REPORT

OF THE

COMMITTEE to the ANNUAL MEETING,

August, 1846.

YOUR Committee felt it to be an important branch of their duty, to present to the General Court the Annual Report of Income and Expenditure in a more intelligible form than that hitherto adopted. As it was impossible to discover what articles were comprehended under the vague titles of "Weekly Bills," "House Bills," &c. they have formed a Table which at one view exhibits the Disbursements under each head of expenditure.

Your Committee report with much pleasure, that at this period of unusual depression and distress in the Country, they have been enabled to diminish, considerably, the Weekly Payments of Patients in indigent circumstances. And if this should appear to the venerable and judicious Guardian of the hitherto accumulating Fund, called Lupton's Fund, to be a proper time for bringing into action a part, or the whole of its annual produce, a still more extensive and efficient reduction will be practicable in such cases as peculiarly need the interposition of charitable aid.

The Committee have pleasure in expressing their general approbation of the conduct of the Officers and Servants: and although the number of Patients at present in the House is rather larger than may be desirable, yet they trust that no serious inconveniences have been occasioned thereby.

The Committee, however, contemplate with much satisfaction the various advantages likely to be derived by the objects of this Institution, from the erection of the Buildings now in progress; advantages which they conceive will abundantly repay the expense incurred in obtaining them.
