1st Class - - - - - 2 6

1st Class - - - - - 7s. 6d. to 10 6

2d Class - - - - - 1 1 0

Visits to the country, under Five Miles and above Two, 10s. 6d. to 2 2 0

Visits to the Country exceeding Five Miles, and not exceeding Ten Do. 1l. 1s. to 3 3 0

Any greater distance to be in Proportion, and during the length of Time, at 2l. 2s. per day. 2 2 0

These Charges to be independent of Horse and Chaise Hire, and to be Doubled during the ordinary Hours of Rest.

N. B. As there is a considerable latitude in the preceding Charges, it is understood, that the Surgeon may charge the highest, or any intermediate Sum, but not under the lowest.

Engagements by the year to be regulated by the Parties.
