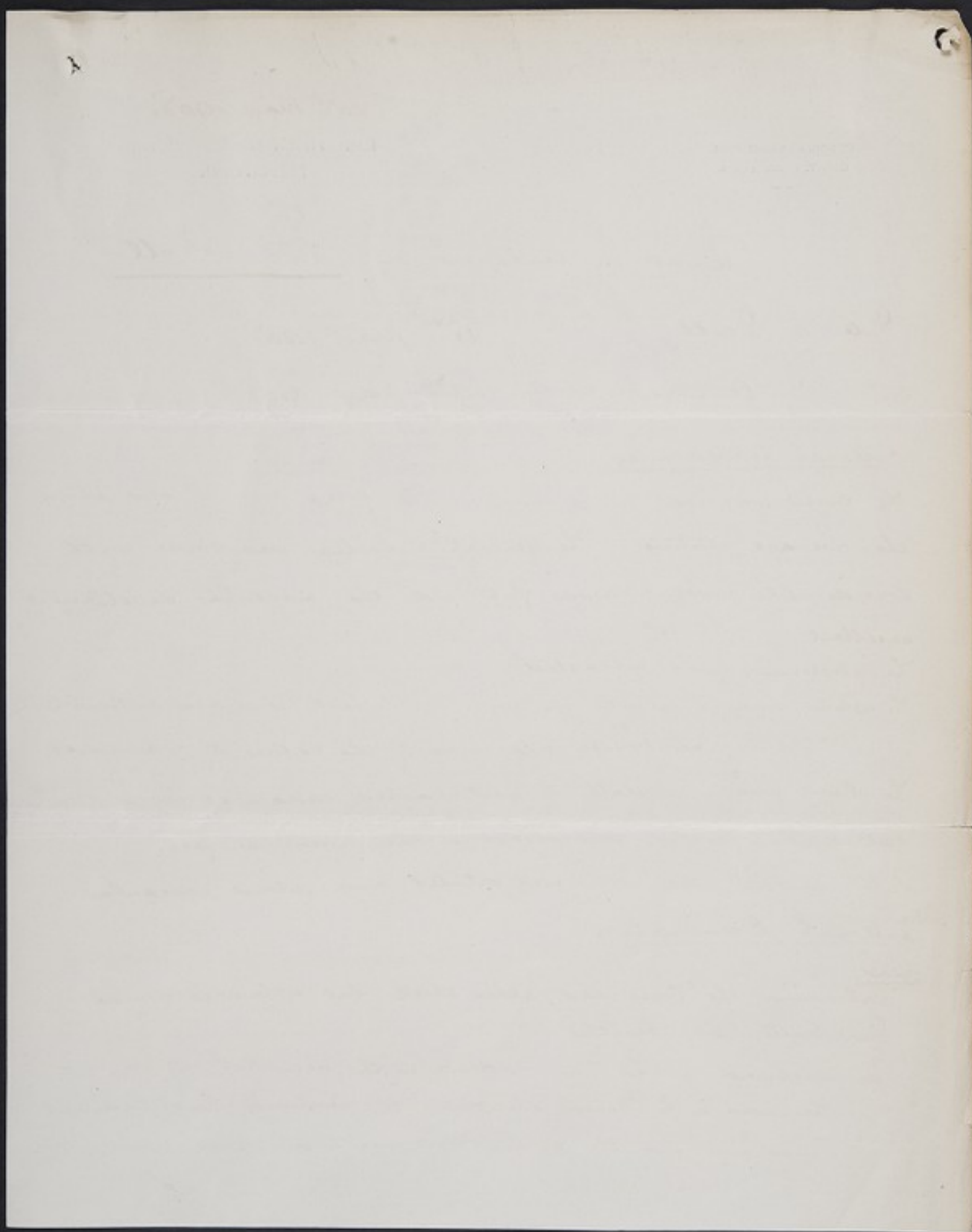
Head.

Calvarium; the bones were rather thick but otherwise normal.

Dura Mater; was healthy.

Pia-arachnoid; showed slight oedema in the occipital region.

There was a milkiness alongside the Superior Longitudinal Sinus and here the dura & pia-arachnoid were adherent.

THE BEECHCROFT ATTEM-
PTED MURDER

Copy of Affidavit sworn
on behalf of
J. G. Davidson against Dr
Thomas Muir, Educational Su-
perintendent of Cape Colony.

