INTRODUCTION.

A LIBRARY which was commenced some thirty years before the occurrence of the Great Fire of London, partially, if not entirely, destroyed by that catastrophe, and gradually resuscitated in the course of time, is a possession of which its owners may well be proud.

The Society of Apothecaries was incorporated by a Charter of James I. on May 30, 1617, and the following year was established in its Hall in Blackfriars. The first Master was Edmond Phillips, the first Wardens Stephen Higgins and Thomas Fownes.

The year 1618 was further remarkable for the publication by the College of Physicians of the first *Pharmacopæia Londinensis*, which was translated into English in 1649 by the famous Apothecary, Nicholas Culpeper.

It appears, from the archives of the Society, that on Nov. 28, 1633, the nucleus of a Library was formed by the generosity of Mr. Thomas Johnson, of Snow Hill, who on that date presented to the Society "as a guifte, a booke called *Gerard's Herbal*." As a return he was made free of the Livery and was presented with a gown and hood.* Evidently the donor was no other than the author of the second edition of that famous Herbal which he had published the same year; a circumstance which rendered its possession the more valuable.

It may be reasonably supposed that during the next thirty-three years many more volumes must have been presented, and probably others were purchased; but as the Apothecaries Hall was destroyed by the Great Fire in 1666, we may infer that whatever the dimensions

of the Library may have been at that date, the contents perished with the building. Strange to say the Minute Book of the Society contains no entry relating to the fire, nor to the losses thereby incurred in the way of pictures, books, plate, and other valuable possessions. Nor does any catalogue now exist of the books which were in the Library before that date. Possibly none was ever made.

Apparently no active steps were taken to commence a fresh collection of books until October 1681, when it was determined "to contrive a library" for the use of the Chemical Laboratory—rebuilt in 1671—and the Physic Garden * at Chelsea, which the Society held on a 30 years' lease. Before that lease expired they were presented with the freehold through the liberality of Sir Hans Sloane. As soon as the Deed of Conveyance was executed, a Committee was formed to attend actively to the Garden and to appoint a competent head gardener.

In June 1739 a notable addition to the Library was made under the Will of Dr. Samuel Dale, of Braintree, Essex, a friend and neighbour of John Ray, and like him a botanist of repute.

The terms of the bequest were as follows :-

"I give and devise unto the Master and Wardens of the Society of Apothecaries of the City of London all such of my books on Botany as at present they have not, and also all my Hortus siccus or collection of dried plants, including those collected by my kind friend and neighbour the late learned Mr. John Ray †: upon condition that the said Master and Wardens shall, within twelve months next after my decease make or erect proper conveniences in their Physic Garden at Chelsea in the County of Middlesex for the reception thereof and under such regulations for the keeping and preserving them as shall be agreed on and approved by Sir Hans Sloane, Bart., M.D., President of the Royal Society, London, and my Executor hereafter named."

It followed that at a Court of Assistants held on June 21, 1739, the Master, Joseph Miller, presiding, "Mr. Isaac Rand acquainted the Court that Sir Hans Sloane had met the Committee for the Garden and declared it as his opinion that it would be most proper to have Dr. Dale's legacy of books and plants kept in a press or presses by themselves, and not mixed with other books or plants." Accordingly it was "agreed that the Committee for the Garden provide proper press or presses for keeping the said books and plants by themselves and that something be wrote on the said presses denoting the donation." The plants are now in the British Museum.

It is of interest to mention these matters here, for, as will be seen later, the books which were for many years deposited in the library of the old Physic Garden at Chelsea were ultimately transferred to the Hall in Blackfriars, which had been rebuilt in 1668 from designs by Henry Cook.

Meanwhile, as appears from entries in the Minute Book, steps were taken from time to time to augment the collection of books belonging to the Society, and to provide "a repositorie" for them at the end of the gallery. This "repositorie" still exists in the shape; of some deep cupboards on either side of the fireplace. At the same time the sides of the gallery were ordered to be lined with wainscot, and a panel was executed as a specimen.

On June 14, 1744, a Committee was appointed to consider what alterations would be needful to convert the Gallery into a Library; for previously the books had been merely stored there in the "repositorie" aforesaid.

The appearance which the Gallery presented after the book-cases had been supplied, and which to a certain extent it still retains, may be seen on reference to the frontispiece to this Catalogue, which is reproduced, by permission, from one of the plates in Mr. C. R. Barrett's admirable *History of the Society of Apothecaries*, published by Mr. Elliot Stock in 1905.

That the augmentation of the Library was not altogether dependent on donations from the Members or their friends is shown by an entry in the Minutes under date March 20, 1807, where the Society "ordered the purchase of certain books on Materia Medica to complete the library, the amount to be expended not to exceed twenty guineas."

A careful examination of the Minute Books has not disclosed many references to the Library, the entries relating to it being few and far between. The last entry for 1829 concerns the Physic Garden at Chelsea. "It had long been felt that its usefulness as a school for students of Medical Botany could be much increased, and the time had arrived when it became possible to use the garden to a far greater extent than before. Consequently it was practically thrown open to all genuine students who could obtain the necessary letters of recommendation." *

In March 1832 the old project of forming a Library in the Hall, and also a Museum of such branches of natural history as are connected with medicine, was revived, and a Committee was appointed to carry out the design should they think fit to do so.*

It had already been decided that the books in the library at Chelsea should be removed to the Hall in Blackfriars, and they were accordingly transferred.

