APPEAL FOR PENSION FUND AT THE RETREAT, YORK.

Interim Report.

THE Committee gratefully acknowledge the receipt of donations and promises amounting to £4,540 towards the £7,000 required to initiate the Pension Fund for nurses, attendants, and other servants at the Retreat. The response to the Appeal has been very encouraging, the more so as many kind letters from the friends of patients and from former patients themselves have accompanied donations. But for these the Committee would hardly have been aware of the marked appreciation of the work of the Retreat and its staff.

Appended to this is a list of subscribers, and, in addition to those named, a considerable number of anonymous contributions have been received.

The Committee are now confronted with the problem of obtaining the balance of £2,460, still required, as unless this can be done the result, especially for the older servants now doing the work whilst so many are absent on military duty, must be disappointing.

The response to the Appeal has justified the Committee in making a commencement with the scheme, in so far as it affects the male and female nurses who will not reach the pension age for at least ten years, and policies have been effected for securing deferred annuities for all of these.

About one-third of the amount of the premiums for these policies is being paid by contributions from the staff and the remaining two-thirds by the Retreat out of revenue, donations to this fund being reserved for the benefit of the older members of the staff for whom policies have not as yet been taken out pending the completion of the scheme.

The question of these pensions has given the Committee much anxious thought for many years, and the increasing cost of living makes the matter still more difficult now. There appears to be no other solution than to ask the many friends of the Institution for still further help.

The Appeal, with full details of the proposals, has been distributed widely through the Agents of the Retreat in the various Quarterly and Monthly Meetings and in other ways, but it is hardly likely that it has reached all those who would wish to contribute. Copies will gladly be forwarded and further contributions thankfully acknowledged by