It is as in the second or third week
of September 1886 that I visited
Dr. Thomas Muir at his villa of
Beekwicht, Boshwilt. I was
shown into the library. I sat down
on this two more the preceding, when
I as well received and he even
departed from his name this time.
After so far as to allow my
nature to go over his head, which as
a rule he shows to assist at any
cost to the superior of persons whom
I called in pursuance of an advice
then and long after showed that
as soon as he entered the room

I saw as suddenly on this ac-
-casion to the person asked. As if to
show himself for his previous
conduct and he assumed his most
magnificent air, with every
eye on the "lettered world" "what do
you mean" and "what am I to
understand". I have to go, but he
surprised me into one less room on
subject of showing me something
and then he turned his head at assault
-and-battery with he thought he had
secured me to deliver as he had re-
-ceived his character in various
at Glasgow High School, Mr. William
Rend. I have not collected myself
strongly and made for the door of
exit. Dr. Muir has all his lips behind
as if he thought it a crime to speak
when he was speaking and this time
he was turned to a perfect transport
of fury. He literally hunted me to
the far door-jack, playing his face to
as to show me that he, in a strong show
in so as to make my breath come

think - and - fast and catching up every word I said to say no to it with calculated fury. When a man's brain and frame are so much isolated by the climate as Dr Muir he has not the faintest idea what his interlocutor is saying to say real, and looking back as I emerged I could see the assassin standing in his grounds faking and faking and faking idiotically after me. I reached Bathmelt station quivering in every limb and was ill for three weeks after. Had not my system been already injured so as to neutralise the shocks received he would have killed me. The methods of the encounter have been this man's methods through life and justifying me in styling him an anti-social and murderous force.

To which Dr. Easterbrook appended his admission but Muir ("Brutality Town") Conscious of fault took the challenge lying down. Starting as it appears, the Lanarkshire criminal authorities

took no action against this mis-creant, and apparently persons of sensitive system would be safer in Morocco than in the West of Scotland People

like Muir come in this way to regard themselves as chartered assailants of all forms of impersonal structure for whom they go fightway in the manner described above so if law and police had been banded to the planet Saturn. It is the most shocking species of crime yet heard of, and the most anti-national, the big nations in which the personal equation is abolished being prevented by the ruthless egotism of men like Thomas Muir so as to be kept from scoring for their own good and society as nature intended. Violation often takes place with unshaken confidence, and the sensation of having one's intelligence attacked in an alleged civilized country and of being called on to work and at the same time prevented resembles nothing outside Edgar Allan Poe's Pit and Pendulum.

You sympathize neither with my sufferings nor with my ancestors, to others who do not realize that yet before I close let me suggest morally he ranks with Burke and to you a possible reply on the Hare. I, with probably the best endowment in the country, have not had a day's life in this insanely run nation, let alone the superior person. Because the inferior - in their own - and bare people take the upper hand with those of immensely superior brain-structure. Those natures begin where theirs leaves off. For a nature like mine, with the personal equation left out, the whole nature moving spontaneously, bright and extra ability showing itself in the comprehending movement in the superior brain-structure, every thing is done even the presence of another man of Yellowless type, manœuvreing to gain the upper hand with a better structure than his own, not to speak of his close knocking in with material speech catches the action of the spleen and pain out as a ghastly death. I see no sign I deeply grieve to say, that the Chicken superintendent has wrecked in this town even to the extent of making my life safe: if David Yellowless came down here he might kill me to-morrow in this far western man-farm fashion.

(2) Genius is always accompanied by abnormality of some kind in its owner or his collateral. That I should have been born with a brain susceptible to physical affections indicated penetration into the effect of the climate on the brain and frame of the Lowland-Scotts breeding, as it does a hopelessly inferior type

superiorly dangerous in the West to higher brain-structures than its own to which it does not hesitate to attack with incredible recklessness. That the term work should be restricted to an individual non-moral form of brain-activity, as the misfortune of the country. A man like Dr. Low with a moral agreeing frame of brain-structure, beginning where David Yellowless leaves off, and actually finding himself in his neighbour, should find in Yellowless a chief with no thing about him to reach out to, should be in continuous embarrassment from this cause should look up the phenomenon with similar phenomena throughout the country. Should do his best to get through, his duties always hampered and twisted by his chief, should nevertheless always play up to the idea of perfection and maintain the strict standard of morality which Yellowless did his best to break down and should nevertheless be twisted by the stupid attendant as a man, who did not seem to do much, and in consequence felt himself compelled to decline later present is very sufficient cause of the true value of "Little Scotland" claims to lead the world in medical psychology. (3) This greenhorn of a Dr. Macdougall depresses me severely: to all appearance he cannot understand that for Yellowlegs or Mui to advance upon a man like me calling for work with threatening glare does not tell me to work, but terrifies me or my life out of working and where moral and physical come so close and the nature is extraordinarily perceptible cause a horrible death, worse than any Germans could inflict. That is the worst of the Scotch conversation - they have very bad material to work upon and train that material to a self-assurance which plays the dance with higher types. Superior methods in deed! as I read in a letter from some draft Englishman - you can't have superior methods from inferior people. "Every thing was taken the wrong way, reported Dr. Johnson about the case. It was taken the wrong way because every thing in Scotland at least in the West of Scotland is taken the wrong way from morning till night. Glasgow is anti-human and absolutely criminal and Edinburgh under Sir Thomas Clouston's influence tends to a consecration of lawland-Scotchness, with monstrous talk about thickheadedness (Glasgow alone can supply all Europe with thickheadedness and have enough over for itself) and an invariable diversion of the idea - what did the case turn on? to the idea - what did the patient fancy to work at. Perceptiveness is not honoured in a word. You get all its disadvantages from the close chugging in of these Yahoos, but none of its advantages -

