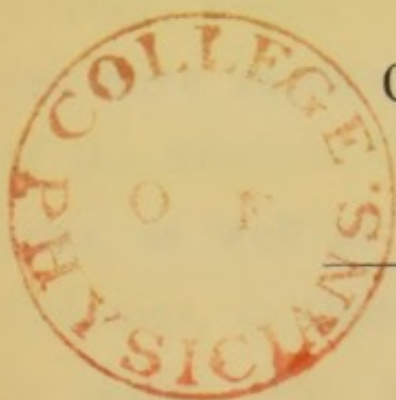

THE attention of Medical Officers is particularly directed to the wants of the Museum, in the Orders *Chelonia* and *Batrachia*; the collection contains but few species of either of these orders, and considering that India, Australia and Canada are so abundantly supplied with species of both, it is a cause of surprise that so few specimens of Tortoises, Turtles, Frogs, Toads, Tree Frogs, &c. should yet have reached Fort Pitt. The assistance of the Medical Officers serving in these countries, as well as of those stationed in other Colonies, is therefore particularly requested, in order that materials for an Appendix to this Catalogue may exist by the period of the next annual meeting.

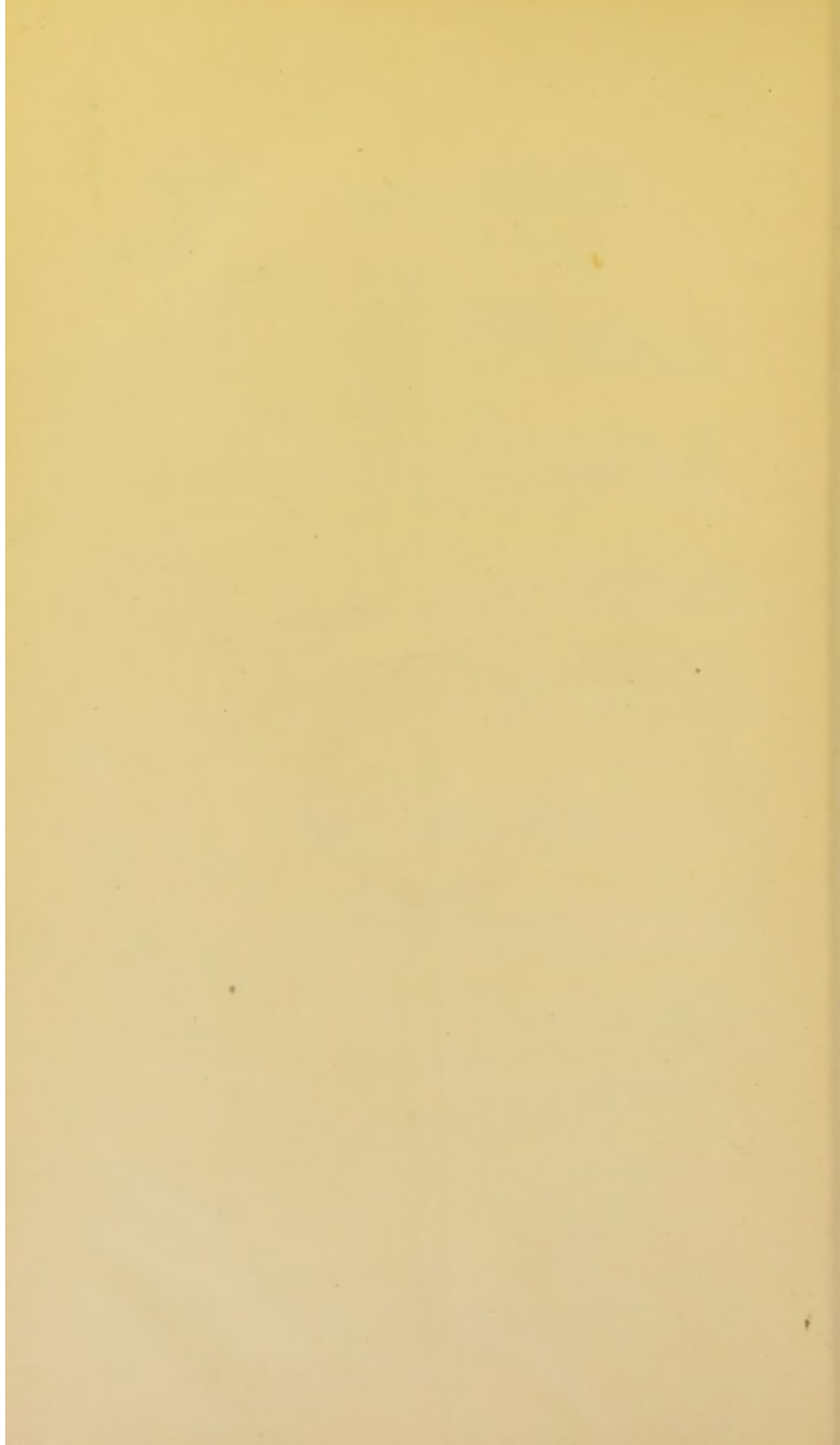

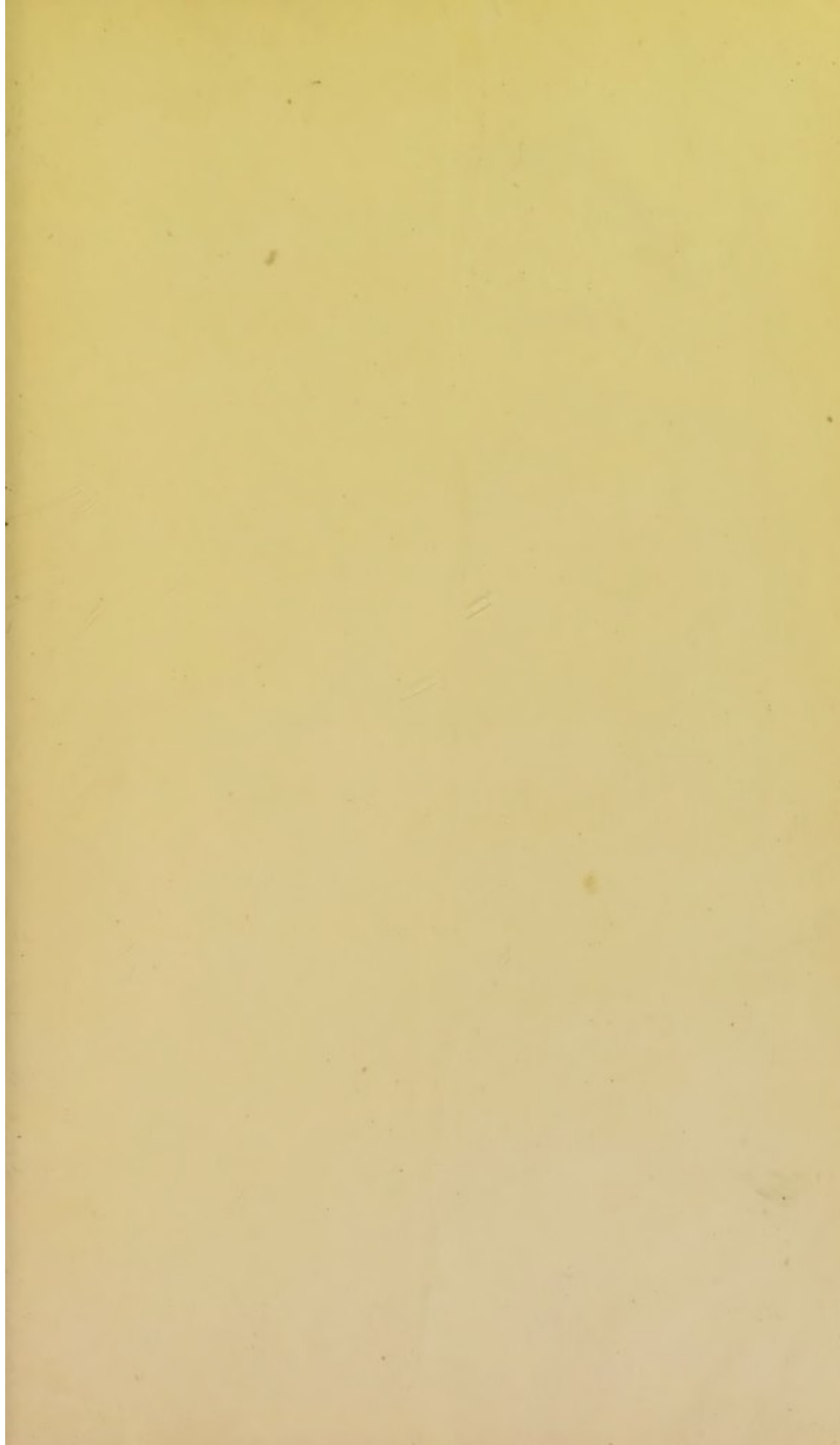

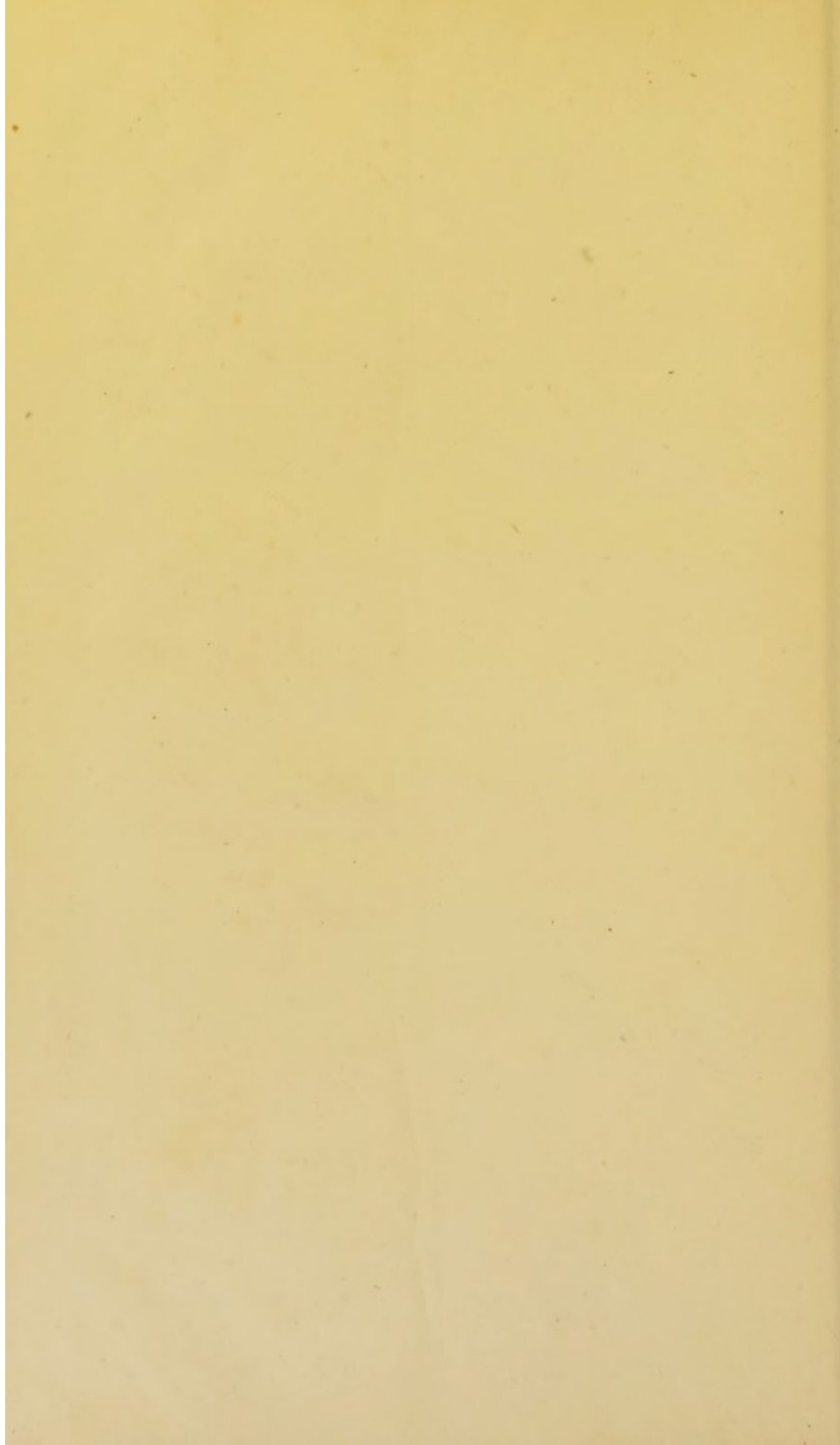
