





Danysz Virus is a bacteriological preparation containing the germs of a disease to which only rats and other mouse-like rodents are susceptible. When the bait, prepared with Danysz Virus, is eaten by rats and mice, they contract the disease and die in about 8 to 14 days. Other rats coming in contact with those suffering from the disease will also contract it.

How Much to Use.— The quantity of Danysz Virus to be applied depends on the extent of the area, and the number of the vermin present. A small cottage can be cleared of mice with the contents of a single tube; for an ordinary dwelling house, where rats in large numbers are found, not less than six tubes should be simultaneously applied. One or two dozen tubes must be used for a large stable with hayloft and yard attached. A similar quantity should be put down in the case of a warehouse, or granary, each rat-infested floor being separately treated. In connection with larger applications of Danysz Virus, such as the treatment of towns, or whole estates, from one to two dozen tubes per acre of inhabited area, and from three to six tubes per acre for game preserves, parks, fields, etc., may be indicated.



### LIQUID DANYSZ VIRUS.

Liquid Danysz Virus is made to order, and is ready for delivery in about a fortnight. It should, if possible, be applied on the same day as it is received. 