no one wants to hear a word you say, not even if you have a nation's fight on other people's heads and therefore capable of assuming cause, and the issues concerned are those of life and death.

(4) Inwardly during the past four years I passed away to the Londoners here, whose brain substance is, as Matthew Arnold remarked, decidedly superior to the Scotch. Nicholson, Albrecht, Kops and others - I found them all meeting me with a firm intelligent expression of their instinct for conduct not lying about like that corroded thing of a Yellowlegs, infamously crying no to every thing subtle, and using the bullying notes in his voice rockless whether he killed me or not, nor battling me out of my existence like Yellowlegs. You can't shut even in a Glasgow Keats or Thackeray. It is more and more clearly apparent that the Scotch mark-error refers to an inferior structure which exists nowhere else than in Scotland and conceals its daily duties not morally like other nations but in an ignominious fashion, continually attacking intelligence and in a word defeat its own end. Now as in Luther's time the Scotch are the most impudent and conceited of nations and the nation in the moral realm has less than any other nation to be contented about. Even a writer of Carlyle's force has not meaning, explanatory force enough to satisfy smaller men of superior races.

THE BEECHCROFT
ATTEMPTED MURDER

A CHARACTERISTIC WEST
OF SCOTLAND EPISODE

Copy of Affidavit sworn on
behalf of James Grant David-
-son ^{against} Dr. Thomas Muir, Edin-
-burgh Superintendent of Cape
Colony, by Dr. Easterbrook of the
Brisbane, and forwarded to the
Governor and Premier of the Cape
at the end of April, 1908.

It was in the second or third
week of September 1886, that
I called on Dr. Thomas Muir at
his Villa of Beechcroft, Botolph.
I was shown into the library. I
had visited his house two months
previously, when he received me
well, even allowing my nature
to go over his head, which as
a rule he strove to prevent by
at any cost to the superior or-
-ganisation. It was in pursuance
of an abject then and long

David Yellowlegs' methods
have been identical. His vio-
-lence is appalling and
murderous. Dr. Easterbrook
sent a similar affidavit des-
-cribing a similar scene in

has not covered himself with
honour in refusing help in what
has become a sheer brute struggle
for physical life against
criminal lunatics in high
places.

I want it recorded and Kept
in some permanent shape that
when the person is non-
-existent the brain - Content
amounting to a higher or reason-
-able self, binding others as
well as the owner, and the
moral and physical closeness
usually present in the chest in
Scottish North-easterners of
this type extends right up
through the brain, with a
friend-showing movement through
head and body, and a lucid
cause-showing movement in
the eyes, then the brain may
be completely impregnated by
contact with another of the
same kind - the type being
the most intimate in the world.
Also that any attempt of
the bare, individualised
non-moral self so frequently
bred in the Scotch Lowlands,
especially in the West, to
take the upper hand 'with
such an organisation, much

more a deliberate smash at
the brain or irrepressible
pushing into the action of the
body may ^{cause}

There appeared no interstitial or suppurative changes. But the parenchyma was much altered.

The Gall-bladder was collapsed and empty and no stones were found there or in ducts.

The Stomach contained several ounces of a grumous fluid, and the wall was healthy.

The Jejunum was dark in colour with a greenish tinge and showed some hyperaemia in places but not markedly.

The Large Intestine was contracted in the whole of its length and free from faecal accumulation.

The Spleen, weighed $2\frac{3}{4}$ oz: was small, firm, & healthy.

The Kidneys: Right $6\frac{3}{4}$ oz, left $8\frac{1}{4}$ oz.

Appeared large, and of a light brown colour. The surfaces were smooth; the capsule was adherent in places but there was no contraction of the cortex and no distinct alteration could be noticed.

The pancreas was examined and found healthy as were also the supra-renal bodies.

Pelvis: The bladder was full.

The conditions found lead to the diagnosis of an
Acute Hepatitis.

The Encephalon, weighed 3 lb. $7\frac{1}{4}$ oz.

Right Hemisphere, 1 lb. 7 oz.

Left do. 1 lb. 7 oz.

Pons & Medulla, 1 oz.

The convolutions were normal in appearance, there being no signs of atrophy or widening of the sulci. The consistence of the cerebral matter was normal. The lateral ventricles were normal and the expenditure of all the ventricles was healthy.