The number of volumes thus acquired, so far as can be now ascertained, amounted to 218, nearly all of which are still on the shelves, though a few have not been found. As this notable addition included some of the most valuable books now in the Library — principally Herbals and Pharmacopæias — it has been thought well to distinguish them in the present Catalogue by prefixing an asterisk to the titles.

The total number of books now catalogued under Authors' names amounts roughly to about 1700, and in addition there are forty-three Periodicals. Many of the latter, however, are very imperfect, and it would entail some expense to complete them. The chief feature of the collection, as will be seen from the Catalogue, is the number of old Herbals which it contains. Many of these are of considerable value, and to judge by the prices realized of late years at auction (occasioned, it is said, by the competition of American book buyers), their value is becoming annually enhanced. In addition to the Herbals there is a goodly list of Pharmacopæias and a fair proportion of the works of Linnæus, most of which were acquired in 1832 with the books which came from Chelsea.

Amongst the rarities in the collection, exclusive of Herbals already noticed,† allusion may be made to the following:—

- (1) ORTUS SANITATIS. De Herbis et plantis: de animalibus et reptilibus; de avibus; de piscibus; &c. Tabula medicinalis cum directorio generali per omnes tractatus. Fol. B.L. Morgantiæ, 1491. The earliest printed book in the Library, and one of the most valuable. The omission of the initial "H" in Hortus is explained by the fact that the early printers sometimes left space for a floreated capital which was not always supplied.
- (2) VINCENTIUS BELLOVACENSIS. Speculum Historiale. Fol. B.L. Venetiis, 1494. Another early and valuable work, but unfortunately imperfect.

- (3) ALEXIS OF PIEDMONT. 4to. B.L. 1560. See p. 4.
- (4) Monardus (Nicolas). Joyfull Newes out of the New-found Worlde; wherein are declared the rare and singular virtues of divers Herbs, Trees, Plants, &c. Translated from the Spanish by John Frampton, an English merchant, is a small 4to in gothic letter 1596, and gives a curious insight into the knowledge of herbs and the practice of medicine in Spain during the 16th century. It contains three books in addition to the first-named, treating respectively of the far-famed bezoar stone, iron, and steel in medicine, and the benefit of snow. A copy in contemporary vellum like that in the Society's library is priced by Quaritch at fifteen guineas.
- (5) Clusius seu L'Escluse (Carolus). Rariorum Plantarum Historia. Engraved Title, portrait, and numerous woodcuts. Fol. Antwerp, 1601. This work, with the Exoticorum Libri X. and the Curæ Posteriores, all of which are in the Library, are sometimes bound in 1 vol. folio. A good copy is priced by Quaritch at twenty guineas.
- (6) Crispin van der Pass. Hortus Floridus, an oblong quarto published at Arnheim in 1614 and esteemed for its engravings. Hardly two copies of this rare book are alike. Plate numbers were altered, certain plates were substituted for others, and additions were made at various times. An unusually complete copy of the edition in the Society's Library is priced in Quaritch's Natural History Catalogue, 1912, at twenty guineas.
- (7) Bauhinus (Johannes). Historia Plantarum Universalis. With engraved title and woodcuts. 3 vols., Fol., Yverdon, 1650-51. An esteemed work.
- (8) Merrett (Christopher). Pinax Rerum Naturalium Britannicarum, 12mo, London, 1667, is a scarce little book. The first edition, 1666, is believed to have been almost entirely destroyed by the Great Fire in the year of its publication, and the second issue in the following year was probably not a large one, if we may judge by the infrequency with which copies are now offered for sale.
- (9) QUINTINYE (J. DE LA). The Compleat Gard'ner: or directions for cultivating and right ordering of Fruit-gardens and Kitchengardens. In six books. Made English by John Evelyn. With portrait and folding copper plate. Sm. fol., London, 1693. In his Diary, April 24, 1694, Evelyn mentions a visit to Brompton Park, between Knightsbridge and Kensington, long since built over, where

he admired the store of rare plants in the grounds of Henry Wise, afterwards gardener to Queen Anne. He refers to it again in the advertisement to his translation of the Compleat Gardiner.

Amongst the few Manuscripts which are preserved in the Library may be mentioned a quarto volume of 1770 entitled *Index Plantarum quæ in Horto Medico Chelseano aluntur*, and another, in 3 vols. 8vo, containing lists of seeds annually sown in the same garden. There is also Miller's *Icones Plantarum Officinalium*, in two volumes folio.

A large number of Medical Tracts of various dates are preserved and press-marked, the titles of which will be found catalogued under the names of their respective authors.

It will doubtless be noticed on looking through the Catalogue that a great number of modern works which might reasonably be expected to be in the Library, are conspicuous by their absence. The explanation is that this is not, and does not profess to be, an up to date scientific library but a collection of old books brought together in the course of many years and dating from about the end of the 15th to the middle of the 19th centuries. It contains a number of curious volumes and some rare ones, and for this reason it has been thought desirable to prepare the present Catalogue, the first which has properly been attempted. absence of any previous guide, excepting a MS. list of the books received from Chelsea in 1832, has rendered the task a very arduous one; but it is hoped that the Catalogue in its present form will be of value not only to members of the Society as a permanent record of the books in their possession, but also to others who love old books, and may be glad to learn where some of them may be found.