The choroid plexus in the descending cornu of the lateral ventricles was vascular and appeared cystic.

The cerebellum and mid brain appeared normal.

The cerebral vessels & cranial nerves were normal.

Thorax. There were some adhesions in the pleural sac at right apex.

Right Lung, 1 lb. $7\frac{1}{4}$ oz.

Left do. 1 lb. 6 oz.

There was present congestion & oedema in dependent parts, especially at bases but they were otherwise healthy.

The pericardium showed adhesions between its two layers on the right side.

The Heart weighed 12 oz.

There was some hypertrophy of the left ventricle. The cavities contained some white thrombi which had a yellowish-green tinge.

No valvular changes were found but the myocardium was rather pale, though otherwise normal.

Abdomen.

The symptoms of extreme collapse with epigastric pain & tenderness lead to a careful examination of the organs of that region. There was no local peritonitis. The liver was uniformly enlarged and came down over an inch beyond the costal margin.

The liver weighed 5 lb. 6 oz. The margins were sharp and even.

It was of a pale yellowish-green colour with punctate spots deeply congested. The central hepatic lobules paler than periphery.

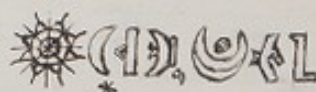

Foregoing

Foregoing is the simplified form of the new alphabet, & embraces forty-five signs & sounds. In extended full scientific form, a much more elaborate sign system is necessary. All vowels are both surds & drones; semi-vowels consist of surds 36, drones 26; consonants, surds 14, drones 6. This is arrived at, that all semi-vowels & consonants possess backward forms, quite individual & distinct from their forward ones, - X is backward form of K, for instance. Backward sounds signs are marked with a diacritical mark so, & surds are shown in thin lines, drones in thick ones. For capital letters or rather words, show vowels in double line. The full number of signs & sounds, including the said backward forms is thus 122, a number which demonstrates analogy, tho. clear.

The foregoing is nearly all fresh discovery of mine, and I have discontinued the use, as separate signs, of the letters I, J, Q, W & X. I is really an E; J, a form of soft G is merely ga, as ge is G, and in the same way Q is Kw opposed to Ka, Ko-ke, while X is the backward form of K. The letter W is simply an absurd fiction. It is but a semi-vowel. The non-alphabetical system is a necessary & useful principle & serves many useful purposes. I have also a system of phrases & other improvements in preparation.

In this new language, I employ but one syllable for each simple, single element or thing, and one vowel only to each syllable, & never a single consonant, etc., more than is necessary. The alphabet is founded on the fact that ordinary letters are formed of five or six signs, each capable of being used as a letter itself, and in using these, as such, eliminating words are reduced to the size of ordinary letters without inconvenience, as demonstrated in foregoing illustrations. A person using this language, may thus both read & write four or five times quicker than in "English," & save materials space, etc., of the kind, & five or six times such in printing.

This language is scientifically constituted on the simplest & most elementary principles, to provide a necessary, facile medium of international, interworld & universal communication, for political, business & all ordinary purposes. To begin-learners, whether these be children, or else adults of a strange people, words written in ordinary languages are hard to recollect, & difficult to copy; whereas in the present instance, they are presented in the form of simple, alphabeto-semantic signs, which do the utmost possible to aid the memory & intelligence and facilitate writing. Though constructed ^{unusually} to meet but ordinary purposes, at the same time this language may be used to transmit the finest ideas of Literature-poetry & prose. It is, however, too short-simple, etc., to be utilized in the highest & most perfect manner as a final language for the scientific & artistic, lacking the necessary infinite varied, & exhaustive technicalities of a language specially constructed to comprehend all ^{necessary} ~~all~~ ^{principles of} ~~the~~ super-rational language. Such language, I have in preparation. These languages are perfectly philosophical, philomathical, etc., - are on ^{perfect} ~~universal~~ ^{scientific} ~~scientific~~ ^{the first of the} kind constructed; their grammatical forms are not yet completed. Languages in detail included. Both are dominantly Celtic-British, French, Italian (Latin included), Spanish & other - all these nations are Celtic, the greatest race of the world, and the dominant one. These languages are not intended to supersede, & may not be allowed to do, national, racial ^{in detail} ones, otherwise would be quite in scientific.

Dear Sir,

With reference to the magnetic storm of Saturday last, seeing that its consequences were so serious, permit me to explain to the Government the nature of its phenomena. Aurorae occur in maximum form & condition bi-annually, roughly in January & August. ^{minimum on 15th or 16th of a year} This dual principle is due to the alternate vicinity of Moon & Sun respectively. - The Moon pendulates annually North & South as does the Sun, viz at its extreme South in Summer, North in Winter.
